

Today's Reflection: The Spirit's Active Power

The mystery of the Trinity refers to one God in three persons. We frequently acknowledge Jesus as “the second person of the Trinity,” but referring also to the Spirit as a “person” comes less naturally. In religious art, the Holy Spirit often appears as a dove or, as in today’s reading from the Acts of the Apostles, tongues of fire. Much rarer are images of the Spirit as a “person” in recognizable human form. Today’s readings do not settle the issue of how to picture the Spirit, but they certainly give shape to the Spirit’s active power in the world and in each human heart. In Acts, the Spirit enables people to speak and understand a variety of languages. Paul’s letter to the Corinthians praises the Spirit for all kinds of spiritual gifts, services, and “workings.” Finally, in John’s Gospel, Jesus calls the Spirit our Advocate and our divine teacher.





Corpus Christi Sunday June 19, 2022

The Feast of Corpus Christi, also called The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a festival of the Roman Catholic Church to honor the real presence of the body (corpus) of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

This year the Feast at Holy Trinity will be celebrated as follows:

Sunday, June 19
1pm Bilingual Mass with
our Pastor, Fr. Kevin Nolan
2pm Benediction & Street Procession
3pm Light refreshments in the gathering area

The procession route will be on the streets surrounding the church. The procession will commence using our new processional canopy at approximately 2:00 p.m. and conclude by 3:00 p.m. followed by a gathering with light refreshments in the church patio area.

Please note, the Feast Day falls on Father's Day. Hopefully, time can be made for participation in this very special celebration. This is what our Catholic faith is all about. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the whole Christian life. The feast of Corpus Christi is a celebration of Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist. It parallels the celebration on Holy Thursday in commemoration of the institution of this sacrament. #### Scripture Focus:

It is just such a mystery that is revealed to us in the readings for the Feast of Holy Trinity. The first speaks of the Creator delighting in creation (including each one of us); the second tells of Jesus who identifies with us in our sufferings and our hopes; the Gospel promises the Spirit of Truth who will always be there to guide us. This God "who was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be" is one we can totally rely on:

"I am with you always to the end of the world."

#### Reflection:

1. Tell of a moment when you experienced the wonder of life or creation.
2. Remember a time when you felt God's care for you. Who helped you to know God cared?
3. Where in your life do you need to rely on God more?
4. It is a struggle to be "open to the truth", to find the truth in today's world. How can the Spirit of Truth guide you?
