# PASTOR'S MESSAGE

## FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

### Listening for God's Voice in Confusing Times

#### An Advent Reflection on St. Joseph

Most of us know what it feels like to lie awake at night, replaying a difficult situation over and over in our minds. A relationship has become complicated, a decision at work weighs heavily, a family problem seems to have no good solution. In those moments, a question often rises from the heart: "God, what do You want me to do?" Advent is a season made for that question. The Church invites us not only to prepare for Christmas as a date on the calendar, but to prepare the way of the Lord in our own hearts—clearing away whatever blocks us from hearing and following Him. This preparation is not abstract or sentimental; it happens right in the middle of confusing, painful, real-life situations. One person who can guide us in this is St. Joseph.

Before the angel ever spoke to him, Joseph was already a man of prayer. Scripture calls him "just"—upright, faithful, and humble. As a devout Jew, he longed for the coming of the Messiah. He worked with his hands, lived quietly, and prepared to welcome Mary as his wife. Then everything seemed to fall apart. Mary returns from visiting her cousin Elizabeth, and Joseph learns she is with child. He is told that this child is from God, conceived by the Holy Spirit. But from the outside, nothing about this situation looks simple or clear. Joseph is torn between what his heart feels and what his mind tells him. He loves Mary and wants to protect her, yet he cannot see how their marriage can go forward. Scripture is brief, but we can imagine those restless nights: "How could this have happened?" "What is the right thing to do?" "I don't want to hurt her, but I don't understand." Joseph's situation is not so different from ours. Sometimes the most painful dilemmas are the ones that involve those we love and trust most. We want to be faithful to God and kind to others, but we truly do not know which path is right. Our thoughts spin, our emotions surge, and we are tempted to act out of fear, anger, or self-protection.

In this crisis, Joseph does not lash out or act impulsively. He chooses a path that is both responsible and compassionate: he resolves to divorce Mary quietly, trying to protect her from shame and harm. Even before the angel appears, Joseph is already searching for God's will with integrity and calm. It is at the very moment when his human reasoning has gone as far as it can that God gives more light. In a dream, the angel tells him: "Do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home, for it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her." Joseph receives an answer that is both clear and utterly

astonishing. God does not simply confirm Joseph's plan; He reverses it and asks something far more mysterious and demanding. Yet Joseph recognizes the voice of God and obeys.

St. Joseph shows us that discerning God's will is not magic. It is the fruit of a life already shaped by faith. Before the dream, Joseph was prayerful—accustomed to turning to God, not only when crises hit. He was rooted in Scripture—formed by God's promises and the story of Israel. He was humble and just—willing to put God and others before his own pride. Because of this, when God spoke, Joseph could recognize His voice—even when the command was perplexing.

Obedience did not erase all mystery, but it did bring a deep, steady peace that comes from entrusting one's life and future to the Lord. We can practice the same attitudes: spending quiet time in prayer, especially in Advent; meditating on Scripture, letting God's word shape our thinking; reflecting on the deeper meaning of events instead of reacting only on the surface; and seeking counsel from holy and wise people when we are unsure. These habits do not eliminate difficulty, but they dispose our hearts to hear God's direction when it comes.

Every Advent, Christ desires to enter more deeply into our lives. But His coming often passes through decisions we would rather not have to make, crosses we would rather not carry, and invitations we do not

completely understand. Like Joseph, we are asked to discern between our way and God's way, between our will and His will. This does not mean ignoring our reason or our feelings. It means bringing both heart and mind before God, and then being willing to follow where He leads—trusting that His path, though sometimes painful or perplexing, is ultimately the one that will fulfill our vocation and bring true peace.

During this season, consider taking one concrete step: Set aside a few minutes each day to pray with this question: "Lord, what do You want me to do in this situation?" Read a short passage of Scripture (perhaps the infancy narratives in Matthew or Luke) and ask the Holy Spirit to speak through it. Offer to God a specific decision or worry, and then listen in silence, even briefly. As we do this, we may find that, like Joseph, God sheds light at the very moment when all other options seem exhausted. His answer may surprise us. It may stretch our faith. But if we, like Joseph, are willing to trust and obey, we will discover that the Lord is not only asking something from us—He is giving Himself to us. May this Advent be a time when, following the example of St. Joseph, we grow in the courage to ask, to listen, and to say "yes" to whatever God is inviting us to do.

