PASTOR'S MESSAGE

August 20, 2023

20TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

My Journey to the Diaconate

My life has taken many twists and turns. Unfortunately, my faith did the same. Although born into a very devout Catholic family and attending Catholic schools, my faith and prayer life were almost nonexistent. When God sent Christy and I a daughter to adopt, I was 39 and at my lowest spiritually.

For some reason, I had a very strong desire that Claire must be Baptized and attend catholic school. The irony is, I was so adamant she have these things, while I never once appreciated or used these same gifts in my own life. As she started school at St. George we began to go to Mass as a family. I didn't have faith but went because deep down I knew it was the right thing and I needed to set an example for Claires life.

Slowly, I began to go to church and school events and was amazed at all the people who gave so generously of their time and talents to serve God and this parish. One day, Fr. Brad Doyle walked down that aisle, as our new priest, and lit a fire in me that I had never before felt. I had never met a priest like him, and I could not figure out why someone so athletic, good looking, smart, and confident would throw all that away to become a priest.

My curiosity in trying to figure him out or what was he getting out of the deal opened my mind, for the first time in my life, to let my defenses down and listen for God and his desires for my own life. Fr. Brad challenged some men to go and climb a Pico De Orizaba. The second highest peak in North America. We would train for a year to get in shape and conquer that peak in Mexico, then we would climb Tepeyac Hill to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and offer thanks and praise to God through Mary for our journey.

While training, I began to say the rosary, to Our Lady of Guadalupe, really to just help pass the time easier. At the

end of that trip the last thing we did was celebrate a private Mass at the shrine. At that Mass, the Holy Spirit used Fr. Brad to call me specifically to the service of Christ as a Deacon. From that moment on, I accepted His will for my life and used my free will to cooperate. He has done the rest!



My diaconate is the fruit of all the great people of St. George's prayer, service, generosity, and love of God. This parish will always remain special to me, you are my family! I leave you with this scripture to pray with. Habakkuk 2:1-3 "Then the Lord answered me and said, for the vision is a witness for the appointed time, a testimony to the end, it will not disappoint. If it delays, wait for it, it will surely come, it will not be late."

I love this verse. It shows clearly that God and His Truth and Love never change or move. It is always present in each of us. By virtue of our Baptism and Confirmation we have been given all the Grace needed to serve God and get to Heaven. I may have waited until fifty to accept His call, but it was not late, it surely came and has not disappointed.

It is never too late to return to the Father or grow deeper in your own personal relationship with Christ. Ask for something new and beautiful in your own life. He will always honor your request, and you will never be disappointed with His response. May the light of Christ continue to shine brightly on St. George.

Question:

I volunteer every once in a while. How can I incorporate serving the poor in my everyday life?

Answer:

Registration In the Gospels, Jesus is very clear about emphasizing outreach to vulnerable persons on the margins of society. These may be the materially poor, the disabled, the lonely, or any others whose circumstances drive them from mainstream society. We can all respond to Christ's call to love by incorporating direct service into our regular life routine. Here are some ideas to find your niche:

Consider your life. Before you look for direct service opportunities, consider your schedule, commitment levels, and personal gifts. When can you help out and how regularly? Where have you volunteered in the past that has felt like a good fit? Do you have any particular skills or personality traits that lend you to particular work?

Do some research. There are a lot of structured ways you can get involved in your community. Your parish might have a social concerns outreach program. If not, ask friends and family. A simple online search for local nonprofits can also expose you to new opportunities.

Be open to God's invitation. The chance to serve may be closer than you think. Befriending an elderly neighbor, widowed and far from children, is an act of serving the poor. Keep your eyes and heart open!






