




Parents,

I wanted to let all of you know that the SPX staff had a very impactful meeting with an outside agency this past Friday 10/27/23 relative to our school safety plan. We have taken what we learned in that training and are currently updating all of our safety plans relative to shelter in place and lock down. Please note that if at all possible in an "Emergency situation", we will do our best to notify you all. In addition we will continue to practice with our students our Emergency preparedness.

Thank you again for trusting us with your most valuable gifts and know that we are doing our best to ensure their safety at all times.






SPX will be collecting canned goods for the Bishop Sullivan Center Nov 9th-20th. The tribe that collects the most canned goods wins.




We would like to recognize the exemplary efforts of SPX Junior Alynah Tran.
