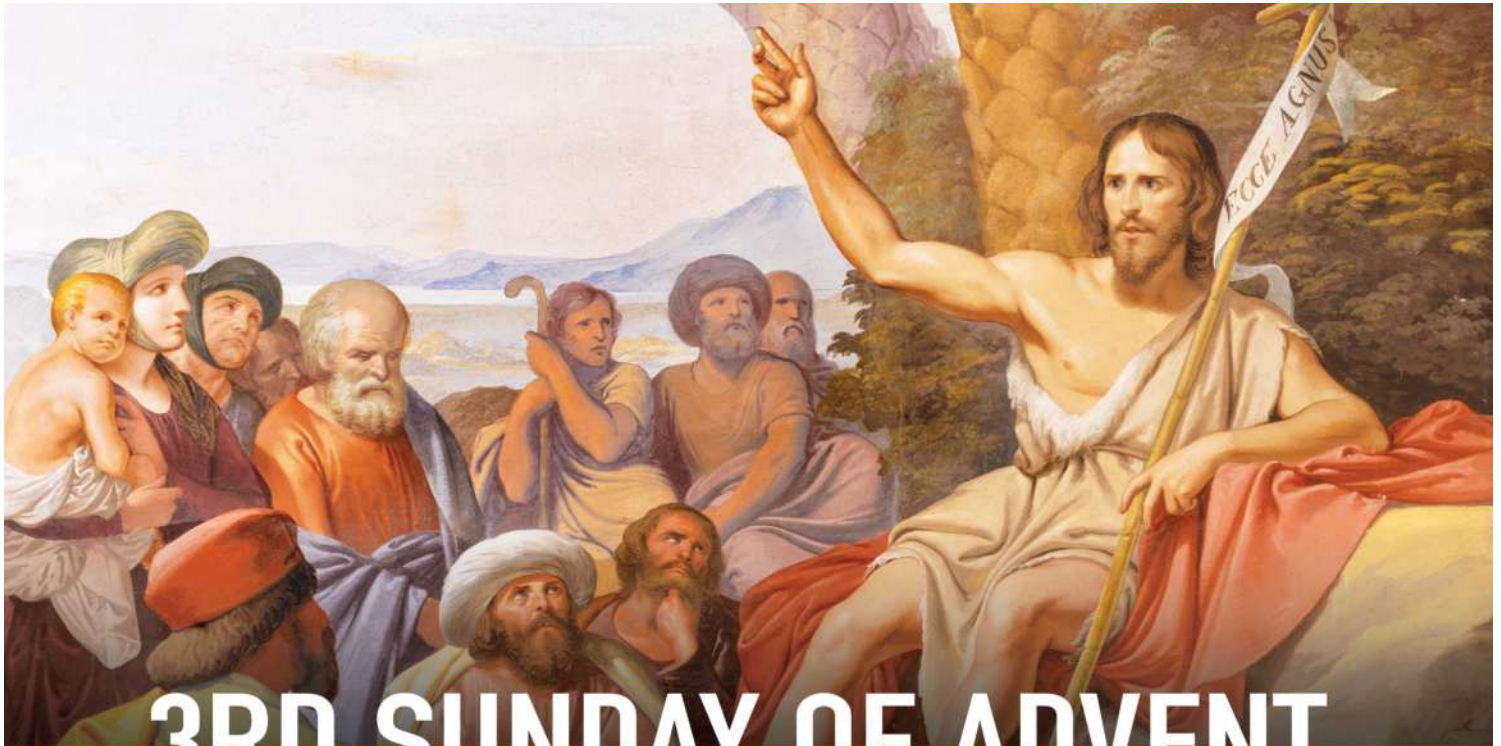

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

December 14, 2025

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Gaudete Sunday: Finding Joy in the Waiting

Less than ten days left until Christmas! The world around us is already acting as if Christmas has arrived—but what about our hearts? As we gather on this Third Sunday of Advent—Gaudete Sunday, the Sunday of joy—are we truly filled with the joy and hope of anticipating the birth of our Savior?

