My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
I saw this Advent reflection in *Waiting in Joyful Hope 2013-14* by Jay Cormier published by Liturgical Press and wanted to share it.

### GOD CRIES OUT IN THE DESERT OF OUR HEARTS

*It was of John that the prophet Isaiah had spoken when he said:  
A voice of one crying out in the desert,  
Prepare the way of the LORD,  
Make straight his paths. (Matt 3:3)*

Kathleen Norris recounts the following scene in her book *Acedia & Me: A Marriage, Monks and a Writer's Life*:

It is the noon rush at a busy downtown restaurant. A man sipping a drink and chatting with associates begins to cough; suddenly, he stops breathing and turns blue before collapsing.

"In that instant, everything changes. Strangers drop what they are doing." Someone phones 911, while a group of waiters, patrons, and friends work together to place the man on his side to help him breathe again.

"When he opens his eyes and responds, however feebly, to a question, everyone cheers. It is as if time had been suspended, waiting for this moment.

When the EMTs arrive, the rescuers drift back to their lunches.

Having been shocked by the real - forcibly reminded that life is both precious and precarious, a tenuous matter of heartbeat and breath - one [patron] will order a stiff drink, another will phone her husband to tell him that she loves him.

A man will go back to his office and stare at the family photographs on his desk until tears well up. Eventually, he will turn to the blinking cursor on his computer screen.

The effect of John the Baptizer's preaching of a baptism of repentance and conversion of life mirrors what happened in that restaurant: the sobering realization that our time is limited, that life is precious and fragile, that the busyness of our days distracts us from the true joys of our lifetimes.


John calls us to snap out of our obliviousness to God in our midst.

The same Word that came to John in the desert comes to each of us in the deserts of our own hearts, enabling us to transform the wastelands and straighten the winding roads of our lives in the compassion and justice of God.

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

This week we hear that John the Baptist is out in the wilderness eating **"locusts and wild honey"** (Mark 1:6). It's not just a strange historical detail. It's a symbolic expression of a healthy spiritual diet. The path to Christ includes both the hard and the beautiful, the gritty and the sweet. We have to learn to gulp the locusts and savor the honey.

I remember working with a young couple preparing for marriage. They were sincere, but raw — barely beginning to discover faith. Part of me wanted to rush them ahead, to fill in all the gaps, to bombard them with scripture and church documents. I swallowed that instinct. It was like eating locusts.

But I also recall them light up as they spoke about each other, about their first child, then their second. And they wanted to be close to God. Something innocent and beautiful was unfolding. That was the honey. I knew God was asking me to savor it.

This Advent, maybe we're each being invited to accept both locusts and honey. Maybe it's time to stop avoiding the difficult parts of faith — prayer that feels dry, the call to repentance, the patience with the troublesome. It's time to eat some locusts.

But we also need to notice the small gifts God gives us: a peaceful moment, a good conversation, the joy of serving someone else, new life, good intentions of our friends. That's the honey. Savor it!

John didn't avoid either. He took it all in. And so can we. What are your locusts? Your honey? If we let God feed us with both, we'll be ready — really ready — for the coming of Christ.



**Our Lady of Guadalupe Novena & Mass**

Please join the Guadalupanas Ministry in the beautiful tradition of praying a Novena in anticipation of The Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12.

Our Lady of Guadalupe, the Patroness of the Americas appeared to Aztec peasant Juan Diego on Tepeyac Hill in Mexico City 1531. Our Lady requested a church

be built on the spot, logically no one believed Juan Diego and the bishop at the time was naturally skeptical of such story. Juan Diego noticed roses growing at the site of the apparition despite it being winter. He wrapped them in his tilma and took them to the Bishop. Upon presenting the tilma to the Bishop, the tilma had been miraculously imprinted with an image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The tilma and image are preserved to this day at the Our Lady of Guadalupe Basilica in Mexico City.

**Novena y misa de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe**

Únase al Ministerio Guadalupanas en la hermosa tradición de rezar una novena en anticipación a la fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe el 12 de Diciembre.

Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, patrona de América, se le apareció al campesino azteca Juan Diego en el cerro del Tepeyac, en la Ciudad de México, en 1531. Nuestra Señora pidió que se construyera una Iglesia en ese lugar, pero, lógicamente, nadie creyó a Juan Diego y el obispo de la época se mostró escéptico ante tal historia. Juan Diego observó que crecían rosas en el lugar de la aparición a pesar de ser invierno. Las envolvió en su tilma y se las llevó al obispo, y al presentarle la tilma, esta tenía milagrosamente impresa la imagen de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. La tilma y la imagen se conservan hasta el día de hoy en la Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en la Ciudad de México.
