

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

December 28, 2025 & January 4, 2026

HOLY FAMILY | EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Feast of the Holy Family (Dec. 28, 2025) & Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord (Jan. 4, 2026)

As we continue to rejoice in the Christmas season, the Church offers us two profound feasts that help us enter more deeply into the mystery of Christ: the **Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph** and the **Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord**. Together, they reveal how God's saving love is at work both in the hidden life of the family and in the great revelation of Christ to the whole world.

The **Feast of the Holy Family**, celebrated on the Sunday after Christmas, highlights Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as the ultimate model for Christian family life. In them we see the virtues of faith, love, unity, and obedience lived out within the home, which the Church calls a "domestic church." Nazareth was a simple household, but it was a sanctuary of grace and love. There, holiness was found not in grand gestures, but in the daily rhythm of work, prayer, sacrifice, and mutual care.

This feast reminds us that holiness can be discovered right in the midst of our ordinary family struggles: sleepless nights, financial worries, misunderstandings, and the many demands of daily life. The Holy Family encourages parents and children to build strong bonds through shared prayer, mutual support, and trusting God's plan—even when the path forward is unclear. As we honor the Holy Family, we are invited to ask how our own homes can more closely resemble Nazareth: a place where God's will is sought, where forgiveness is practiced, and where love is expressed in concrete, everyday ways. In this way, every Christian home can grow into a true "domestic church," a small but real reflection of God's presence in the world.

The following week we celebrate the **Epiphany of the Lord**, an ancient Christian feast that marks the culmination of the Christmas season and celebrates the revelation of Jesus Christ as the Son of God. Traditionally observed on January 6 (or transferred to a nearby Sunday, as in the United States), Epiphany actually predates the formal celebration of Christmas and originally commemorated several mysteries together: Christ's Nativity, the visit of the Magi, His baptism in the Jordan, and the wedding at Cana.

Over time, the Western (Latin) Church has come to focus Epiphany primarily on the visit of the Magi—the first Gentiles to recognize and adore Christ. Guided by the



light of a star, they represent all nations and peoples who are drawn to the true Light of the world. In the Eastern Churches, where the feast is known as **Theophany**, the emphasis falls on Christ's baptism in the Jordan as the great manifestation of His divinity and the beginning of His public ministry. There, the Father's voice, the descent of the Holy Spirit, and the sanctification of the waters reveal Jesus as the beloved Son who has come to heal our fallen human nature.

Rich theological meaning unites these traditions. Epiphany proclaims that God does not remain hidden, but reveals Himself in Jesus Christ for the salvation of all. The events recalled—Nativity, Magi, Baptism, Cana—each foreshadow Christ's death and resurrection and point to the transformation He brings: water made holy, hearts made new, ordinary lives filled with divine grace. Around the world, this mystery is celebrated with a variety of beautiful customs: blessings of water and homes, special processions, King Cakes, gift-giving on Three Kings Day, and family-centered gatherings. All these traditions, in their own way, point to Epiphany as a feast of revelation, faith, and divine mystery.

For us as a parish family, these two feasts belong together. The Magi encounter Jesus not in isolation, but within a family—cradled in Mary's arms, under Joseph's protection. In the Holy Family we see that the home is the first place where Christ is revealed, worshiped, and loved. As we celebrate the **Feast of the Holy Family (December 28, 2025)** and the **Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord (January 4, 2026)**, let us ask for the grace that our households may truly become "domestic churches," and that our parish community may shine with the light of Christ—so that, like the star over Bethlehem, we may lead many hearts to Him.

2026 HONDURAS MISSION TRIP

Join us for St. George's first international mission trip!

March 7-13, 2026 • Tegucigalpa, Honduras

It will be a meaningful, hands-on mission experience supporting the villages of Las Flores and Las Cienegas, just outside of the country's capital, Tegucigalpa. This 7-day trip is led by Rob and Stacy Dille and is open to 10-12 adult men and women (age 21+). It is organized by longtime mission partner Lucas Padilla, who grew up just minutes from these two villages. The trip includes both community projects and opportunities to build relationships with local families.



What the Trip Involves

We will spend five days assisting local residents with light-construction community projects. The work is very simple, non-strenuous and requires no prior experience or skill. The more demanding tasks are handled by the villagers, working alongside us. Examples of the projects we do are:

Concrete floors + Tin roofs (from the ground) + Latrines + Incinerators + Pilas (concrete wash basins)

Additional activities include visits to Casa Blanca (a home for abandoned elderly residents), Vacation Bible School (VBS) with local children, Field Day outdoor games, a village welcome, and a closing fiesta.

Adult Confirmation classes (total of four) will begin January 7th from 6:30-8pm in the Parish Office conference room.


Are you a Baptized Catholic who has received the Sacrament of First Eucharist, is out of high school, but has not been Confirmed?




