






Discover Catholic Schools Week






In keeping with tradition, we ask that <u>ALL FRESHMEN</u>

Scholarship Details

- Eligible to earn 1:1 match on college savings, not to exceed \$1,000, and up to \$400 available for achieving college-ready milestones during high school.
- Up to 250 9th graders will be selected for the College Savings Match program
- Match and incentives earnings will be paid directly to the college, in a one-time payment the first semester of college.

Eligibility Requirements

- Current 9th grader
- Be home-schooled or attend a public, charter, or private high school in one of the six eligible counties (Kansas: Johnson, Wyandotte. Missouri: Cass, Clay, Jackson, Platte.)
- Income eligible (FAFSA Student Aid Index of 12,000 or less)
- 2.5 cumulative unweighted high school GPA in 9th grade.

- Up to \$50,000 paid directly to the college, over the course of up to six years.
- Required to complete GPA and graduate requirements in senior year of high school
- Minimum of 250 scholarships awarded yearly.

- 2.5 cumulative unweighted high school GPA OR at least a 16 on the ACT or at least an 800 on the SAT.
