

#### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

August 10, 2025

#### 19TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Have you ever witnessed the fierce tenderness of maternal instinct? On the Animal Planet show 'Meerkat Manor', we see a vivid portrayal of this instinct in the wild. Meerkats, small and vigilant creatures, stand upright like sentinels, scanning the horizon for danger. When newborns are in the den, the entire community heightens its alertness. At the first sign of threat, the mother meerkat rushes to shield her young, ready to lay down her life. Life on the prairie is unforgiving, and survival hinges on vigilance.

This instinct is not confined to the animal kingdom. Human mothers, too, are guardians of life and soul. My own mother's vigilance intensified during my high school years. She noticed subtle changes—black clothing, incense in my room, late nights. Her heart ached, sensing a spiritual danger she couldn't name. But she knew where to turn: she clutched her rosary and implored the Blessed Virgin Mary to protect her son.

What my mother didn't know was that I had begun dabbling in New Age and Wicca. I wasn't using drugs or alcohol, but I was engaging in something far more perilous: I was risking my soul. I had begun to

believe in impersonal forces and spirits I thought I could control. I had ceased to believe in the personal love of God the Father revealed through Jesus Christ. My house of hope was being plundered.

St. John Vianney once said, "The devil only tempts those souls who wish to abandon sin and those who are in a state of grace. The others belong to him; he has no need to tempt them." I had unknowingly wandered into the devil's playground, and my soul was in peril. But through the intercession of my earthly and heavenly mothers, I returned the borrowed books and severed ties with those influences. Though it took years to fully regain my faith, the seeds of hope had been replanted.

In today's Gospel, Jesus calls us to vigilance: "Be like servants who await their master's return, ready to open immediately when he comes and knocks." \*He warns us that if the master of the house had known when the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake. The house we must guard is the house of hope—the virtue by which we desire heaven and eternal life, trusting not in ourselves but in the promises of Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit (CCC 1817).

Hope is not passive. It is a weapon in our spiritual battle. St. Teresa of Ávila reminds us, "Hope, O my soul, hope. You know neither the day nor the hour. Watch carefully, for everything passes quickly." When I lost my faith, I lost sight of heaven. But hope—nurtured by prayer—restored my vision.

So how do we remain vigilant? How do we guard our hearts against the thief who seeks to steal our hope?

We pray. Daily. Fervently. Persistently.

My mother's example taught me that prayer is the soul's radar. The Church teaches that prayer is humble vigilance and filial trust, even in the midst of trial. The Blessed Virgin Mary, in her apparitions at Fatima, Lourdes,

La Salette, and Medjugorje, has consistently urged us: "Pray, pray," She especially recommends the Rosary, calling it a spiritual weapon against Satan's schemes.

Today, the enemy comes cloaked in books, music, media, and ideologies that distort truth and seduce the soul. But we are not defenseless. St. Padre Pio said, "The Rosary is the weapon for these times." Let us wield it with faith and love.

Let us be like the vigilant meerkat—alert, protective, and ready. Let us be like the faithful servant—awake, hopeful, and prepared. And let us be like the Blessed Mother—interceding, praying, and trusting in the victory of her Son.

## Ever Wonder About...

#### PARISH REGISTRATION

#### Question:

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

#### Answer:

Although Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

## You could volunteer in: Spiritual Life

The Spiritual Life Commission deepens spiritual life by helping the individual and community to respond to the presence of God.

#### Adoration


## Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion


