My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
I saw this article written and published by "The Word Among Us" and I wanted to share it with you.

### **Be Ready**

*Of that day or hour, no one knows. (Mark 13:32)*

When Jesus said that "no one knows" when the Second Coming would happen, was he saying that even he didn't know?

It sure seems that way.

Maybe he was reminding us that he had submitted to the limitations of being human, just like us.

Yes, he was fully divine, but he was also fully human.

And that entailed certain limitations.

This is why Luke tells us that Jesus was always increasing in wisdom "before God and man" (Luke 2:52).

Today, however, Jesus knows when he will come again.

The problem is, we still don't know!

Repeatedly throughout history, people have tried to predict the end of the world.

St. Paul thought it was around the corner.

St. Hippolytus of Rome and St. Irenaeus of Lyon thought it would happen in AD 500.

John Wesley, the first Methodist, thought the end would come in 1836.

Many Christian leaders—and no shortage of psychics—have also weighed in.

Not surprisingly, many of these people then recalculated the dates after their first predictions didn't come true, only to have their followers disappointed again.

Some believers are more cautious. They tell us that we will see specific clues when the time is near.

They point to certain signs—a war in the Middle east, a drought in Africa, earthquakes in Peru, or some other disaster.

When those signs occur, it means that Jesus is very near.

Still, no human being knows when Jesus will come.

It could be today.

It may not be for thousands of years.

St. Francis had a different take on the subject.

Once, when he was working in the garden, a friar asked, "what would you be doing now if you knew that Jesus was coming back today?"

Francis replied, "I would keep hoeing my garden."

Francis knew he was trying his best to be ready, and there was nothing more he could do.

The point is, Jesus *will* come.

So our best answer is the same as it has always been: be ready.

### **Question For Reflection**

*If you knew Jesus was coming back today...how would you change your life? **BUT** we don't know when Jesus will come again, so be ready and make those changes anyway.*



## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

When I was a kid growing up in New England, I'd occasionally go on a whale watch. Once we went out with calm waters and clear skies. But on the way back in, the sea got rough. I was just a kid, and I remember thinking we should turn left or right toward the shoreline I could see. But the pilot of the boat kept going straight — right into the waves — focused on a small, discouragingly distant lighthouse. Even when it flickered in and out of sight, he stayed the course. He knew where he was going.

That image comes to mind when I hear Jesus' words in today's Gospel regarding false messiahs: **"Do not follow them" (Luke 21:8)**. In times of chaos or uncertainty, there are always voices offering easier routes, promising false safety, claiming to speak for God. But Jesus isn't found in the loudest voice or the nearest shoreline. He is steady, like a lighthouse in the storm.

The tribulation of which Jesus speaks — it's real. It happened to the Temple, it happened to him, it happens in the Church, and it will come to each of us. But the command is not to panic. It's to endure. To keep steering toward him. Faith isn't about having all the answers or dodging every wave. It's about knowing where the lighthouse is — and trusting it enough to keep going, especially when false safety beckons us to stop.





As Christians, we are called to care for others, to generously share our abundance with our brothers and sisters in need.

Holy Trinity's long established tradition of bringing non-perishable food

items to our Thanksgiving Day Mass, will continue **Thursday, November 27th, at 9:00 am.**

Parishioners are reminded that the offering of the food items is a part of the liturgy, and that all gifts should be held in the pews until it is time to bring them forward in procession. This ritual occurs after the homily and intersessions, at the Presentation of the Gifts.

After mass, we request assistance in transporting the food items down to the parish center auditorium/lobby where they will be collected and prepared for future distribution.

Below is a list of items needed:

**Staples:** cooking oil, peanut butter, jams & jellies, spaghetti and pastas, instant mashed potatoes, cereal, cake mix & frosting, rice, oatmeal, and powdered milk.

**Canned Foods:** soup, broth, gravy, tuna, salmon, spam, Vienna sausage, pasta sauce, pinto beans, chili beans, beef stew, green beans, corn, mixed vegetables, sweet potatoes, yams, canned fruit, apple sauce, and tomato/pasta sauce.



**Our Lady of Guadalupe Novena & Mass**

Please join the Guadalupanas Ministry in the beautiful tradition of praying a Novena in anticipation of The Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12.

Our Lady of Guadalupe, the Patroness of the Americas appeared to Aztec peasant Juan Diego on Tepeyac Hill in Mexico City 1531. Our Lady requested a church

be built on the spot, logically no one believed Juan Diego and the bishop at the time was naturally skeptical of such story. Juan Diego noticed roses growing at the site of the apparition despite it being winter. He wrapped them in his tilma and took them to the Bishop. Upon presenting the tilma to the Bishop the tilma had been miraculously imprinted with an image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The tilma and image are preserved to this day at the Our Lady of Guadalupe Basilica in Mexico City.

Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, patrona de América, se le apareció al campesino azteca Juan Diego en el cerro del Tepeyac, en la Ciudad de México, en 1531. Nuestra Señora pidió que se construyera una Iglesia en ese lugar, pero, lógicamente, nadie creyó a Juan Diego y el obispo de la época se mostró escéptico ante tal historia. Juan Diego observó que crecían rosas en el lugar de la aparición a pesar de ser invierno. Las envolvió en su tilma y se las llevó al obispo, y al presentarle la tilma, esta tenía milagrosamente impresa la imagen de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. La tilma y la imagen se conservan hasta el día de hoy en la Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en la Ciudad de México.
