

Dear Parishioner,

After forty-six years of serving as a priest in the Diocese of Baton Rouge, including the past eighteen years of serving our faith community of St. Jean Vianney, our dear Pastor, Fr. Tom, is retiring in June. Fr. Tom has shepherded our Parish well in the spirit of St. Jean Vianney (the Patron Saint of Parish Priests.) During his years in our Parish, he has led us with compassion, humility and perseverance through the storms of hurricane Katrina, the unprecedented flood of 2016 and most recently, the worldwide Covid pandemic. Throughout, he never wavered. He continued to say Mass and run our Parish as usual, even if it had to be done remotely. Aside from Mass, he nurtured our faith by offering Parish missions, retreats and adult religious education classes. He brought to fruition the building of our long-awaited parish gymnasium, our covered walkway for the church, remodel and built permanent buildings to our schools. In gratitude for his leadership and to wish him well in retirement, we are collecting donations as a gift.



# Ever Wonder About...

## SHARING YOUR FAITH

#### Question:

My friend has never heard of Christ and I want to share the Gospel with her but I'm afraid to. How do I share my faith?

#### Answer:

There are a lot of ways to bring up the topic of religion, without being judgmental or pushy. Begin by asking what her thoughts are about religion, or what her experience was growing up. Finding common ground is often easier than you think, because the questions and problems we have about God, the presence of evil, our purpose in life, and our relationship with God are universal concerns.

Why are you afraid? If you do not want to insult or offend someone, don't be pushy or judgmental. If you are uncertain about how to explain your own faith, do a little reading or practice with a friend. If you measure success only by this person converting, focus your attention more on beginning the conversation, not on bringing it to a perfect close! Faith is a journey of many acts of belief, many discussions about God, and many choices about how we practice what we preach. In some we will have great success; in others we will need forgiveness and perseverance. The most important thing to keep in mind is that the Holy Spirit is always at work and our most humble efforts can bear great fruit. Have faith in God because he has faith in you!

## **DOULA TRAINING**

Doula Training- Catholic Volunteers Needed: A Birth Doula is a non-medical birth support person trained to provide continuous emotional, physical, educational, and spiritual support to women in crisis pregnancy.

Volunteers must complete 24 hours of comprehensive and collaborative training and commit to serving 2 mothers a year while serving in the program. Doula volunteers will work in teams of 3 to serve 1 mother directly throughout her pregnancy, birth, and postpartum period.

This program has been developed in tandem with the Baton Rouge Diocese, Catholic Charities, local crisis pregnancy centers, and maternal wellness providers.

## PRISON MINISTRY

#### **VOLUNTEER WITH PAROLE PROJECT**

When formally incarcerated individuals reenter our community, they need support and help navigating the skills needed to be successful. Volunteers can help in several of the programs and classes. Time commitment depends on the class, usually one 2-hour class, every other week. Topics include:

Healthcare Navigation: how to navigate the healthcare system  $\theta$  very basic level with Medicaid knowledge

Employment Skills: how to look for jobs  $\theta$  appropriate attire for interviews  $\theta$  mock job interviews

Technology Skills: hands on class  $\theta$  how to utilize the cell phone  $\theta$  working on laptops, using emails


Will you welcome the vocation prayer materials into your home for one week and pray for the current future vocations (religious, sisters, deacons, and priests)?

## REGISTRATION OPEN FOR ACTS RETREAT

Men's Retreat Date: Aug. 10-13

Retreatant Registration are due by June 18th

The intent of an ACTS retreat is to provide an opportunity for a personal encounter with Jesus Christ. The purpose of the retreat is to promote intentional Christ-centered discipleship and build parish community.

When: The retreat begins Thursday evening, Aug. 10th with check-in for retreatants at 5pm to 5:30pm in the St. George KAC. We will return to St. George on Aug. 13th for 11:30am Mass with a reception in the KAC to follow.

Where: Tracy Center, Baton Rouge, LA

Cost: Retreat amount is \$350 to help defer overall retreat expenses. Payment must be made within 7 days after notification of being selected (early July). You will get an email to pay online using the St George website. NO DEPOSIT IS REQUIRED. Financial aid is also available and can be requested on the registration form.

Space on the retreat is limited to 36, and registration is open to all men, 21 years and older. Please note that St George Parishioners are given first priority. Those outside of the parish are encouraged to apply and if necessary, will be placed on a waiting list and contacted if space becomes available.

In the event there are more than 36 applications, retreatants will be selected by a blind-lottery, after discernment and prayer, during the week of June 19th. Everyone who applies will be notified by June 29.

Please note due to retreat schedule, it is advised that retreatants do not plan any remote work or work calls while attending the retreat.


