Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I saw this Reflection written by Natalia Imperatori-Lee and I wanted to share it with you.

The Love Comes First

Watching your child walk across a high school graduation stage prompts memories of pre-K graduation with Off - key singing and sweet handmade gifts for parents. It's tough to look at a high school graduate and not see a pre-kindergartener beaming back at us. Graduations are, fundamentally, celebrations of achievement, of things learned, grasped, and mastered.

The feast of Jesus' baptism reflects some of the emotions we celebrate in milestone moments like graduations. I hear God proclaim, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased," and am reminded of families applauding heartily for their children as they received awards and diplomas celebrating their excellence. There is, however, one glaring difference: God's proclamation about Jesus comes before Jesus' public ministry even begins. Jesus hasn't "done" anything yet: no sermons, no healings, certainly no paschal mystery. And yet, God is already well pleased.

This is the secret of God's love and a parent's love: both are unconditional. Genuine unconditional love precedes any achievement and endures through any disappointment. We do nothing to earn such love. There's no bar to clear.

Let's face it, the joy children bring to their families precedes even the first discordant songs at preschool. The love comes first, and we love our children into life, into independence—into, we hope, joy. God wills this love for us as well.

May we be graced with the openness to receive it.



Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Apple ran a commercial not long ago called "Behind the Mac - Greatness." It shows artists and creators, such as Kendrick Lamar, Billie Eilish, and Lady Gaga, working behind their MacBooks. The narration says, "There's a certain kind of person who doesn't wait for greatness. They make it." It's a compelling message. There's beauty in using our gifts with passion and purpose. But there lies a hidden weight in that idea: If you are what you make, what happens when you can't anymore? When the project fails, the passion fades, or the spotlight moves on, where is greatness then?

Today's Gospel offers a differing vision of greatness. Jesus steps into the Jordan River. He hasn't preached, healed, or performed a single miracle. Then the heavens open, and the Father speaks: "**You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.**" It's not a reward for success. It's not earned. Before he does anything "great," Jesus receives the greatness of his identity from the Father.

And so do you. At your baptism, God said the same thing over you: "You are my beloved." That is your true identity, not constructed or earned but received. When we see ourselves and others this way, everything changes for the better. We discover a greatness that can never be taken away.

This week, reflect on your baptism: look up the date, thank God for it, pray for those baptized with you, or visit the church where it happened. Let your identity be rooted there.


