Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

#### What is PEACE?

In the gospel this week Jesus says to his disciples, and by extension to all of us "Peace I leave with you, peace I give to you. Not as the world gives [peace] do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." But the big question is what is the peace of Christ? This short reflection by Rev. Chris Miller C.M. from his Daily Reflections offers a fine job in helping us to understand the difference between peace as the world defines it and the peace one has through Christ.

Peace is a beautiful reality, impossible to define and yet experienced by all of us at some times. Peace can be thought of in a negative way, such as an absence of war between nations, or a lack or turmoil within a family, or freedom from anxiety in one's heart. But true peace is something positive. Underlying all kinds of peace is a sense of tranquility and harmony which comes from unity. Nations are truly at peace with one another, not when there is no relation at all between them, but when they cooperate with each other. A family is at peace, not when everyone has moved out of the house, but when they have learned to live together in harmony. A person is at peace, not when he ignores his problems, but when he has come to rest confidently in the loving arms of Jesus Christ.

Peace, then, is something positive and something very precious. It is this positive peace which is the farewell gift of Jesus to his disciples and to us. His words are earnest: "Peace is my farewell to you, my peace is my gift to you; do not be distressed or fearful." Jesus did not, however, stop with words. He gave us a means to find peace. And that means His body and blood in the Eucharist. There is a connection between peace and the Eucharist. That is why the prayers before communion turn to the theme of peace.

Putting it somewhat technically, the Eucharist is the effective sign of unity in the Church. This statement means simply that we all become one in Christ. We all receive one and the same Christ in communion. By uniting each individual to himself, he unites all of us with each other. He is our bond of union. His wish is that tranquility and harmony will come about through this unity.

If we are true to the Eucharist, if we respond to the grace granted us in the holy communion, we will find true peace in our hearts and we will live in peace with each other.





## Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Jonathan Haidt's 2024 book entitled "The Anxious Generation" argues that today's kids are marked by significant increases in anxiety, as the title suggests. Smartphones, social media, economic uncertainty, the chaos of a global pandemic, fear regarding climate change, and the so-called "meaning crisis" all contribute to strikingly high levels of anxiety in young people today. I'm a bit older than this generation, but I feel it, too. The world can be too much to handle.

The Gospel this week offers a stunning solution for troubled souls. To his overwhelmed and anxious disciples, the risen Jesus says, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you" (John 14:27). His peace is that of the one who was overwhelmed on the cross and then conquered death by the power of his divinity, his bond of love with the Father. He offers us this unshakeable peace.

Of course, mental illness does not magically disappear because of the risen Jesus. But he does walk with us and offer us his peace in the midst of our suffering. The peace the world gives is not like his because it is weak, uncertain, and self-generated. Jesus' peace is strong, sure, and given as a gift from God. He gives it to us amid our anxiety. Will you receive it as a gift? I hope so. He wants to fill the hearts of this generation with his peace.

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles began implementing the VIRTUS® Protecting God's Children sexual abuse prevention program in 2004 to send a message to potential predators that child sexual abuse is not tolerated. Through this program, adults learn that through early identification, awareness, and education they can be "proactive" in protecting children and young people from child sexual abuse. Since the program began, more than 405,000 adults have been trained in abuse prevention. Additionally, more than 165,000 Catholic school and religious education students are trained annually with an age-appropriate curriculum on boundary awareness and how to communicate if violations of those safe boundaries occur. 
