
Dear Beloved Parishioners of St. George,

It is with a heart brimming with joy that I, Fr. Akhilesh Antony, introduce myself to you, my new family in faith. Just imagine a lanky lad from a tiny, unassuming village in Kerala, South India, born on March 13, 1974, into a bustling Catholic household where love, laughter, and prayers were as plentiful as the coconuts falling from our backyard trees. As the eighth of eleven children—nine boys and two girls—I learned early on how to share everything, from mangoes to mischief, all under the watchful eyes of my devout parents.

My sister, ever the trailblazer, answered her calling to the Carmelite order and now shepherds young minds as a high school principal. Inspired by her devotion, I set off on my own spiritual adventure, joining the Indian Missionary Society after matriculation. This indigenous congregation, with its heart set on serving non-Christian regions, became my home as I trained for the priesthood. On May 11, 2005, in the familiar embrace of my home parish, I was ordained—a moment when the heavens seemed to wink and say, "Antony, you're in for quite the ride!"

For eighteen vibrant years, I served as a missionary across India, juggling roles like Mission In-Charge, School Manager, School Principal, Finance Manager, and even Estate Manager. If there was a hat to wear, I probably tried it on—sometimes all at once! But amid the whirlwind of administration, a quiet longing stirred within me: to trade spreadsheets for souls on a different footing, to serve not just with my hands but with my heart and soul. That whisper of inspiration led me across oceans to the United States, landing me in the warm, vibrant embrace of the diocese of Baton Rouge.

In May 2023, I arrived on a sabbatical, soaking in the Southern charm and spicy gumbo of this beautiful city. I served at Our Lady of Mercy Parish until June 22, 2025, where I learned that faith, like a good roux, requires patience, care, and a little bit of spice. Now, as your newly



appointed associate at St. George, I stand before you with a heart full of gratitude and a grin as wide as the Mississippi River. I am thrilled to walk this journey with you, to laugh, pray, and walk together as we grow in God's love. The affected Word of God that moves and guides me and which I am deeply convinced of is Matthew 6:33: "Strive first for the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."

And so here's to new beginnings, shared stories, and the sacred adventure of serving you the people of God at St. George, striving to experience the Kingdom of God and live by His righteousness. May our time together be a tapestry of joy, faith and hope that lead us to His abode.

Ever Wonder About...

QUEENSHIP OF MARY

Question:

Why do we have a feast for the Queenship of Mary?

Answer:

For many of us, the language of kings and queens may seem like they belong to history or a medieval movie. Royalty have absolute authority over a kingdom and their subjects, a concept that is foreign to many of us today. While Jesus doesn't rule a political kingdom, we honor and recognize him as the King of Kings, Lord of Heaven and Earth. To God alone belongs absolute authority over all of existence.

We may think of queens as the spouse of the king, but there is another key relationship: the king's mother. In Biblical history, we see instances where the mother of the king is given due as a queen herself, complete with a throne! Mary's guiding influence over her Son is seen most notably in the Wedding Feast at Cana. Mary is not Queen on her own merit. She is "full of grace" and "blessed" in "all ages" because of the reign of her Son.





Devotions, Explained!

GREGORIAN CHANT

Explained:

Gregorian chant is an ancient form of sacred music used in liturgical worship and prayer. Defined by a monophonic (meaning a single melody without harmony or chords), unaccompanied song, this type of chant focuses the singer's mind on the content of the prayer being sung, which makes it uniquely suited for use in the Mass.

Dating to the first millennium, it derives its name from Pope St. Gregory the Great, though scholarship is unclear on when exactly this type of chant originated. Prior to the Second Vatican Council, it was standard to use Gregorian chant in the Roman Rite Mass. Sacrosanctum Concilium, the Constitution on Divine Worship promulgated by Pope Paul VI in 1963, asserts that Gregorian chant is "specially suited to the Roman liturgy...(and) should be given pride of place in liturgical services."






