

# PASTOR'S MESSAGE

# 4TH SUNDAY OF EASTER



Dear Parishioners,

Bishop Michael Duca of the Diocese of Baton Rouge announced his intention to lower the age of Confirmation to 7th grade. A diocesan committee has been formed to help parishes transition formation of our young people from 11th grade to 7th grade. Here are the key points of his decision:

**Cultural Challenges**: Bishop Duca believes that children today face a culture that is often hostile to their Catholic faith and morals, especially through social media and other influences.

**Full Grace of the Sacrament**: By lowering the age of Confirmation, he aims to provide children with the full grace of the Sacrament of Confirmation earlier, helping them to meet these challenges with the strength and gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Historical Context: Before the Second Vatican Council, children were confirmed at a younger age. The age was raised to high school afterward, but Bishop Duca feels that the current cultural context necessitates a return to earlier Confirmation.

**Transition Plan**: He has outlined a transition plan to accommodate older students who are not yet confirmed, ensuring a smooth implementation across parishes.

Formation and Support: The Diocese will provide support to parish leaders to help them adapt to this change and to better form children into missionary disciples.

Our Confirmation Program director and Youth Minister, Catherine Stewart Broussard, will help us transition over the course of next few years. A draft of the program is as follows: Spring 2025:

Confirm: Class of 2026

Fall 2025: 10th & 11th Grade

Confirm: Class of 2027 & 2028

Spring 2026: 10th & 11th Grade Confirm: Class of 2027 & 2028

Fall 2026: 9th & 10th Grade

Confirm: Class of 2029 & 2030

Spring 2027: 9th & 10th Grade
 Confirm: Class of 2029 & 2030

Fall 2027: 8th & 9th Grade

Confirm: Class of 2031 & 2032

Spring 2028: 8th & 9th Grade

Confirm: Class of 2031 & 2032

Fall 2028: 7th & 8th Grade

Confirm: Class of 2033 & 2034

Spring 2029: 7th & 8th grade

Confirm: Class of 2033 & 2034

Fall/spring 2029/30: 7th Grade Alone

Single Session of Classes & Confirm only Class of 2035



# TRADITION OF GENUFLECTION

### Question:

Why do Catholics genuflect?

### Answer:

Genuflection is an act of devotion that literally means "to bend the knee." For many Catholics, it's an almost automatic gesture that we perform before entering our pew or row of seats at Mass. But, like many of the symbols and gestures of our faith tradition, genuflecting can also be an invitation for deeper reflection.

The practice of "bending the knee" is an ancient way of recognizing the presence of someone greater than we are. It has been said that the practice dates back to the time of Alexander the Great, but it became a common part of etiquette in the royal courts of the Middle Ages. From throne rooms and palaces, it was a small step to genuflecting becoming part of the devotional lives of Christians, who used this secular gesture as a way of recognizing the presence of the One who is King of Kings, especially in the Eucharist.

Today, Catholics are asked to genuflect in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament (whether in the tabernacle or exposed on the altar during eucharistic adoration). So, while it has become second nature to genuflect before entering your seat in church, we should pay attention to where the Blessed Sacrament is kept in each church or chapel that we visit, and genuflect in the direction of the tabernacle where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. In churches or chapels in which the tabernacle is in a separate space, we are invited to simply bow toward the altar.

In addition to genuflecting before the Blessed Sacrament, we are also instructed to genuflect before the cross used for veneration on Good Friday (during the solemn celebrations of the Lord's Passion) and any time a relic of the True Cross is displayed for veneration. This long-standing tradition is a way of honoring the cross as the great sign of our salvation and of showing devotion to the passion of Jesus.

### 70TH ANNIVERSARY MILESTONE

The Knight of Columbus Council 4030 was founded 70 years ago. In the early 1950s, Baton Rouge already had Knights of Columbus actively involved in the local churches. State KC leaders advised that a new council should be established to serve the rapidly growing southeastern region of Baton Rouge. A core group from Baton Rouge Council 969 and Istrouma Council 2807, guided by Father Louis Marionneaux, K.W. Davis, Bill Doran Sr., and a few others, came together to establish Mother of Mercy Council 4030 with 93 charter members. The charter was approved on May 1st, 1955, and the first class was dedicated to Msgr. Marionneaux, the founding Chaplain. Over the past 70 years, hundreds of members have worked for the benefit of the church community.

We have been fortunate and blessed to have priests serve as our Chaplains, with Fr. Nutan Minj recently taking the position after Fr. Bob Banares.

While some of our platforms have evolved over time, the spirit of service and brotherhood remains unchanged. Our goal is to help men, their families, and parishioners come closer to Christ. Our programs and resources provide opportunities to embrace and spread the Catholic faith.

# Explained:

Spiritual retreats are an act of removing oneself from one's daily life for a period of prayer and reflection, with the intent of returning to that daily life transformed.

It was Christ himself who was the greatest and earliest advocate of spiritual retreat. In the Gospels, he is constantly depicted as withdrawing from other people to be alone in prayer. Likewise, participants in a modern retreat most often go somewhere like a retreat center to seek silence, solitude and communion with God. There are many different varieties of retreats; they can be guided and take place in a group setting, or they can be undertaken alone by just one person. Some are focused on a specific topic or theme; some are defined by periods of total silence. Though clerics are compelled by canon law to go on retreat regularly, all faithful are encouraged to make retreat part of their spiritual life.

# HOW MANY MEMBERS DO YOU HAVE IN THIS MINISTRY?

Our Eucharistic Ministry to Homebound, Long Term Care Facilities, Rehabs and Hospitals has more than 60 volunteers who help serve in our Eucharistic Ministry to rehab facilities and hospitals, homebound parishioners, and long term care facilities in our area.

# HOW OFTEN ARE THIS MINISTRY'S MEETINGS, AND WHAT ACTIVITIES DO MEMBERS WORK ON THROUGHOUT THE YEAR?

Some Eucharistic Ministers make visits every week while others serve once a month. Many help serve as substitutes and assist when they are available.

Bringing Christ in the Holy Eucharist to our brothers and sisters who cannot worship with us is the greatest honor. As Catholic Christians, we recognize that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. He is the source of all love and grace, He is the greatest gift we can bring to someone. With a community as large as St. George, it is essential for lay parishioners to help our priests and deacons in this ministry. This ministry encourages fellowship between the Eucharistic Ministers and the people they serve, and between the groups of people who serve together at the various facilities. The relationships developed though this ministry are priceless.

# WHAT GOALS DOES THIS MINISTRY HAVE FOR THIS YEAR AND NEXT?

The goal of this ministry is to continuously meet the needs of the homebound parishioners and residents at long-term care facilities. Many volunteers are needed year round.

Every time we visit someone, we are bringing them Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. This is the greatest gift. We are sent by our parish to show them God's love. This ministry experiences many successes: Often a Eucharistic minister is the one who gives a person the Viaticum, which is food for the journey. The Viaticum is the last consecrated host the person receives before they pass away.


