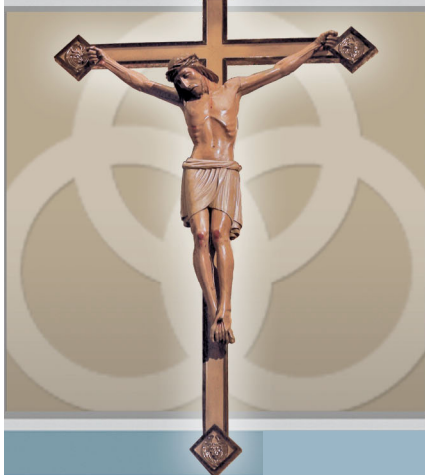

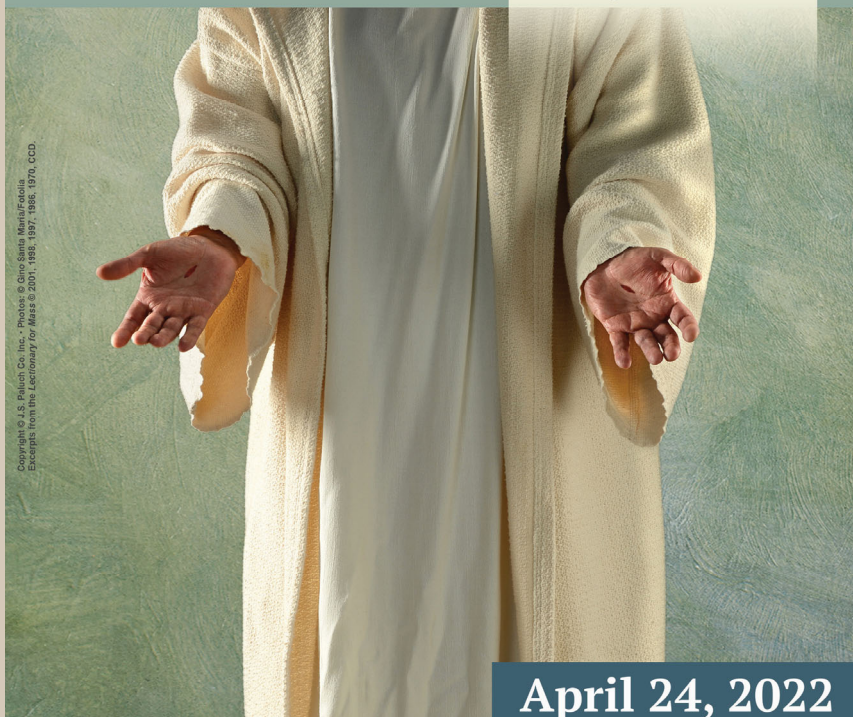

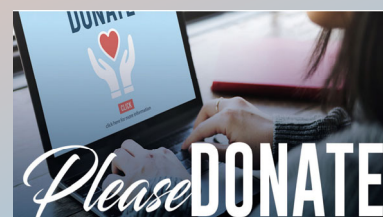
Today's Reflection: Difficulty, Survival, and Glory

In Revelation, John the Evangelist tells us what we can expect as followers of the risen Jesus: distress, endurance, and a kingdom. Although we are only eight days into our fifty-day Easter feasting, we cannot ignore the distress weighing down our daily lives. Jesus' resurrection does not erase individual suffering, but His glorious triumph over death cultivates endurance in our hearts. We remember that Jesus did not spare himself, and we ask for the strength to endure as he did. Imitating Christ helps us grow as members of God's royal family. As beloved citizens of the Kingdom of God, we recognize our kinship with all people. Peter demonstrates his care for others as he heals multitudes of broken, suffering people. In the Gospel, Thomas accepts his own spiritual healing when Jesus helps him to believe. In times of difficulty, survival, and glory, we borrow Thomas' declaration of faith: "My Lord and my God!"