Waiting is not something our culture does well. We live in an age of instant gratification, and Advent's call to slow down can feel unnatural. On top of that, many of us are already tired from holiday preparations. Undereneath the lights and decorations, there can be disappointment, anxiety, even sadness.

In the Gospel, even John the Baptist, from Herod's prison, sends his disciples to Jesus with a painfully honest question: "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" (Matthew 11:3). John expected dramatic political overthrow, but Jesus was quietly healing, restoring, and lifting up the poor. John's question is ours too: "Is Jesus really the One?"

We might not say it out loud, but we sometimes live as if we are hedging our bets, compartmentalizing our faith. We have "church expectations" for Sunday, and different expectations for Monday through Saturday. We can limit how much we let Christ into our hearts, wanting to stay in control.

As adults, our "wish lists" become more sophisticated: the house, the job, the status. But whether we have it all or feel we have little, the deeper question remains: Have these things truly satisfied the longing in our hearts? Or do we still crave the next thing? What do you do when you have everything you ever wanted—and it is still not enough?

Martin Luther King, Jr. wisely said, "We must accept finite disappointment, but never lose infinite hope." Advent acknowledges finite disappointment but calls us to infinite hope—a hope built not on circumstances, but on Jesus Christ.

Jesus answers John not with a simple yes or no, but by pointing to what God is doing: "the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news



proclaimed to them." (Matthew 11:4–5). God often works not by removing our struggles, but by bringing new life *into* those places.

Advent reminds us of three comings of Christ: His first coming in Bethlehem, His coming into our lives now, and His final coming in glory.

Gaudete Sunday's joy is not a fake smile; it's the joy of trusting that God is at work even when not everything is fixed yet.

The Gospel is not just a story to admire; it is a power to live by. Are we limiting Jesus to certain "religious" corners of our lives? Perhaps this Advent, Jesus is gently asking us: "Where are you still trying to keep control?" "Where are you afraid to let Me in?"

In these final days, let's not just rush to Christmas. Let's walk these days reflectively, prayerfully, making real space in our hearts for the One who comes. May we welcome Christ as a living Person—our Savior, our Joy, our Hope—who comes to us today and will come again in glory. Come, Lord Jesus.

Ever Wonder About...

SAINTS OR SINNERS

Question:

Our prayer group has been reading the lives of some saints, and we were struck by how some of them thought they were such sinners. Why would someone so holy think they had such serious sin?

Answer:

Professional athletes practice the fundamentals of their sport over and over again, reaching for better form, consistency, and performance. They focus on the basics, review past performances, and visualize greater success. Practice makes better, if not perfect! Spiritual masters such as the saints also looked for perfection. They practiced their faith in the search for holiness, grace, and virtue. Through sacraments, prayer, study, good works, and penance, they raised their level of awareness and their sensitivity to the presence of God, the demands of the Gospel, and the workings of the Holy Spirit. They examined their consciences daily, reviewing the day for moments of failure and times that they could have been more virtuous in one way or another. They resolved to do better, be more attentive, and alert! Therefore, anything that would distract them or interfere with their relationship with God would be like a small black spot on a bright white wall — you can't miss it! The great saints were aware of sin and the presence of evil because they were so tuned into the struggle between good and evil that was fought in their own lives, hearts, and souls.

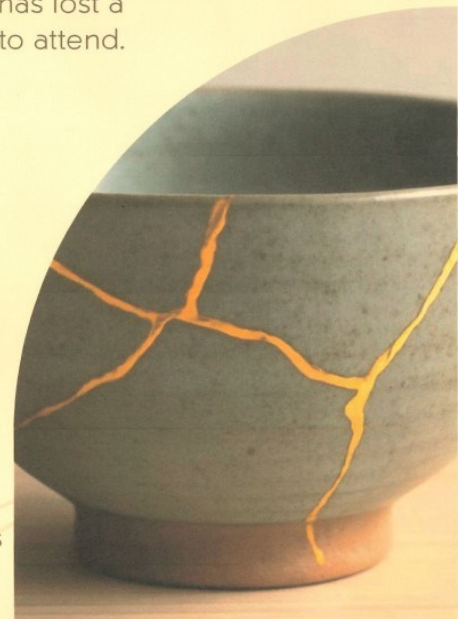

2026 HONDURAS MISSION TRIP

Join us for St. George's **first** international mission trip!

