Library Donation Policy

The library of St. Pius X High School welcomes donated materials. Donated items will be evaluated in order to determine their suitability for the library's collection. Those not added to the collection may variously be offered to students and staff, exchanged with a local dealer for other books, or donated to a charity.

Although items need not be new, they should be in very good condition with few signs of wear or markings.

There are some items that will not be accepted because they would not be suitable for the collection, for exchange, or for donation:

- Encyclopedias/dictionaries
- Textbooks
- Magazines/newspapers

Upon request, a receipt of the donation will be provided. It will indicate the number of items donated, with no assigned value. It will be left to the donor to assign the value of the donation.

Anyone considering a financial gift to the library ought to contact the school's development office.

St. Pius X High School appreciates the generous support shown to the library through donations, which enhance the learning and personal development of the students, teachers, staff and the broader community.
