### Places:

- ❖ **Where do I turn in service hours?**
  - x2vol
- ❖ **Where is the school library/media center?**
  - End of the main building hallway
- ❖ **Where is the SPX Chapel?**
  - In the main hallway on the right before you reach the library. Masses before school are held here.
- ❖ **What & where is the Armoury?**
  - It is our spirit store; purchase dance tickets, uniform shirts, "Jeans' Days & "dress down day" wristbands here. Next to the main office.
- ❖ **How are the rooms numbered in the main building?**
  - Main Hallway: Beginning on the left with the Conference Room, then 102, they are numbered like a horseshoe.
  - Science Wing, 2nd & 3rd floor: Beginning with Room 151, first floor past the elevator like a horseshoe, numbered in reverse.
- ❖ **Location of restrooms:**

- First floor-main building between commons & freshmen lockers; in science wing, boys on 1st & 3rd floors, girls on 1st & 2nd floors

- ❖ **Location of computer lab:**
  - 2nd floor of science wing, Room 250
- ❖ **Location of the Logan Center:**
  - 3rd floor of Fine Arts Building
- ❖ **Fine Arts Building:**
  - Art, Music, Journalism, Ms. Daniels office

### Procedures:

- ❖ **When do I need passes when I leave my classroom or "family?"**
  - Restroom, library, computer lab, counselors, see another teacher, emergency to office.
- ❖ **How many lunches? How do they work?**
  - There are 4: A, B, C, D. On a M-T-F schedule, you eat period 5; on Wednesday block, you eat Period 3; on Thursday block, you eat Period 6. Also study time M-T-F.
- ❖ **Where are all the different Pius schedules located?**
  - The "Academic Calendar" on SPX webpage.
- ❖ **What is a seminar period?**
  - Study, use of the library and computer lab, "family time", visiting college recruiters, assemblies, All-School Mass, adoration in chapel, class meetings
- ❖ **How often is Mass offered?**
  - Tuesday--All School Mass; optional daily mass at 7:15 am; in SPX Chapel.
- ❖ **Confession times?**
  - Before & after school. Seminar & by appt.
- ❖ **How do "dress down" days work?**
  - Students may wear clean, neat black or blue jeans or clean, neat sweatpants on approved Jeans Days. No leggings. Normally, SPX t-shirts are required to be worn unless otherwise stated.
- ❖ **What is the difference between "family time" and "tribe time"?**
  - Family Time = visit in families, Tribe is the entire school.

### Things to Know:
