

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

June 1, 2025

ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Have you heard of the Rescue Project?

The Rescue Project is a series of 8 weekly sessions designed to share the gospel message in a compelling and engaging way, through a meal, conversation, and prayer in a small group setting. The Rescue Project centers around the idea of "rescue" - being created by God, captured by sin, and then rescued by Christ. The content includes talks led by Father John Riccardo, video series, and companion resources for facilitators and participants. The overarching goal is to help people be "overwhelmed" by the gospel's message, moved to faith, and mobilized for mission. Here is a snippet of what will be covered at the small group meetings:

The Importance of Stories: The Rescue Project proposes another story, another way to see reality...It's the biblical story. The biblical story is a way to make sense of why things happen in life. We don't have to be afraid, anxious, or give into depression or despair when times are tough.

Why is There Something Rather Than Nothing? The beauty of creation leads us to the Creator: God. We have a destination that gives us hope. Hope doesn't mean wishful thinking. It's an anchor, it's certain, it's truth. With the Biblical story people know why they are here, where they are going, and how to get there. Some people have the mindset that there are important people and unimportant people. God loves us and knows each of us by name. There are no unimportant people.

The Enemy is the Enemy: Many people living in our modern world simply reject the notion that the devil exists, let alone that he could play havoc in our lives, but Jesus Himself throughout the gospels speaks often about the reality of the devil and the ways we must face him in the world. Jesus calls him the ruler of the world. (John 12:3) The Lord is the one exposing this enemy of ours for our great benefit. Scripture is like game film so we can see how Satan works. God wants us ready and prepared. God wants us to win.

What Has God Done About It? There is only one way Jesus can get on the cross, only one. He has to want to be there. Jesus said to His disciples: "The ruler of the world is coming (for me). He has no power over me." (John 14:30-31) What is about to happen to me is entirely in my control. No one has power over me. Victim or aggressor? Jesus' death, resurrection, and rescue makes a difference in our lives right now. How does it change me right now? We pray for the grace of unshakeable confidence in the Lordship of Jesus.

Ever Wonder About...

RECEIVING COMMUNION

Question:

Why do some people receive Communion in the hand, while others have it put on the tongue? And is one better than the other?

Answer:

Prior to the liturgical reforms that accompanied the Second Vatican Council, it was the universal practice that Catholics would receive communion "on the tongue," meaning that the one receiving would allow the priest distributing communion to place the consecrated host on their outstretched tongue. At this time, only the priest celebrant (and, on special occasions, priests assisting at the Mass) was allowed to receive the Precious Blood.

Since 1977 (with the approval of the Holy See) the bishops of the United States have officially approved two equally valid options for receiving Holy Communion in Masses celebrated according to the Ordinary Form of the Mass. As the bishops' statement Norms for Holy Communion Under Both Kinds states:

The communicant may choose whether to receive the Body of Christ in the hand or on the tongue. When receiving in the hand, the communicant should be guided by the words of St. Cyril of Jerusalem: "When you approach, take care not to do so with your hand stretched out and your fingers open or apart, but rather place your left hand as a throne beneath your right, as befits one who is about to receive the King. Then receive him, taking care that nothing is lost" (no. 41).

As we noted, both ways of receiving communion are equally valid in the United States and it is important that we always keep the instructions of the bishops in mind as we reflect on which method we might prefer.

Devotions, Explained!

PRAYER AFTER MEALS

Explained:

Just as praying before a meal, praying after a meal is meant to inspire in Christians an attitude of thanksgiving and an acknowledgment of our dependence on God.

Though it is a less common practice in the modern world, early Church fathers like Tertullian and St. Jerome extolled the importance of praying after a meal, and the Christian poet Prudentius composed hymns for before and after meals ("ante cibum" and "post cibum").

There are no "official" prayers for after a meal, but the most common one said by Catholics is this: "We give thee thanks, almighty God, for all your benefits, who lives and reigns forever and ever. And may the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God rest in peace." It is a benediction which recalls our perpetual fellowship with the entire Body of Christ, including those who have passed from this life.

'UPPER ROOM' MEN'S BIBLE STUDY




