PASTOR'S MESSAGE

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

The Night the Power Went Out: A Family's Advent Story of Peace

It was a chilly December evening in a small East Coast town, and the Wright family had gathered around the table for dinner when, without warning, everything went dark. The forecast had mentioned high winds and snow, but no one expected a total blackout right in the middle of their conversation. In an instant, the familiar sounds and lights of their home disappeared, leaving only the whistle of the wind outside. "Oh no, not now!" Mom exclaimed, glancing at the stove where dinner was still cooking. Sarah, their oldest, reached for her phone and sighed, "No WiFi!" Ten-year-old Ethan whispered, "What if the power doesn't come back for days?" Little Mia, wide-eyed, asked, "Is it going to be like this forever?" Fear and frustration began to settle over the room like the storm settling over their town.

Then Dad remembered the Advent candles they had set aside for the upcoming Sunday. "Let's use those," he suggested, breaking the tension. The family gathered the purple and pink candles from the living room, and Dad struck a match. A small flame flickered to life, then another, and another, until the kitchen glowed with warm candlelight. The oven no longer seemed like the biggest problem; they could warm leftover soup on a camping stove. With no screens and no TV, they suddenly found themselves paying closer attention to one another.

The kids began telling funny stories; Mom shared memories of childhood power outages when her own family sang carols by candlelight. The storm still raged outside, the house was still cold, but something inside the home had changed. What began as a frightening blackout became, almost mysteriously, a moment of peace and closeness. "This is kind of nice, isn't it?" Sarah said, looking around the table. "It feels like we're more connected."

As the Second Sunday of Advent approached—the Sunday of Peace—the irony was not lost on them. The world

outside felt anything but peaceful: political divisions, school stresses, worries about the future. Dad remembered the Scripture that often came to mind when everything felt overwhelming: "For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God" (Romans 8:19). The Wrights were reminded that they, too, are part of a much larger story—a creation groaning and waiting for redemption, longing for the coming of the true Light.

Around that small circle of candlelight, Mom spoke quietly to the kids.

"Change is tough," she said, "but it can lead to wonderful things. When Jesus came, everyone expected something different—a powerful king, a conqueror. But He came in humility, and He changed the world through love and sacrifice." Ethan, calmer now, asked, "How can we prepare for Him?" Mom replied, "By making room for Him in our hearts and lives—choosing humility instead of pride, love instead of bitterness, peace instead of panic."

Mia, listening intently, suggested that they sing a song like Mom's family used to do. So they did. They gathered around the Advent candles and began

to sing carols softly, their voices rising above the wind outside. In that simple moment—no electricity, no devices, just family, flame, and song—they discovered the heart of Advent. They were not just waiting for Christmas to arrive; they were learning to welcome Christ's peace in the middle of their worries and disruptions.

As they finished singing, Dad said, "This Advent, let's promise to keep that light shining in our lives, even when the storms come. We can gather around the peace that Jesus offers and invite Him to be at the center of our home." On that dark winter night, the Wright family discovered what the Second Sunday of Advent proclaims: that in the midst of chaos and change, the light of Christ can still shine brightly, and the peace He brings is not the absence of storms, but His loving presence with us in the middle of them.

Ever Wonder About...

PENITENTIAL ACT

Question:

When we say the Penitential Act at Mass, why do we strike our chest three times?


Answer:

Our rituals and liturgical celebrations are filled with a variety of symbols, some of which also relate to our gestures and physical postures (e.g. kneeling, sitting, processing, making the Sign of the Cross). The custom of striking our breast three times during the "I Confess" of the Penitential Act of the Mass is one of those gestures that is loaded with symbolism.

The tradition of Christian's striking the breast (above the heart) is rooted in the image of Sacred Scripture, especially texts like Psalm 51 which speak of a "humbled contrite heart" or how God heals broken hearts, binding up our wounds (see Psalm 147:3). Early Christian writers like Saint Augustine of Hippo and Saint Jerome also refer to this custom in their writings.

Ultimately, this practice is an expression of our sorrow for those times when we have been guilty of faults and a sign that we are willing to take responsibility for our sins and failings. That we all perform this gesture together is also an act of solidarity, recognizing that none of us, regardless of where we are on our journey of faith, is without fault and the need for grace and forgiveness.



Adult Confirmation classes (total of four) will begin January 7th from 6:30-8pm in the Parish Office conference room.


Are you a Baptized Catholic who has received the Sacrament of First Eucharist, is out of high school, but has not been Confirmed?

2026 HONDURAS MISSION TRIP

Join us for St. George's first international mission trip!

March 7-13, 2026 • Tegucigalpa, Honduras

It will be a meaningful, hands-on mission experience supporting the villages of Las Flores and Las Cienegas, just outside of the country's capital, Tegucigalpa. This 7-day trip is led by Rob and Stacy Dille and is open to 10-12 adult men and women. It is organized by longtime mission partner Lucas Padilla, who grew up just minutes from these two villages. The trip includes both community projects and opportunities to build relationships with local families.

What the Trip Involves

We will spend five days assisting local residents with light-construction community projects. The work is very simple, non-strenuous and requires no prior experience or skill. The more demanding tasks are handled by the villagers, working alongside us. Examples of the projects we do are:

- Concrete floors
- Tin roofs (from the ground)
- Latrines
- Incinerators
- Pilas (concrete wash basins)






