PASTOR'S MESSAGE

May 25, 2025

6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

A Jewish person would greet a fellow Jew with the word, "Shalom," meaning peace, and the other person would respond, "Aleichem Shalom," meaning 'upon you peace.' The word "Shalom" does not simply denote the absence of conflict; it derives from the root word 'shalam,' which conveys meanings of completeness, fullness, and wholeness. Thus, when you greet someone or bid farewell with "Shalom," you are essentially saying, "May you be full of well-being" or "May health and prosperity be upon you."

On the night of the Last Supper, Jesus prepared his disciples for his impending departure, encouraging them to demonstrate their love for him through loyalty and obedience to his teachings. He assured them they would not be left alone, promising the presence of the Holy Spirit, the Advocate, as their guide and support. Jesus told his disciples, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you." This peace, or 'Shalom Hashem,' is not like the peace the world offers. He urged them not to let their hearts be troubled or afraid, for the Holy Spirit, sent by the Father in Jesus' name, would teach them all things.

Just as the early Church faced fear and uncertainty after Jesus' arrest and death, today's disciples also contend with challenges that cause anxiety and worry. We experience trials such as illness, aging parents, addiction, job loss, and broken relationships. In these moments, we must remember the Lord's promise that the Holy Spirit is with us, granting us true shalom—wholeness, completeness, and fullness of soul even amidst our difficulties.

St. Teresa of Avila, who faced her own grave illnesses and personal trials, encouraged her religious sisters with these words:

"Let nothing disturb you / Let nothing frighten you / All things are passing away: God never changes / Patience obtains all things / Whoever has God lacks nothing / God alone suffices."

These sentiments resonate with the assurance that the Holy Spirit within us provides strength and hope, allowing us to radiate God's peace in our hearts, families, and communities. Patience, as St. Teresa reminds us, can obtain all things. By displaying courage and fortitude during times of disturbance, we can embrace the ultimate reality that God is unchanging and always present.

Ever Wonder About...

SUNDAY MASS

Question:

Why do Catholics need to go to Mass every Sunday?

Answer:

The heart of the Church's instruction that we are to attend Mass on Sundays goes back to the Third Commandment: "Take care to keep holy the sabbath day as the LORD, your God, has commanded you" (Deuteronomy 5:12). Although the Jewish People celebrate the Sabbath on Saturday, the first generations of Christians began to observe the sabbath on Sunday, recognizing how important it is for Christians to celebrate the day that Jesus rose from the dead. As the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults observes, "Sunday extends the celebration of Easter throughout the year ... It makes present the new creation brought about by Christ" (364).

The focus of our Sunday should be the celebration of the Eucharist in the Mass. This is our time to be formed by God's Word and nourished at the table of the Lord, becoming prepared to live out and share our faith in the week that follows. In his encyclical, Dies Domini, Pope Saint John Paul II reminded us that Christians "cannot live their faith or share fully in the life of the Christian community unless they take part regularly in the Sunday Eucharistic assembly" (no. 81). This is why the Church teaches us that Sunday Mass is a non-negotiable part of being a Christian (see Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2192).

Beyond being a time of worship, we should also remember that Sunday is intended to be a day of rest, when we make time for recreation, for sharing meals, and enjoying the company of friends and family. Sunday is given to as a day to take stock of and enjoy the blessings that God has given us (see Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2187). Pope Francis reminds us, "The day of rest, centered on the Eucharist, sheds its light on the whole week, and motivates us to greater concern for nature and the poor" (Laudato Si', no. 237).

Devotions, Explained!

OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP

Explained:

Our Lady of Perpetual Help refers both to a title conferred upon the Blessed Mother as well as to a corresponding icon that dates to the late Middle Ages.

Painted on wood, the original icon has a Byzantine style and depicts the Blessed Mother holding the Christ Child. She is flanked by St. Michael and St. Gabriel, who hold the instruments of Christ's passion, including a spear, nails and the Crown of Thorns. In the image, Christ seemingly leans into his mother's embrace for comfort and strength as he contemplates these objects.

The icon is thought to have originated in Crete, but for 300 years was venerated in the Church of San Matteo in Merulana in Rome. Blessed Pope Pius IX entrusted the image to the Order of Redemptorists, who moved it to the Church of St. Alphonsus. He later established the Feast of Our Lady of Perpetual Help on June 27.

'UPPER ROOM' MEN'S BIBLE STUDY




