

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

July 31, 2022

18TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

From our new Parochial Vicar, Fr. Bob Banares:

I'm Fr. Bernard Banares, everyone calls me Fr. Bob. I come from a big family with nine siblings. We are five boys and four girls, and I am the 4th child. When we were kids my mother managed handicrafts and my father worked in an electric company. When we were kids we were not like the other kids who have a lot of time playing because we were trained to help in the handicraft business.

What attracted me to enter the seminary and to become a priest was when I joined my parish's choir. I always dreamt of being a priest at the altar saying Mass. So I entered the seminary in 1983 after graduating from high school at the age of 16. And then nine straight years in the seminary, the first five years for my B.A. in Philosophy and the other four years for my Theological studies. I finished my Philosophical studies in 1998, after which I took my Theological studies and finished in 1992. I was ordained December 8, 1992 as a deacon and May 22, 1993 as a priest. I'm celebrating 30 years in the priesthood this coming May 22, 2023. In my 29 years as a priest, I have been assigned to seven churches in our Diocese, the Diocese of Legazpi, Philippines.

My bishop sent me for a special ministry starting in 1997 Preaching for the Missions here in North America, particularly in Ontario in Canada and here in the States every year, and just stopped in 2020 and 2021 due to the pandemic. A couple of times I had a mission preaching here in Baton Rouge and each time Fr. Jeff Bayhi offered me to stay in his parish while here in Louisiana. And it is through Fr. Jeff's recommendation to Bishop Michael Duca, D.D. that I had this chance of doing my pastoral ministry here in Baton Rouge. Thanks to Fr. Paul Yi for accommodating me here at St. George.



I consider this year a great blessing for me to be here in this Diocese of Baton Rouge most specifically being assigned here in this great parish of St. George Church. Know of my prayers for you all that make up this hospitable and welcoming Faith Community. Please humbly pray for me that my ministry and pastoral care here may be fruitful for myself and you all.





We are pleased to announce that arrangements have been completed with **American Cemetery Consultants LLC** to build the beautiful new Garden Mausoleum in St. George Cemetery. The program has the full approval of His Excellency, Most Reverend Michael G. Duca, Bishop of Baton Rouge.

Sales Representatives of American Cemetery Consultants will be contacting the families of St. George, St. Jude the Apostle, St. Patrick, and Most Blessed Sacrament Parishes over the next few weeks to answer questions about the mausoleum and determine who is interested. The number of crypts selected before construction will determine the size of the mausoleum. Spaces are reserved on a first come basis; therefore, anyone seeking information should either mail in the postage paid reply card from the brochure mailer that was mailed to your home.

Due to the dwindling cemetery space, once the Mausoleum is constructed, the remaining spaces will be available to St. George Parish Families only.

We wish to thank everyone for the warm reception given to the representatives who are visiting families in Baton Rouge concerning the St. George Cemetery New Mausoleum. The active survey part of the program is scheduled to be completed in the next few weeks. Therefore, all families that have not made a final decision are reminded that this will be the last opportunity to make financial arrangements with American Cemetery Consultants. If you have not been contacted about the new mausoleum, and are interested, only a short time remains on our survey period. Only those families that contract for spaces now will be assured burial places in the Memorial. Remember, the final size of the building will be determined by the number of families that select spaces during this part of the program.



God made the world, "saw that it was good," and gave it to us to care for and share.

"God has entrusted the world to us, and we must steer all development toward the human person, not merely toward financial gain." (LS 4)

"We have forgotten that we ourselves are dust of the earth; our very bodies are made up of her elements, we breathe her air and we receive life an refreshment from her waters." (LS 2)

Outside the Catholic Church, other Churches and Christian communities – and other religions as well – have expressed deep concern and offered valuable reflections on issues which all of us find disturbing.

To give just one striking example, I would mention the statements made by the beloved Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew, with whom we share the hope of full ecclesial communion. Patriarch Bartholomew has spoken in particular of the need for each of us to repent of the ways we have harmed the planet, for "inasmuch as we all generate small ecological damage," we are called to acknowledge "our contribution, smaller or greater, to the disfigurement and destruction of creation." He has repeatedly stated this firmly and persuasively, challenging us to acknowledge our sins against creation: "For human beings... to destroy the biological diversity of God's creation; for human beings to degrade the integrity of the earth by causing changes in its climate, by stripping the earth of its natural forests or destroying its wetlands; for human beings to contaminate the earth's waters, its land, its air, and its life - these are sins."

For "to commit a crime against the natural world is a sin against ourselves and a sin against God." We should see the world as a "sacrament," he tells us, a way of sharing life with God and our neighbors. We meet on the earth, and we humans are drawn, from her dust. (LS # 7,8,9)


