### Ministry Highlight: Called To Be A Mom

What is Called To Be A Mom?

"Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching." Hebrews 10:24-25

Called To Be A Mom is a ministry for moms at St. George. We meet moms wherever they are in life. Members are encouraged to attend events that meet their needs without feeling pressured to attend everything (because we get it... moms are busy).

I joined Called To Be A Mom (CTBAM) in 2018 when my oldest child started pre-k at St. George. The summer before he started Pre-K, we signed up to play on a YMCA sports team and requested to play with St. George families to introduce him to other Pre-K students before the start of school. Laurie Moran was one of the CTBAM chairs at the time and her son also played on the sports team. She told me about CTBAM, and it sounded like a perfect fit for my needs. It was a great way to get to know other moms in the church that were similarly situated in their motherhood journey. It also provided me with mentorship from moms who were willing to share their past experiences.

Unfortunately, CTBAM, like so many things, took a pause during COVID-19. Last year, I answered a calling to join the CTBAM leadership and co-chair with Angelle Zewe and Mandy Tumminello. We knew it would be a challenge to get the ministry to what it once had been and that it would take more than one year. We were successful in bringing back several events that promoted fellowship, spiritual growth, service, and quality time with our children.

This year Mandy Tumminello and I returned as chairs and brought on Ashlyn Bergeron. On August 24 we kicked off the year with fellowship, mentorship, and celebration of the beginning of the school year at our wine and cheese social. If you missed the kickoff event, it isn't too late to join CTBAM.

Our next event is focused on self-care. Motherhood is hard. If we want to do our best at taking care of our families, then we also must take care of ourselves. This includes our physical, mental, and spiritual health. On September 24 we are having a group workout and dinner to discuss and promote the importance of self-care in all these areas of our lives.



Other upcoming events include Trunk-or-Treat (family friendly); Pizza, PJs, and Prosecco (mom only ornament exchange); Potluck & Prayer in the Marian Prayer Garden; Easter Egg Hunt (family friendly); Spring Couples Night; and Popsicles in the Park (family friendly).

## Ever Wonder About...

### CATHOLIC VS. PROTESTANT BIBLES

#### Question:

Why are Catholic and Protestant Bibles different?

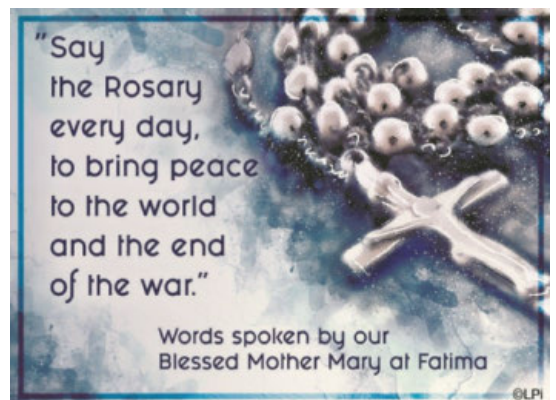
#### Answer:

Since the earliest days of the Church, Christians used a Greek translation of the Old Testament known as the Septuagint. This collection of the texts of the Hebrew Scriptures included 46 books.

At the time of the Protestant Reformation in the 1500s, the Protestant reformers began to create their own translations of the Bible (into local languages) and some began to question why the Jewish Scriptures would have included texts that were written in Greek, because, they assumed, the only valid Jewish Scriptures would have been written in Hebrew.

And so, they decided to remove seven books from the Old Testament: Baruch, Sirach, 1 and 2 Maccabees, Tobit, Judith and Wisdom (as well as portions of the Books of Daniel and Esther). This means that the Protestant Old Testament only includes 39 books, while Catholic Bibles continue to include those original 46 books. Both Catholic and Protestant Bibles include 27 books and letters in the New Testament.
