My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I saw this reflection in "Waiting in Joyful Hope" by Rev. Joseph F. Sica and published by Twenty-Third Publications and thought it would set the mood well for our 3rd Sunday of Lent.

I've Fallen, But I will Get Up!

In the gospel today, John the Baptist's heart is breaking as he asks Jesus, "Are you the one, or do we look for another?"

John had high expectations for Jesus, thinking he would muscle the Romans, it didn't happen, and now John is disappointed and devastated.

Jesus the encourager gives John affirmation, telling him– and us– that when hopes and expectations are shattered, we should not give up.

Work through the pain, look inside, and find the strength to take one more step. These three suggestions may help:

- **Cry it out.** Let the tears flow. As you feel your pain empty out of your body, you will feel healing begin.
- **Talk it out.** Hurting people often say, "I can't talk about it," but you need to connect with another person and engage in a heart-to-heart conversation. In the exchange, you'll gain insight and understanding into overlooked possibilities.
- **Write it out.** If you're angry at God, that's okay. Get those deep hurts out. Write down all your negative thoughts in a journal– or just a lined piece of paper.

When the bottom falls out of your life, and you can't find anything to grasp onto, stop pretending that you have it all together and admit your hurt. While Jesus never insulates us from heartaches, He will walk alongside us, giving us the assurance and reinforcement we need to continue on.


Repeat this to yourself when life turns you upside down: This, too, shall pass.

ADVENT FEATURE



GAUDETE SUNDAY

The Third Sunday of Advent is called *Gaudete Sunday*, the day when we light the pink candle on the Advent wreath (hence the 'pink candle' Sunday). Rose vestments are worn to emphasize our joy that Christmas is near. Gaudete means "rejoice". This day reminds us of the joy that is to come, and serves, amid this season of penance, as a kind of 'break' when we recall the hope we have because of the coming of Our Lord Jesus.

Today is the 3rd Sunday of Advent, traditionally called "Gaudete" Sunday which is Latin for rejoice. We get the Rejoice theme from the 2nd reading where St. Paul writes, "Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say rejoice."

This week we light the rose candle in the Advent wreath, signifying joy. Too often we think joy means getting what we want. But consider the joyful mysteries of the rosary- events filled with surprise and often trepidation. Mary didn't ask to become pregnant before marriage, Elizabeth had despaired of conceiving in her old age, and it took a visit from an angel to convince Joseph that things would be OK. Their joy, and ours too, comes not in getting what we want, but in accepting God's will, even when we don't understand it.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A priest friend recently told me a remarkable story. One of his cousins reported having a vivid dream in which an angel told him the family needed to exhume their grandmother's body from a cemetery in New York and return it to her birthplace in Romania. She had been dead nearly ten years. As you might expect, the family thought it was, well, crazy. But astonishingly they exhumed her body. It was incorrupt, showing no signs of decomposition. That experience sparked healing, faith, and reconciliation throughout the family.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Joseph also receives a dream. He's confused, afraid. But in the quiet of sleep, God speaks: **"Do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home" (Matthew 1:20)**. When he wakes, Joseph acts. He doesn't overanalyze or dismiss the message. He trusts, and acts.

God still speaks — not necessarily through literal dreams but through those deeper intuitions of the heart. St. Ignatius of Loyola taught that God's voice draws us into peace, courage, and love. But we have to listen to it. Advent is a time for stillness. As we prepare for Christ's coming, we're invited to enter that quiet space where God's voice can be heard.

When and how do you become most receptive to God? Is it in silence? In prayer? In nature? At Mass? This week, go there. Be still. Listen. And like Joseph, have the courage to act on what God shows you.




