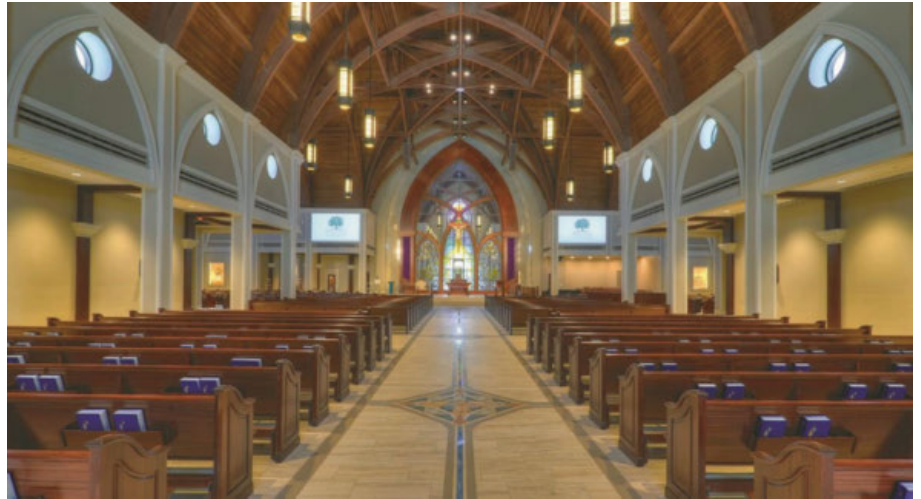

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

June 18, 2023

11TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Solemnity of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (Friday, June 16, 2023)

June, traditionally, is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Friday after the Feast of Corpus Christi is the Feast of the Sacred Heart, always in June. The heart symbolizes love, mercy, tenderness, compassion. Our God has a heart! His Sacred Heart is literally on fire with those noble sentiments, and I find that very consoling.

The heart of God burns with compassion! On the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus the Church presents us this mystery for our contemplation: the mystery of the heart of a God who feels compassion and who bestows all his love upon humanity. A mysterious love, which in the texts of the New Testament is revealed to us as God's boundless and passionate love for mankind. God does not lose heart in the face of ingratitude or rejection by the people he has chosen; rather, with infinite mercy he sends his only-begotten Son into the world to take upon himself the fate of a shattered love, so that by defeating the power of evil and death he could restore to human beings enslaved by sin their dignity as sons and daughters.

But this took place at great cost—the only-begotten Son of the Father was sacrificed on the Cross: "Having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end" (cf. Jn 13:1). The symbol of this love which transcends death is his side, pierced by a spear. The Apostle John, an eyewitness, tells us: "one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water" (cf. Jn 19:34).

Our hearts, like the heart of Jesus, have been pierced. No one escapes sorrow in their life. When our dreams have been dashed or our trust betrayed, our hearts are pierced as was the Heart of Jesus. Sometimes we may react in anger and aggression, but even this anger is a sign of the depth of the pain we are in, a cry lifted to heaven for mercy and help. At other times we have born

our sorrow in silence and in patient love and in so doing we have become more like Jesus.

We've loved and been betrayed and decided to keep loving.

The mystery of the love of the heart of Jesus is that even after betrayal Jesus continues to love us. Even after his death, when his heart is pierced by a lance, he pours out blood and water, symbols of the sacraments, his continued presence within us. There are many times in our lives, no doubt, in which we can look back on ways we reacted for which we are sorry. We haven't continued to love, we've perhaps collapsed inward to protect ourselves or lashed outward in anger. But I bet there is at least one time, if not more, in which we have decided to keep loving, even if we stumbled along in trying to carry out what we have decided to do. In that decision, in those sometimes fumbling steps, we have been like the Sacred Heart of Jesus. And for any of those times in which we haven't kept loving when we've been hurt or outraged by the actions of another, we can find right now our refuge in Jesus' most Sacred Heart, where he continues to love us with great tenderness. The more we choose to love, the more we become like the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Answer:

The role of the Church in the world has taken different forms over time, but the theme is the same. Be disciples in it! As the lay faithful — that is, not vowed priest or religious — we are called to live and love in the circumstances of our daily lives.

St. John Paul II wrote a document about the laity. In it he wrote, "In their situation in the world God manifests His plan and communicates to them their particular vocation of seeking the Kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs and by ordering them according to the plan of God" (On the Lay Members of Christ's Faithful, 15).

God wants us in the hospitals, the board rooms, the law offices, the food pantries, and the little league games! We are to engage in the affairs of the world. But when we're there, we should live the plan of God.

We need to respect those around us, engage in just business and legal practices, and love our children. We should care for the earth, use our money wisely, and get to know our neighbors. We must advocate for social policies that respect human dignity and human freedom. No matter our state in life, we are invited to build the kingdom of God!

As Christians, our most urgent task is the compelling proclamation of the Gospel, one that not only shares it in an attractive – and concentrated – way, but that also offers people a way of seeing reality, and of making sense of the world, history, and life that is vastly different from the story our modern culture tells.



Until this happens, the Christian faith is often experienced as a mere set of rules and disciplines, and simply going to Church isn't likely to lead a person to embark on the great adventure that is following Jesus and continuing His mission of the rescuing of this world.

The Gospel message is simple: Jesus, out of love, died to rescue man from his sins, and calls him to a life of friendship with God.

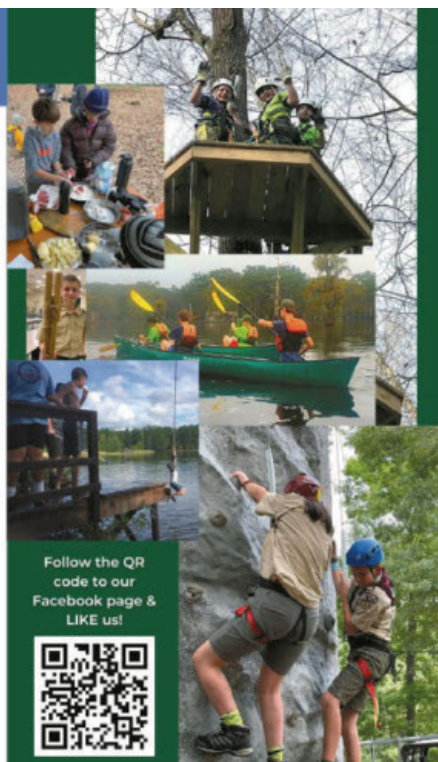