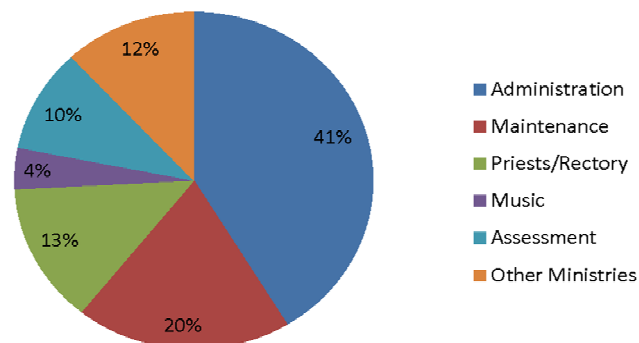

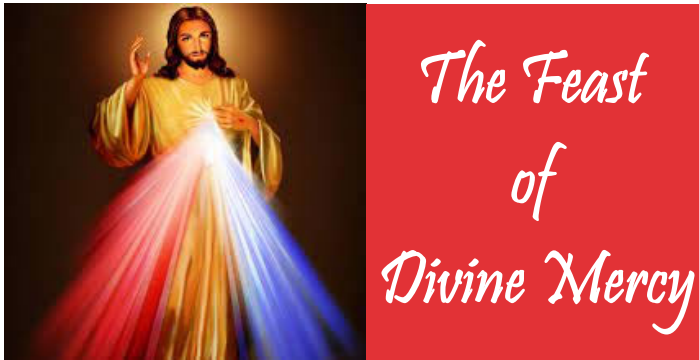

Wooden Clackers Used For The Holy Triduum

Wooden clackers, whose official name is "crotalus" (meaning "rattle"), are used in place of altar bells in the Catholic church during Holy Triduum. The sweet rings of altar bells are not appropriate after the Gloria on Holy Thursday through the Gloria on Holy Saturday. Therefore, rare instruments, like wooden clackers, are used to maintain an appropriate somber mood where the altar bells would be rung. The clacker is sounded at the consecration of the gifts during the liturgy of the Eucharist, reminding the congregation of the awesome transformation that takes place at these moments.

Why wooden clackers you may ask? The Catholic Church did not specify what should be used in place of altar bells for the Holy Triduum. Therefore, an instrument that simply "made noise" and provided a somber tone was needed. Hence, wooden clackers were brought into the liturgy. They come in two primary forms – one that produces a rattle sound from a small hammer repeatedly striking a wood block, and another which produces a striking single "crack" sound which is meant to reference the sound of a whip or nails being hammered. Examples of the two versions of the instrument were heard at Catholic Churches all over the world. Most notably, the rattling form was used this year was used at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington DC, while the sharp "whip" version was used at the Holy Church of the Holy Sepulcher in Jerusalem. (And at our very own church, Holy Trinity.)

Scripture Focus:

The scene in today's Gospel appears as a commentary upon a statement made by Jesus: "Apart from me you can do nothing." Apart from Him their efforts have been fruitless, but now that they are with Him, anything is possible. Peter's leadership role is expressed in pastoral imagery. With leadership comes responsibility and a call to imitate the selfless love of Christ. It is summed up in the statement, "Follow Me." To follow Jesus is to keep our focus on Jesus and His message of love and compassion while going about our daily lives. Nourished by His Spirit in Eucharist we are called to care, heal, teach, pray and challenge one another in word and action: to feed His sheep today.

Reflection:

1. Which "sheep" are not being fed well now? What will you do about this in the next two weeks?
2. What does it mean for you when Jesus says to you, "Follow Me"? What prevents you from following Jesus more closely?
3. What is God repeatedly asking of you in your life right now?

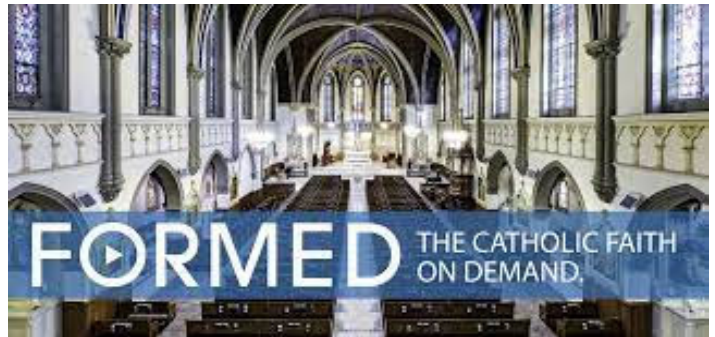

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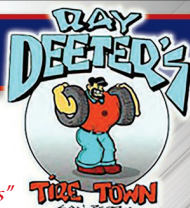
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
