

# PASTOR'S MESSAGE

March 17, 2024

### **5TH SUNDAY IN LENT**

The past week, I have been reminiscing about my time with my mom who had passed this past July. About five years ago, I brought her from Texas ton Baton Rouge to see medical professionals for a particular condition she is experiencing. As long as I can remember, she had been energetic and always-on-the-go kind of a woman. She used to do aerobics every day until her health began to decline 5 years ago. She said her mind wanted to move, but her body was no longer cooperating. She was experiencing, in a sense, a dying of herself—her youthful energy has dissipated and her body is getting frail, prone to break.

If you think about it, there is a lot of dying that is mixed in with living. Every time we pass from one stage of life to another, something in us dies and something new is born. I remember one Christmas, I bought mom an iPod and filled it with Korean pop songs from her familiar era, but she said that she no longer enjoys that music. For some strange reason, she said, she wanted to hear religious music. Similarly, she no longer enjoyed Korean soap dramas. Instead, she enjoyed watching spiritual retreat talks given by Korean priests on YouTube.

Jesus used an image of the grain of wheat buried in the cold damp earth as in a tomb. He said, "unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit." There is a sense in which we must die if we are to live fully and fruitfully. We have to die to self in order to realize our full potential as human beings and children of God. Jesus set himself as the example. He sacrificed his life; his life wasn't taken from him; he gave it, out of love for us. When the moment of death arrived he was filled with fear and doubt as he said, "My soul is troubled." But he received the strength and courage from praying to His Father.

Concretely, what does all this dying to self or dying to our own will mean for you and me everyday of our lives? It means dying to our pride and asking for help; admitting our problem and seeking help from others and God; forgiving the person from our hearts and treating her/him with love once again. To die to self, then is to choose eternal life. This week let us ponder what in our lives that we need to modify or eliminate so that we can bear more fruit.

# Ever Wonder About...

### **BLESSED SACRAMENT**

### Question:

Why do parishes have the Blessed Sacrament in a separate room?

### Answer:

While many Catholics of a certain age have memories of the Blessed Sacrament being housed in the tabernacle on the high altar of the church, many parishes in the decades since the Second Vatican Council have chosen to build a separate space - a reservation chapel - where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. Although this practice is not universal, it is in keeping with the guidance offered by the US Bishops in their document Built of Living Stones (see nos 77-78). The goal is to create a space that is separated from the nave and sanctuary, but which is "integrally connected with the church" which can foster "reverence and can provide the guiet and focus needed for personal prayer." This can be especially important for communities that have continuous eucharistic adoration, allowing people to come and pray in a space separate from the normal activities of parish

The practice of reserving the Eucharist in a separate space — or in a dignified location away from the altar where Mass is celebrated — is that it emphasizes the importance of the liturgy itself, which is the "source and summit" of the life of the Church.

As with many things in the Church, the practice of placing the tabernacle in the sanctuary or in a separate chapel is not universal (as can be seen in visits to historic churches in Rome and other places). The important thing is that as communities question where to place the tabernacle, they listen to the voice of the Church, explore the ancient and varied liturgical tradition of the Church, consider the needs and life of the community, and also take into account the architecture and limits of the spaces they might already have.

# Meet this Ministry: VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

LEAD COORDINATORS, TEACHERS, AIDES, ARTS AND CRAFTS, REFRESHMENTS, DRAMA, NURSERY COORDINATORS, COSTUME COORDINATORS, AND MUSIC LEADERS ARE NEEDED FOR ONE WEEK DURING THE SUMMER TO SPREAD THE GOOD NEWS OF THE GOSPEL TO CHILDREN. ADULT AND TEEN VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED FOR VBS. ADULT AND TEEN VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED FOR VBS. MINISTRY LEAD MOLLY ROSE EXPLAINS:

# HOW MANY MEMBERS DO YOU HAVE IN THIS MINISTRY?

Each year we have about 50 adult volunteers and 70 teen volunteers who help run all areas of VBS from small group leadership to drama, crafts, music, Pre-K, snacks, and games.

Diocesan youth protection policy states that a certain number of adult volunteers are required, so without these, we would not be able to offer Vacation Bible School.

# HOW OFTEN ARE THIS MINISTRY'S MEETINGS, AND WHAT ACTIVITIES DO MEMBERS WORK ON THROUGHOUT THE YEAR?

We develop our theme about 10 months prior to the week of VBS. This allows volunteers to start brainstorming early. The section leaders meet about twice in the spring prior to VBS. These meetings allow us to plan for a successful week of VBS. We also have a large informational meeting with all the adult and teen volunteers to go over logistics.

# HOW DO THE MEMBERS LIVE OUT THE GOSPEL IN THIS MINISTRY AND ENCOURAGE FELLOWSHIP?

Jesus said, "let the little children come to Me." VBS focuses on bringing each child closer to Jesus Christ in interactive ways through the help of many wonderful volunteers who share their faith. Activities and crafts are incorporated into the morning to help children draw closer to Christ. Dedicating a morning every day for a week can be challenging, but the rewards come in multitudes, as many volunteers will attest.

# WHAT GOALS DOES THIS MINISTRY HAVE FOR THIS YEAR AND NEXT?

VBS is scheduled for June 10-14 with the theme "SCUBA: Diving into friendship with God."

Each year we try to schedule VBS around the same time so that parents can plan accordingly.

Our 2023 VBS had record participation and volunteer levels that we hope to see again this year.







