CHAMBER CHOIR (grades 5-8) – This group rehearses once a week on **Tuesdays** afternoons from 2:30-3:30PM in the music room (rehearsals will be extended to 4:00 when approaching a performance). Our goal is to learn healthy singing techniques and work together to sing a variety of repertoire. We will have many opportunities to sing this year. Please see the attached schedule. Attendance is expected at ALL performances. LEDGER LIONS (grades 7-8) – This group rehearses once a week on **Tuesdays** afternoons from 3:30-4:15PM in the music room (rehearsals will be extended to 4:30 when approaching a performance). Our goal is to learn healthy singing techniques and work together to sing a variety of repertoire a cappella music. Students who are selected for this ensemble will also sing with Chamber Choir. Attendance is expected at ALL performances. ATTENDANCE POLICY: Being a part of any ensemble is like being a part of a sports team. EVERYONE COUNTS! It is extremely important that your child attends rehearsals regularly in order to learn the music/lyrics and to develop their voices properly. I will take attendance at every rehearsal. Students will be allowed three absences from rehearsal without penalty. Any student missing more than **four** rehearsals may not be allowed to sing in the concert or participate in other performance opportunities. If you know ahead of time of an absence, please contact me via email. Being a part of choir means that you are committed for **ALL** of our performances throughout the year including the Winter Concert, students liturgies, Graduation, and competitions/festivals. FAILURE TO ATTEND THESE PERFORMANCES WILL RESULT IN NOT BEING PERMITTED TO JOIN CHOIR THE FOLLOWING YEAR! Monthly calendars will be sent via email for your planning purposes. Parents are **REQUIRED** to help with choral fundraisers. Please remember that our fundraisers help to offset the cost of our trips! DRESS REHEARSALS ARE MANDATORY!!! This is a very important rehearsal usually the day before a performance. Anyone missing a dress rehearsal will not be allowed to sing in the performance. Choristers provide their own concert attire: GIRLS: black knee-length skirts or slacks, white long sleeved button-down oxford cloth shirts, tights or stockings (no knee socks or anklets with the skirts, please), black shoes **BOYS**: black slacks, white long-sleeved button down oxford cloth shirts (no tie), black socks, black Shoes. This seems silly to say, however, I must remind you that these are SINGING ensembles. If your child does not enjoy singing, is not singing in rehearsals, or at student liturgies, etc. they will be no longer able to participate. A performance test may be given to the choir to ensure everyone is doing their part to learn the music.
