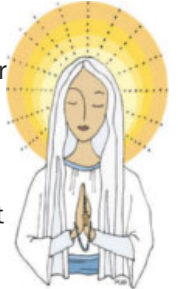

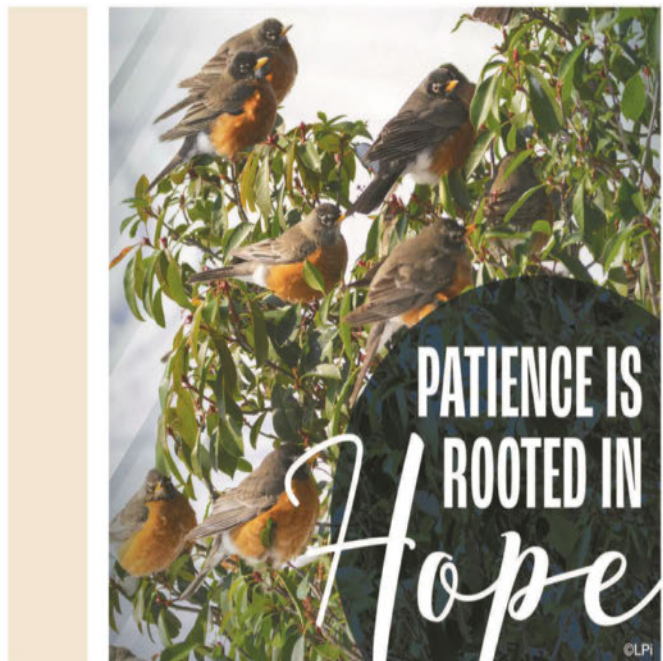

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Patience is rooted in Hope (an image of a bush filled with birds would be great)

Life, like the church, is often burdened with evil, smallness, and impurities. The Lord's parables give us a hope-filled perspective on all three.

Evil: in Jesus' parable about the good farmer whose enemy plants weeds at night, Jesus tells us that God is not the cause of evil but permits evil to exist with good out of his patient love. He will finally deal with it, but his love lets things stay messy for a time.

Smallness: It's funny that Jesus says his kingdom looks like ... wait for it ... a bush. What a letdown! Yet this little shrub still somehow has room for all the birds of the sky. The smallness of the Church, and even our own little lives, still provides plenty of room for all whom God sends.

Impurities: divisions and hypocrisies in the Church and our own hearts exasperate us. Recall that Jesus compares his kingdom to a lump of dough with impure leaven eating away at it and therefore making it expand. It's the secret of the Cross. Not how we'd prefer it. But finally, great news.

The field, the bush, the loaf: all three parables invite us to embrace a patience rooted in hope: one day the field will be weeded, the bush filled with birds, and the risen loaf leaven-free.

## THE SPIRITUAL EXERCISES OF ST. IGNATIUS: RETREAT IN DAILY LIFE SEPTEMBER 9, 2023 TO JUNE 1, 2024

Does it seem like the St. Ignatius or the Spiritual Exercises keep coming into your awareness every so often? Have you felt drawn to the Exercises, but it never seemed like the right time? Or maybe you are facing an important decision and desire to truly discern how God might be leading you. The Lord may be inviting you to make the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius: Retreat in Daily Life. For 500 years, the Ignatian Exercises have guided people into a more personal, practical, and passionate life of faith in God through Jesus Christ and has been described as an apprenticeship in discernment. The full Retreat involves 10 months of private daily prayer with the Exercises material, individual weekly meetings with a retreat facilitator, and monthly faith sharing group meetings. **Applications are now being accepted.** There will be a discernment interview following the submission of the application. #### Understanding the VIRTUS® “Protecting God’s Children” program

Child sexual abusers often target nurturing, child-friendly environments, where parents and participants assume that no one would ever want to harm a child. The Archdiocese

of Los Angeles began implementing the VIRTUS® Protecting God’s Children sexual abuse prevention program in 2004

to send a message to potential predators that child sexual abuse is not tolerated. Through this program, adults learn that through early identification, awareness, and education they can be “proactive” in protecting children and young people from child sexual abuse. Since the program began, more than 405,000 adults have been trained in abuse prevention. Additionally, more than 165,000 Catholic school and religious education students are trained annually with an age-appropriate curriculum on boundary awareness and how to communicate if violations of those safe boundaries occur. 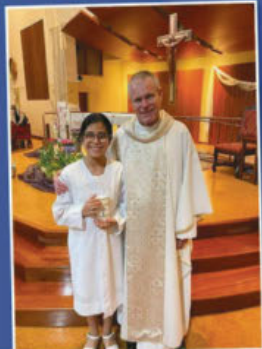

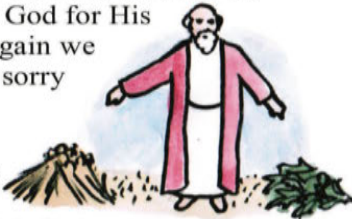
# Weeds Among the Wheat
