Hands and Voices at the Table

After serving for a while at the altar, communion ministers begin to notice people's outreached hands: Hands that are calloused and scarred from work. Hands that are gnarled and broken by illness.

Hands that cook, plant, build, create, paint, make music. Our hands reveal the stories of our lives

A communicant's eyes reveal a great deal, as well. One day joy may illuminate a communicant's eyes while, on another day, those same eyes betray sadness or stress or grief. Sometimes hurt and despair can be detected in the simple *Amen*.

Somedays we come to this table with grateful hearts and some days we come broken and distraught. Other times we come gratefully aware of God's presence in our lives—while sometimes we come wondering if God is here at all.

But we come. Because we know that every time we come, the miracle happens.

What happens on that plain in today's Gospel happens in our churches: the miracle of a collection of diverse, disconnected souls in transformed into a community of faith. We come here with struggles and doubts and pains and sorrows, and, if the Eucharist is what Jesus intended it to be, we find support and compassion from those who come to the tables with us. Today's feast of the Body and Blood of Christ celebrates Christ's call to be both guest and waiter, participant and host at the banquet of God.



Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A Catholic friend of mine occasionally says, "The Eucharist is not a noun. It's a verb." In so saying, he is making the point that the Eucharist isn't simply Jesus' bodily presence given to us in holy Communion. It also manifests the dynamic pattern by which Christ actively loves and saves us. He teaches us to cooperate with that pattern. This Eucharist actually embodies four verbs: Jesus takes, blesses, breaks, and gives. Let's consider each one.

He **takes:** Do we acknowledge that we are totally in God's hands? Do we receive everything in our lives as a gift, and act responsibly with it?

He **blesses:** Do we actively reflect that Jesus makes us holy in our baptism? Do we embrace our bodies and souls as temples of God, worthy of love, peace, and joy?

He **breaks:** Do we run from failure and disappointment, from getting old or being ignored? Are we too worried about getting hurt or sick? Do we embrace our sufferings with confidence?

He **gives**: Are we willing to make our lives a gift for others? Are we confident that we will always have enough love to give to others, that God will always provide enough for us? Do we rejoice in giving away what we have to others, expecting nothing in return? This is the dynamic life the Eucharist empowers us to live.





Through this program, adults learn that through early identification, awareness, and education they can be "proactive" in protecting children and young people from child sexual abuse. Since the program began, more than 405,000 adults have been trained in abuse prevention. Additionally, more than 165,000 Catholic school and religious education students are trained annually with an age-appropriate curriculum on boundary awareness and how to communicate if violations of those safe boundaries occur. 