## Ever Wonder About...

### TITHING VS. STEWARDSHIP

#### Question:

What is the difference between tithing and stewardship?

#### Answer:

Both tithing and stewardship are part of a spiritual way of life that calls us to use all of our resources for the service of the Gospel. Everything we are and everything we have comes from God. Offering back to God what He has given us is part of how we worship and give thanks to God.

Tithing is the practice of giving back 10 percent of what we earn. It comes from the Old English word for "ten." The first Scriptural example of tithing came from Abraham who gave a tenth of his possessions to the priest Melchizedek. He did so as an act of thanksgiving to God.

Stewardship as a way of life calls us to use well all that we have and all that we are, placing all things in service of others and God. Stewardship helps us see the good we can accomplish by making God and our spiritual life the most important values in our life. Whatever we accumulate in this life stays here. We can't take it with us! Both tithing and stewardship help us remember that nothing is mine or even ours ... all belongs to God.

## 2026 HONDURAS MISSION TRIP

Join us for St. George's first international mission trip!

**March 7–13, 2026 • Tegucigalpa, Honduras**

It will be a meaningful, hands-on mission experience supporting the villages of Las Flores and Las Cienegas, just outside of the country's capital, Tegucigalpa.

This 7-day trip is led by Rob and Stacy Dille and is open to 10-12 adult men and women (age 21+). It is organized by longtime mission partner Lucas Padilla, who grew up just minutes from these two villages. The trip includes both community projects and opportunities to build relationships with local families.



### What the Trip Involves

We will spend five days assisting local residents with light-construction community projects. The work is very simple, non-strenuous and requires no prior experience or skill. The more demanding tasks are handled by the villagers, working alongside us. Examples of the projects we do are:

**Concrete floors + Tin roofs (from the ground) + Latrines + Incinerators + Pilas (concrete wash basins)**

Additional activities include visits to Casa Blanca (a home for abandoned elderly residents), Vacation Bible School (VBS) with local children, Field Day outdoor games, a village welcome, and a closing fiesta.

## Devotions, Explained!

### LAS POSADAS

#### Explained:

Las Posadas, typically celebrated between Dec. 16 and Dec. 25, is a Mexican tradition which recreates the Holy Family's search for lodging in Bethlehem. A novenario, or a devotion which extends over a period of nine days, Las Posadas is a celebration of anticipation for the birth of Jesus Christ, who seeks refuge in the heart of every man and woman.

Each night of Las Posadas, a couple portraying Mary and Joseph knocks on the doors of different homes looking for a place to stay. Traditionally, the Holy Family is accompanied by a procession of people singing hymns and bearing candles who stand outside the home as they are denied entry again and again. Finally, they come to the "inn," the house or church that welcomes them. Carols are sung, a feast is enjoyed and star-shaped piñatas are broken open.


Still practiced in Mexico today, Las Posadas has also become an important cultural and spiritual touchstone for communities of Mexican immigrants who have moved abroad.

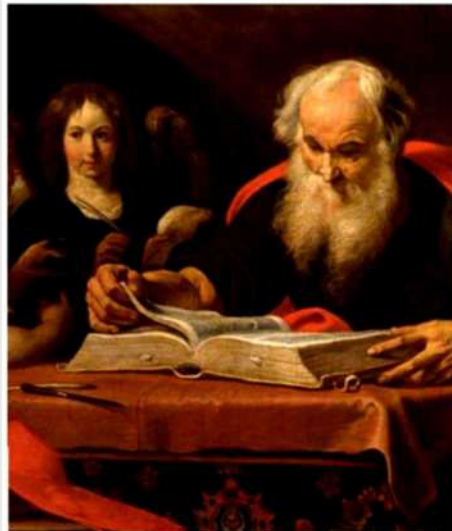

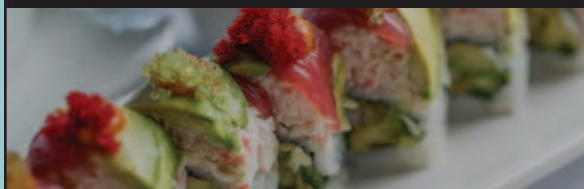
