

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

HOLY WEEK CELEBRATION IN THE PHILIPPINES

The Philippines, a mainly Catholic country, unites faithfully with the Universal Church in celebrating the Lenten Season highlighted by the Holy Week with abundant local colors unique to its culture. Via Crucis (Way of the Cross), both inside and outside the church is a common sight during the entire season. The narrative of the passion is sung in some areas by sponsoring groups during this

period. Various activities during the Holy Week celebrate the mysteries of salvation accompanied by Jesus Christ in the last days of his earthly life. All the rites like the Blessing and Procession of Palms and the following Eucharistic celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Celebration of the Lord's Passion, the Easter Vigil and the following Masses on Easter Sunday find all parish churches throughout the country packed with the faithful.

The Lord's Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem is commemorated by means of a solemn procession. The people gather in a suitable place outside the church and even sometimes in town plaza to which the procession is directed. While in procession the faithful sing and wave branches of the palm tree. These branches are blessed at the start of the celebration so that they may be carried in procession, and after which are devoutly kept at home to call to mind the victory

of Christ as celebrated by the same procession.

Within the week after Palm Sunday thru Saturday, Lenten Recollections with the communal celebration of the Rite of Reconciliation keep churches busy. Also, families come to church for their family devotion and renewal of faith at any time of the day within the week. The Easter Triduum which begins the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper accelerates the weeklong celebration that culminates on Easter Sunday. These are public holidays in the country.

On Holy Thursday the faithful adore the Blessed Sacrament in a meticulously decorated tabernacle, not only individually but by families or church groups and for a suitable time that lasts until midnight.

On Good Friday, after the celebration of the Lord's Passion, a huge procession of "pasos" around the downtown takes place in every parish. Images of life size saints, scenes, events and characters in the Gospel accounts of the Passion and Death of Jesus are displayed and venerated during the procession accompanied by a big number of people with rosaries and candles in their hands. This major activity aims to evangelize through


visual/physical depiction of the Paschal Mystery. Likewise it aims to renew the faith of the People of God by instilling in their hearts and minds the immensity of God's love for us by Jesus' dying on the cross. Finally, it is meant to remind everyone that we are a pilgrim people journeying in this world towards God's kingdom.

On Holy Saturday the Church awaits at the Lord's tomb in prayer and fasting, meditating on the Lord's Passion and Death and awaiting his Resurrection. Hence, the parishes are quiet even if people come to visit the church without any liturgical activity.

The Easter Celebration beginning with the Sacred Vigil tops all activities during the Lenten season particularly the Holy Week. The celebration is done with great solemnity beginning with the blessing of the fire which takes place at the patio of the church with the faithful gathered around a huge flame. After the solemn

Mass with all the liturgical figures, the "Salubong" takes place around four o'clock in the morning (4am). It is a sacred tradition among Filipinos to have the "Encuentro" or meeting between the Risen Christ and Mary, the Mater Dolorosa. The image of the Resurrection meets the image of the Blessed Mother covered with black veil. The Mater Dolorosa symbolizes the Church in mourning at the death of Jesus. A young girl dressed as an angel singing the Regina Coeli removes the veil covering Mary's image inviting all to rejoice for Jesus Christ is risen from the dead! This is the centrality of our faith. Jesus Christ is our Lord and Savior. ALLELUIA!

Where do Palm Sunday palms come from and where should they go?

Ever Wonder

Answer:

The Palm Sunday celebration has ancient origins. Beginning the liturgy "outside" the church, we symbolically reenact Christ's entry into Jerusalem. The crowds in ancient Israel waved palm branches – a symbol of royalty – to welcome Jesus. These days, obtaining palms takes a lot of planning and coordination, as hundreds of thousands of churches worldwide need them on the same day! Many in the United States order palms from Florida, California, Texas, or Central America. Many companies stress the sustainability of their production and the just wages paid to their workers.

The palms used on Palm Sunday are blessed at Mass. This means they shouldn't end up in the trash! Many people weave palms into crosses or families display them in their homes. If you do not plan on displaying your palms throughout the year, they should be burned, buried, or left at the church. In the final case, the palms are burned to provide the ashes for next year's Ash Wednesday service.

PRISON MINISTRY


Want to participate in a prison visit co-hosted by Parole Project and The Frederick Douglass Project?
