

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

## 26TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

## Feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael

Each year on September 29, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. These three are the only angels named in Sacred Scripture, and their feast reminds us that God, in His providence, sends heavenly messengers to guide, defend, and heal His people.

### More Than Angels

The word angel means "messenger," describing their mission rather than their nature. Angels are pure spirits created by God, immortal but not eternal, who serve Him faithfully. Among the nine choirs of angels, archangels are those entrusted with the most important announcements in salvation history. St. Gregory the Great explained that they are called "archangels" because they announce the greatest mysteries.

Their very names tell us their mission, always in relation to God:

- Michael (Mikha-el) means "Who is like God?"
- Gabriel means "God is my strength."
- Raphael means "God heals."

### St. Michael the Archangel: Defender of God's People

Michael is the great protector, invoked as the leader of the heavenly armies against the forces of darkness. In the Book of Daniel, he defends Israel in times of trial (Dn 10:13, 21; 12:1). In the Book of Revelation, he is described as the champion of God who defeats the dragon, Satan, casting him and his followers out of heaven (Rev 12:7-9).

Tradition has long invoked Michael's protection. He is often depicted in iconography as a warrior holding a sword or spear, standing over a defeated dragon. Churches across the world honor him as Princeps *militiae caelestis*—the prince of the heavenly host. He is also the patron of soldiers, police officers, judges, and those who fight to uphold justice.

In 1886, Pope Leo XIII composed the prayer to St. Michael after a vision of the Church under attack. The prayer remains a powerful invocation: "St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle..."

### St. Gabriel the Archangel: Messenger of Good News

Gabriel appears in both the Old and New Testaments as the angel who brings messages of hope and salvation. In Daniel, he interprets visions of the Messiah (Dn 8:16; 9:21–22). In the Gospel of Luke, Gabriel announces to Zechariah the birth of John the Baptist (Lk 1:11–20) and to Mary the Incarnation of Christ (Lk 1:26–38).

Because of his role, Gabriel is often called the messenger par excellence. He is depicted with a lily, symbolizing Mary's purity, or with a scroll bearing the words Ave Maria, gratia plena. Gabriel is patron of messengers, diplomats, and all who communicate the Good News.

### St. Raphael the Archangel: Companion and Healer

Raphael appears in the Book of Tobit as a guide, protector, and healer. Disguised as a traveling companion, he leads young Tobias



on a journey in which a demon is cast out, a marriage is blessed, and blindness is cured (Tob 5–12). Only at the end does Raphael reveal his true identity: "I am Raphael, one of the seven angels who stand and enter before the glory of the Lord" (Tob 12:15).

Because of his mission, Raphael is invoked as the patron of travelers, the sick, young people, and medical professionals. He reminds us that God heals not only physical ailments but also wounds of the heart and soul.

## A Feast of Heavenly Allies

The feast of the three Archangels was originally celebrated as the feast of St. Michael alone, whose veneration dates back to the early centuries of the Church, especially after his apparitions on Mount Gargano in Italy and Mont-Saint-Michael in France. In the reform of the liturgical calendar, the Church joined together the celebrations of Gabriel and Raphael on September 29.

Together, these three archangels remind us that heaven is not distant but deeply involved in our journey of faith. Michael defends us in battle, Gabriel proclaims God's saving word, and Raphael heals and accompanies us.

### Living the Feast

As we celebrate this day, let us entrust ourselves to the intercession of these powerful messengers of God. May St. Michael protect us from evil, St. Gabriel help us to announce the Gospel with courage, and St. Raphael bring God's healing to our lives.

Let us pray with confidence the prayer of the Church:

## St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle.

Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; And do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

## **DIVORCEES AND COMMUNION**

### Question:

Can a divorced Catholic receive holy Communion?

### Answer:

Unfortunately, too many people today — Catholics and non-Catholics alike — mistakenly believe that divorce separates one from the Communion of the Church and that divorced persons may not receive Communion. However, as the Church has communicated in a number of places, the issue at hand is not the reality of divorce, but is more often the reality of remarriage outside of the Church (such as in the case of a Catholic who was previously married within the Church, divorced, and remarried without receiving an annulment).

Divorced persons are called to live chastely as single people and to observe the same call to avoid sin as anyone else who desires to receive the Eucharist. Beyond this, however, Pope Francis has reminded us that the healing power of the Eucharist can be especially significant for those who have "endured separation, divorce, or abandonment ... divorced people who have not remarried, and often bear witness to marital fidelity, ought to be encouraged to find in the Eucharist the nourishment they need to sustain them in their present state of life." (Amoris Laetitia. no. 242) Moreover, he continues, "The local community and pastors should accompany these people with solicitude, particularly when children are involved or when they are in serious financial difficulty." (AL, no 242)

As Pope Francis has also reminded us, the Eucharist is "not a prize for the perfect," but "a powerful medicine and nourishment" (Evangelii Gaudium, no. 47). Because we all stand in need of healing and wholeness, the Church invites all who seek to live their faith in integrity and devotion to come and receive the grace offered in the Eucharist.






## VOCATIONAL PRAYER MINISTRY
