"BREAD OF LIFE" DISCOURSE

Introduction

A famous theologian once said:
"Baptism makes you a Christian, the
Eucharist makes you a Catholic."

There is no greater sign for (of) being Catholic than our theology of the Eucharist. For the next 5 weeks, the gospel of John, chapter 6, will give us a wonderful overview of this belief and teaching of the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Overview

The Lectionary interrupts Mark's Gospel at this point to insert a series of readings from the Gospel according to Saint John, commonly referred to as the Bread of Life Discourse.

Of all the evangelists, Mark has written the shortest Gospel, and the liturgical year requires some additional readings to fill out the remaining weeks of the year.

Nevertheless, it would be a mistake to see the series that commences today as "mere filler."

John illuminates the meaning of the Eucharist feast and Christ abiding presence in an outstanding way, without ever exhausting the mystery.

John's witness is unique among all the evangelists and has been the starting point of reflection for age upon age of faithful Christians.

Over the next several weeks, as the narrative of John unfolds, we are invited to meditate on something that stands at the heart of the experience of the Church, but always goes beyond our power to grasp: the Mystery of the Eucharist.

Today's reading with its compelling, detailed narrative, is quite different in style from the readings that lie ahead, but is closely connected in theme.

Jesus feeds his people with bread and fish, in the weeks to come, he will gradually introduce them to the much more profound way in which he will be their bread.

Notice the telling detail at the beginning of the reading: "the Jewish feast of Passover was near."

In the Jewish tradition, the deliverance of God's people from Egypt was ritualized by a meal.

The Passover setting put us on notice that something highly significant is about to take place. Jesus proposes to feed many with only a little food. Like Elisha from today's first reading, Jesus faces objections, yet all eat and plenty is left over. The crowds acclaim Jesus as a prophet and wish to make him king, but he slips away alone.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Once I went to a hospice facility to celebrate Last Rites for an elderly dying man. His family had told me that he had been uncommunicative for days. At the conclusion of the ritual, we began to recite the Our Father prayer. To everyone's surprise, his lips moved, clearly mouthing the words to the Lord's prayer. Stripped of most of his faculties, the man could still pray those precious Godgiven petitions. A lifetime of prayer had planted the words even deeper than his failing consciousness.

Do we want the Lord's prayer to be as deeply embedded in us? If we want to be people of hope, we should. Recall that our Lord immediately follows the prayer by saying: "Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you" (Luke 11:9). We only ask, search and knock because we hope that the request is not in vain. Everything we could possibly hope for is contained in the prayer. Praying the Our Father deepens our hope.

We should consciously pour all our hopes into the Lord's prayer; we should allow it to be an expression of hope, not simply rote words. Then, over time, it builds up our hope in God. It sinks deep into our souls and bodies. How blessed we are when these words of hope are on our lips, even when everything else seems to fail.



Child sexual abusers often target nurturing, child-friendly environments, where parents and participants assume that no one would ever want to harm a child. The Archdiocese of Los Angeles began implementing the VIRTUS® Protecting God's Children sexual abuse prevention program in 2004 to send a message to potential predators that child sexual abuse is not tolerated. Through this program, adults learn that through early identification, awareness, and education they can be "proactive" in protecting children and young people from child sexual abuse. Since the program began, more than 405,000 adults have been trained in abuse prevention. Additionally, more than 165,000 Catholic school and religious education students are trained annually with an age-appropriate curriculum on boundary awareness and how to communicate if violations of those safe boundaries occur. 
