

# PASTOR'S MESSAGE

January 14, 2024

#### 2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been purchased at a price. Therefore glorify God in your body." (1 Cor 6:17-20)

#### Padre Pio hears the confession of a Freemason

I am Alberto Del Fante, a lawyer from Bologna, a former Freemason of the thirty-third degree. I was converted by Padre Pio. My wife had cancer and she was close to death. There was no more hope. A friend told her about Padre Pio, a humble Capuchin Priest in San Giovanni Rotondo, because she heard

that many people had been healed by him and had returned home healthy. I was standing at her deathbed as she begged me in tears to go to Padre Pio and ask him for her healing. She knew that I was a Freemason and a terrible enemy of the Church. At first, I rejected and mocked the idea. 'Science is powerless; such a poor monk will surely not be able to do anything either,' I thought to myself. However, as I saw her crying in this deplorable condition, I wanted to fulfill her wish and said, All right, I'll go! Not because I believe in him, but because I can try my luck, as in the lottery.

I left and I arrived that same evening in San Giovanni Rotondo. The following moming, I stood in line for confession after I had participated in the lengthy Holy Mass. When it was

my turn, I did not kneel down right away but remained standing in front of Padre Pio. I asked him if I could speak with him briefly. Padre Pio velled at me, Young man, don't waste my time! What are you here for? To try your luck in the lottery? If you want to make a confession then kneel down; otherwise, let me hear the confessions of these poor people who have been waiting. Astounded to hear the same expression that I had used with my wife and shaken by his unexpected rudeness I knelt down, not out of conviction, but somehow automatically. I was completely unprepared for a confession and could not even say two words! I was even less able to recall any of my sins. As soon as I knelt down, however, Padre Pio's tone of voice changed and he became mild and fatherly. By asking me guestions, he gradually unveiled all the sins of my former life. And the sins I had committed were numerous! With my head lowered, I listened to his questions and always answered, Yes. Overwhelmed, and at the same time moved, I remained petrified. Finally, Padre Pio asked me, Do you have any other sins that you would like to

confess? I answered, No. I was certain that he had already said all my sins, and since he obviously knew my life in detail, I was sure I did not have anything else to confess.

Then Padre Pio said with surprising stemness, Aren't you ashamed? The young lady, whom you had return to America a short time ago, gave birth to a son. This child is your flesh and blood, and like a raven you abandoned mother and child. It was all true. I did not answer. I broke into tears and cried bitterly. I was crushed. As I cried, bent over the kneeler, covering my face with my hands, Padre Pio gently placed his arm around me,

drew close to my ear and whispered with a sniffle, My child, I redeem you with the price of my precious blood

At those words. I felt as if my heart were cut in two with a fine blade. Bent over, I cried. Several times I lifted my head, my face overrun with tears, and repeated, Father, forgive me, forgive me, forgive me! Padre Pio, who had already put his arm around me, drew me closer still, and began to cry with me. A wonderfully sweet peace filled my spirit. I suddenly felt how this indescribable pain was transformed into an unbelievable joy. Padre, I said. I belong to you! Do with me what you will! He wiped away his own tears and whispered to me, Support me by helping others. Then he added, Give my greetings to your wife! When I arrived at home, my



wife had been healed."

At the time, Alberto Del Fante did not understand the full depth of these surprising words, which Padre Pio, crying, whispered in his ear during this Confession, 'My child, I redeem you with the price of my precious blood.'" Of course, it was Jesus himself who said this through this simple Capuchin father, because no one other than the Divine Redeemer had shed his Precious Blood once and for all, for the forgiveness of sins. No one other than Jesus Himself offers the infinite treasures of His grace through the priest in the Sacrament of Confession. Padre Pio's words may also be figuratively applied to Padre Pio, himself, since it was through his stigmata that he intimately participated in the Passion of the Lord and did, in fact, shed his blood for the conversion of Alberto Del Fante, and for all of his 14 million spiritual children.



# Ever Wonder About...

# MASS CELEBRATED AROUND THE WORLD

#### Question:

Is the Catholic Mass really celebrated the same throughout the whole world?

#### Answer:

One of the truisms of the Catholic Faith is that "wherever you go in the world, the Mass is the same." In fact, the answer to this question is both "yes" and "no."

On the one hand, the essential elements of the Roman Rite are the same. The structure of the Mass as it is presented in the Roman Missal is consistent and this is one of the beauties of belonging to a liturgical tradition.

On the other hand, however, there are elements of celebrations that can vary depending on the country or even local region you might be in. For example, in certain parts of the world, certain feasts and solemnities are celebrated on different days (even here in the United States the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord can be celebrated on Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter or it may take the place of the Seventh Sunday of Easter, depending on what diocese you are in).

Whether it is the use of certain liturgical colors, local celebrations of regional saints, special seasonal blessings of crops or produce, or the use of dance and processions all demonstrate a sort of organic variety that can exist even within our established liturgical tradition. While we always respect what is essential to the rite, such local variations and traditions are very much in keeping with the vision of liturgical renewal and adaption envisioned by the Second Vatican Council's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (nos. 37-40).