March 7–13, 2026 • Tegucigalpa, Honduras

MISSION TRIP INFORMATION MEETING: WEDNESDAY, DEC. 17TH AT 6 PM IN THE KAC ST. ELIZABETH ROOM

It will be a meaningful, hands-on mission experience supporting the villages of Las Flores and Las Cienegas, just outside of the country's capital, Tegucigalpa. This 7-day trip is led by Rob and Stacy Dille and is open to 10–12 adult men and women (age 21+). It is organized by longtime mission partner Lucas Padilla, who grew up just minutes from these two villages. The trip includes both community projects and opportunities to build relationships with local families.

What the Trip Involves

We will spend five days assisting local residents with light-construction community projects. The work is very simple, non-strenuous and requires no prior experience or skill. The more demanding tasks are handled by the villagers, working alongside us. Examples of the projects we do are:

Concrete floors + Tin roofs (from the ground) + Latrines + Incinerators + Pilas (concrete wash basins)

Additional activities include visits to Casa Blanca (a home for abandoned elderly residents), Vacation Bible School (VBS) with local children, Field Day outdoor games, a village welcome, and a closing fiesta.

Devotions, Explained!

OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

Explained:

The The four apparitions of Our Lady of Guadalupe took place in December 1531, when Juan Diego, an indigenous convert to the Catholic faith, encountered a woman dressed as an Aztec princess on Tepeyac Hill in present-day Mexico City. The woman, who was pregnant, spoke to him in his native language. She identified herself as the Mother of God.

Over the next four apparitions, Our Lady requested that Juan Diego implore the local bishop to build a church on the hill, and performed miracles to prove her identity. Through one of the miracles, she imprinted her image onto Juan Diego's tilma, or cloak; the tilma bearing that image can still be viewed today at the basilica which now stands on the site of the apparition.

Our Lady of Guadalupe is venerated as the Patroness of the Americas, and she is beloved worldwide as a symbol of motherhood, faith and identity. Her feast day is Dec. 12.

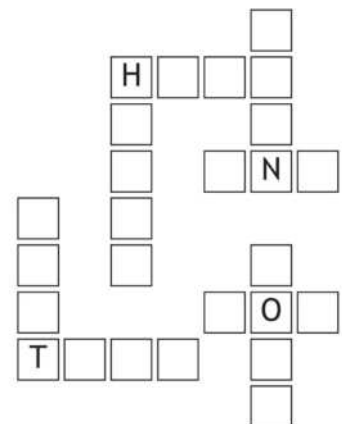

ACTS RETREATS REGISTRATION OPEN

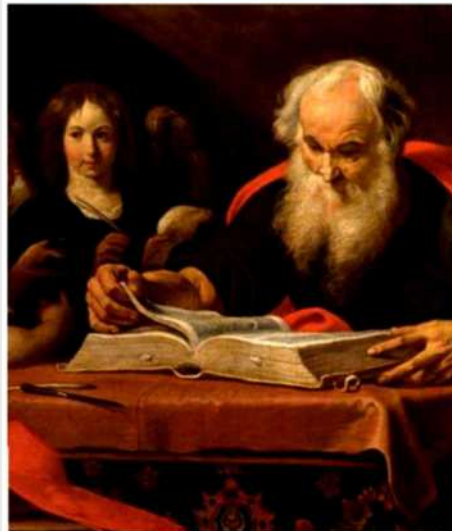

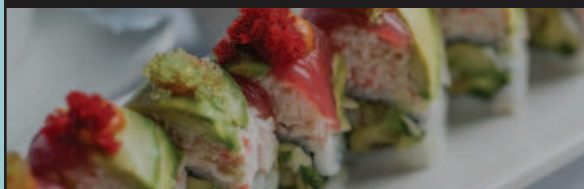
