

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

February 20, 2022

SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Divine Mercy Novena Mass and Chaplet

Beginning Monday, Feb. 21, we will begin our Divine Mercy devotion at St. George Church at 6PM. For the next nine consecutive Mondays, we will celebrate Holy Mass at 6PM followed by singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet.

This year's theme is A Tour of the Diary of St. Faustina. Some who have tried to read her Diary said that it was daunting to go through 700 pages. I hope to provide a "map" of the Diary in a sense to help guide us through the Diary. Those who take the plunge into the Diary will be rewarded with a special glimpse into the intimate relationship between Sr. Faustina and Jesus. Her account was not written down for her sake, but for all of us.

Sister Faustina was born on August 25, 1905 in Głogowiec, Poland to Marianna and Stanisław Kowalski as the third of ten children. Two days later she was baptized with the name Helena in the parish church of Świnice Warckie. At the age of nine, she made her first Holy Communion. She attended elementary school for merely three years and then she went to work as a housekeeper in various well–to–do families in Aleksandrów and Łódź. From the age of seven, she had felt the calling for religious vocation, but her parents would not give her permission to enter the convent.

However, impelled by the vision of the Suffering Christ, in July 1924 she left for Warsaw to find a place. For another year she worked as a housekeeper to save some money for a modest monastic trousseau. On August 1, 1925 she entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Warsaw on Żytnia Street.

She lived in the Congregation for thirteen years, staying in many houses, the longest time (she spent) in Kraków, Płock



and Vilnius; working as a cook, shop assistant in baker's shop, gardener, and portress. She suffered from tuberculosis of the lungs and alimentary system and that is why for over 8 months stayed at the hospital in Kraków – Prądnik. Greater sufferings from those which were caused by tuberculosis, she offered as a voluntary sacrifice for sinners and as the Apostle of Divine Mercy. She experienced also many extraordinary graces such as: apparitions, ecstasies, the gift of bilocation, hidden stigmata, reading into human souls, the mystical betrothal, and nuptials.

In 1934 (Sr. Faustina was 29 yrs. old and 4 years prior to her death), her spiritual director, Fr. Michal Sopocko, told her to keep notes of her experiences. Sr. Faustina was trying to explain to Fr. Sopocko during communal confession time all that she was experiencing during her prayer times. Other sisters were getting annoyed at her excessively long confession. So he told her to only accuse herself of herself of her sins in confession and to



write down all her spiritual experiences in a notebook, which she was to give to him to read.

Initially, Sr. Faustina thought that the task of writing down her experiences was beyond her. She only had 3 semesters of primary schooling, so writing was difficult for her. She was also aware that no words could express her experiences. During the course of 4 years (1934-1938), she filled six handwritten notebooks (over 700 pages!). Her first notebook, she actually burned. She wrote all the entries in secret in her free time when she was not carrying out her monastic duties. She also wrote in hospital, where she had more time and, at Father Sopoćko's request, she underlined all of Jesus' words.

"Even though I am not well and my nature wants to rest, still I feel the inspiration of grace to prevail over tiredness and write, to keep writing to comfort the souls I love so much, with whom I shall share all eternity. I so dearly want them to have eternal life that I spend all my free time, even the briefest moments, on writing, in the way Jesus wants me to write." (Diary 1471). The last entries to which she put a date were written in June 1938, so she stopped writing her Diary three months before her death. She wrote six notebooks altogether, which were published along with a small notebook on the way she prepared for Holy Communion.

In the Diary Sister Faustina described her spiritual life, which was exceptionally profound, culminating in union with God in mystical marriage with Jesus. She wrote how deeply she came to know the mystery of the Divine Mercy and how she contemplated it in her daily life. She also wrote about her struggle against the weakness of human nature and the difficulties she came up against in carrying out her prophetic mission. Above all, the Diary contains the message of God's merciful love for humankind, which Sister Faustina was required to pass on to the Church and the world. This makes her Diary a special work, as the Holy Father, Pope John Paul II, said, "the gospel of mercy written from the 20th-century perspective."





The amazing thing the reader discovers in The Diary of St. Maria Faustina is that, although Maria Faustina was fairly uneducated, she expresses a childlike trust and intimacy in Jesus and expresses spiritual insights that are surprising and rewarding for the reader.




