

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Fruit of Silence is Prayer

Recently, six of our St. George parishioners and I were in Grand Coteau, Louisiana, at the Jesuit Spirituality Center to make our one-on-one directed retreats. Many men and women are familiar with "preached" group retreats at Manresa and formerly Cenacle. However, the Jesuit Spirituality Center is unique in that it offers one-on-one Ignatian-directed retreats.

The following is an interview with Fr. Howard Gray, S.J. explaining what directed retreat is. -Fr. Yi

Many ordinary Catholics may not know what an "Ignatian retreat" means. How do you explain it to them?

A retreat in the Ignatian tradition is a process of prayer and reflection that follows the rhythm of revelation from creation, sinfulness and reconciliation to the life of Jesus; his passion and death; and his resurrection. The Ignatian retreat climaxes in a prayer that celebrates our participation in the loving engagement of God with the world (i.e., the so -called Contemplation to Attain Divine Love).

What's your definition of a retreat?

A retreat is a focused encounter with God that centers on the quality of my personal response to God's self-revelation in prayer and reflection.

What's the difference between a preached retreat and a directed retreat?

A preached retreat is a presentation that offers the principles and rhythms of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola to a group whereas a directed retreat adapts the principles and rhythm of the Exercises to the individual needs and graces of the one person making the Exercises.

How is an Ignatian retreat different from others a Catholic or Christian might make?

The Exercises are geared toward making a decision: a life choice, a reformation of a choice or a deepening and renewal of a choice already made. It's the dynamic of the Exercises of a choice under the inspiration of God that distinguishes the Exercises from simply "a prayerful time of reflection."

What are the best reasons for someone to make an Ignatian retreat, either preached or directed?

(An Ignatian retreat) has to be adapted to the temperament, the time available and the personal spiritual history of each individual. For example, can this person sustain solitude? Is this person familiar with the discipline of daily prayer? Is this person familiar with the Christian/ Catholic tradition? The discerning assessment of readiness has to emerge from a relationship with a woman or a man who asks about a retreat.

Why would someone want to make an Ignatian retreat today?

This again will depend on the history, temperament and past religious experiences of an individual. God calls in any culture, chronological moment or circumstance. People ask about the Ignatian retreat for a variety of initial reasons. The real discernment is to note how the



reasoning for entering the Exercises becomes "rearranged" by the action of God during a retreat (annotation 15).

What's your advice to someone who is making an Ignatian retreat for the first time?

Get rest, pray for an open and generous heart, and do some preliminary reflection like Psalm 23 or the first recorded words of Jesus in John's Gospel: "What are you looking for?" and then "Come and see." Gently engage a person's desires for the retreat experience, be that retreat long or short.

What's the purpose or goal of an Ignatian retreat?

Again, it is to find guidance about a state of life, to reorient a state of life or to deepen one's appreciation for their life with God.

Ever Wonder About...

ROMAN COLLAR

Question:

Why do priests wear a Roman collar?

Answer:

The practice of priests wearing the Roman collar developed in the mid-nineteenth century as an alternative to wearing the cassock which in some places was seen as impractical or which was even outlawed by anti-Catholic legislation. Since its introduction, it has taken different forms, and if you visit different countries today, you will see variation in what priests wear.

The Code of Canon Law simply observes that priests wear "suitable ecclesiastical garb" according to the judgments of the national bishops conferences and local custom (no. 284). The US Bishops have instructed that outside of liturgical functions, a "black suit and Roman collar are the usual formal attire for priests. The use of the cassock is at the discretion of the cleric." Priests who are members of religious communities are to follow the rules of their institute regarding the habit or other approved clothing.

In the end, whether a priest wears the Roman collar, a religious habit, or, as is the case in many European countries, a suit and tie (to distinguish them from Protestant clergy who wear a collar) the goal of their clerical clothing is to serve as a sign of their commitment to guide and to serve, and to also allow them to be truly public figures because they are ordained for the service of all.



VOLUNTEER WITH DOULA TRAINING

Doula Training- Catholic Volunteers Needed: A Birth Doula is a non-medical birth support person trained to provide continuous emotional, physical, educational, and spiritual support to women in crisis pregnancy.

Volunteers must complete 24 hours of comprehensive and collaborative training and commit to serving 2 mothers a year while serving in the program. Doula volunteers will work in teams of 3 to serve 1 mother directly throughout her pregnancy, birth, and postpartum period.






