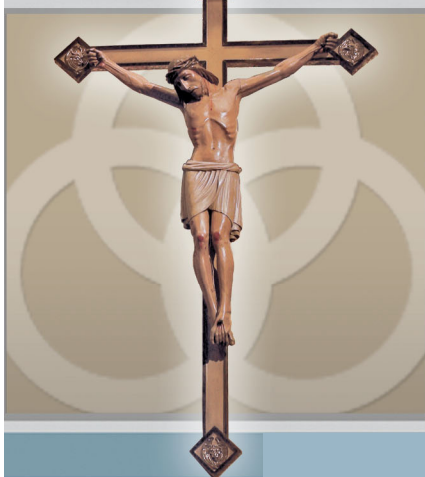

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Today's Reflection: Sacrifice

Today the Church focuses on the Eucharist. Today's readings remind us how connected to ancient blood sacrifices we are when offering our unbloody sacrifice. The reading from Exodus describes a solemn ritual designed so the Israelites would never forget their covenant with God.

The reading from the Letter to the Hebrews turns us from those ancient animal sacrifices, the first efforts to worship the living God. Our sacrifice is the body and blood of the Son of God. Because of Christ we have a new covenant.

The Gospel from Mark retells the establishment of that covenant, the familiar story of the Last Supper. Juxtaposed with the story of animal sacrifice as it is here, we are challenged to listen with new attention, to remember the great price paid for our salvation. Jesus gave his body and every drop of his blood for us.

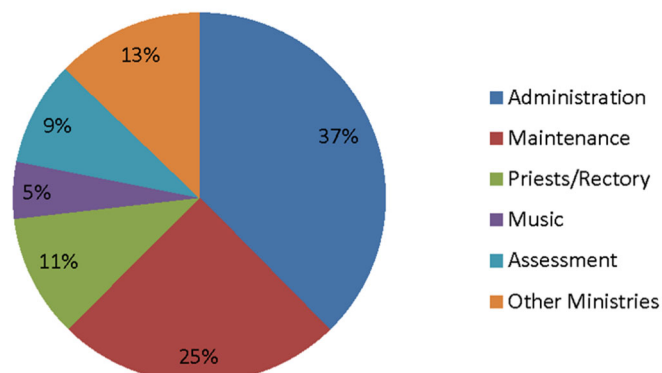

Dispensation Until Further Notice

Given the continuing limitation on large public gatherings, and so as to allow people who are not well or otherwise at risk the ability to stay home, the following provisions will remain in effect until further notice:

- The general dispensation from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass remains in place until further notice.
- People in vulnerable populations are encouraged to stay home.
- Parishioners are reminded of the need for smaller congregations (25% occupancy maximum per Mass).
- Live-streaming of weekday Masses remains available at lacatholics.org or on You Tube (Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels)
- No social sharing of food or drink before or after Mass or any other gathering.

Father's Day Novena & Cards

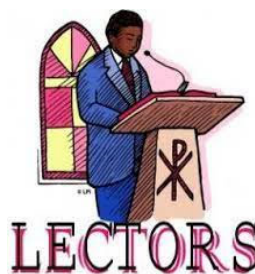


A special 9-day novena (June 21-29) of Masses will be offered for any living or deceased father that is enrolled in our special Father's Day Novena.

Did You Know?

Reporting child sexual exploitation

If your children are exposed to exploitive and abusive materials online, or if you discover such materials online, please report these exposures to help protect other children and families. You can report an incident to the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children (NCMEC) 24/7 at report.cybertip.org. Include the username of the person who shared explicit content, when it happened, what URL was used, and any other relevant information. NCMEC will work with law enforcement officials to start an investigation and shut down inappropriate activity. NCMEC also has materials and resources to help parents and children begin to recover from being exposed to exploitive and abusive materials online. To learn more, visit missingkids.org.

Cómo denunciar la explotación sexual infantil

Si sus hijos están expuestos a materiales abusivos y de explotación en línea, o si descubre dichos materiales en línea, reporte estas exposiciones para ayudar a proteger a otros niños y a familias. Puede reportar un incidente al Centro Nacional para Niños Desaparecidos y Explotados (NCMEC, por sus siglas en inglés) las 24 horas del día, los 7 días de la semana en report.cybertip.org. Incluya el nombre de usuario de la persona que compartió contenido explícito, cuándo sucedió, qué URL se usó y cualquier otra información relevante. El NCMEC trabajará con las autoridades policiales para iniciar una investigación y eliminar la actividad inapropiada. El NCMEC también tiene materiales y recursos para ayudar a los padres de familia y a los niños a comenzar a recuperarse de la exposición a materiales abusivos y de explotación en línea. Scripture Focus:

Jesus often teaches in parables, sayings or stories that compare God's ways to ordinary life. The images get our attention, and the puzzling conclusions keep us thinking about their meaning. If we are open to God, we come to understand today's parable speaks about the seed growing on its own. It has the power that makes the seed grow. The parable of the mustard seed speaks about the very small beginnings of God's Kingdom. God's Kingdom grows from those who heed His words. Most people do not understand about God's Kingdom. But the Lord keeps taking the disciples aside and explaining to them. Those who are willing to set aside the time to listen to Jesus' teachings will come to understand the truth of the Kingdom.

Reflection:

1. Where in your life do you experience “the seed growing on its own”...any change for the better that you notice in yourself, your relationship with God, with others...?
2. What are you anxious about? Is it in your power or God's power to change?
3. Can you set aside quiet time today to let Jesus reveal Himself to you?
4. What one small step can you take today to make your life or the life of those around you a little better?

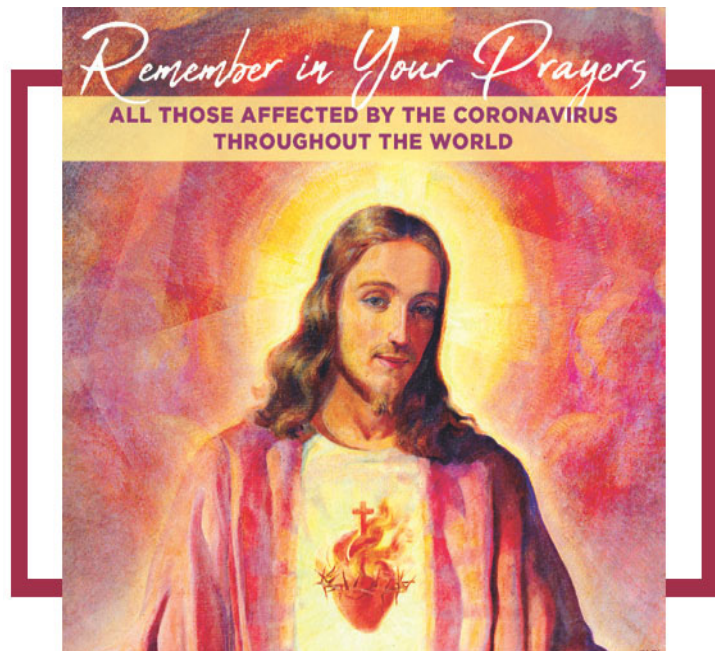

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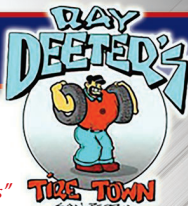
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
