PASTOR'S MESSAGE

BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Feast of the Baptism of the Lord – January 11, 2026

We celebrate many anniversaries—birthdays, weddings, and even the passing of loved ones. Yet, there is one vital anniversary most of us forget. Recently, Pope Francis asked a crowd in St. Peter's Square: "How many of you remember the date of your Baptism? Raise your hands."

I once asked this same question to a group of new seminarians. These men had sacrificed lucrative careers and personal plans to follow God, yet many were still wondering, "Did I make the right choice?" When I asked who knew their baptismal date, only two hands went up. I didn't raise mine either.

Knowing this date is not just about trivia; it is about our identity. Through Baptism, we enter into communion with the Holy Trinity and live as God's beloved children. We do not escape the world, but we learn to live in it without belonging to it. As Pope Francis warned, if we forget this gift, we risk viewing Baptism as a mere event of the past—something our parents did for us—rather than a reality that impacts our present.



Is there a difference between a baptized person and one who is not? St. Paul tells us that in Baptism, we are buried with Christ so that we might "walk in newness of life" (Rom 6:4). It is not a mere rite of passage; it is our entry into a New Covenant and a new family. Through birth, a

child is given to parents; through Baptism, that child is given to God. At the font, parents acknowledge that their role is a participation in God's own parenthood, recognizing that all fatherhood and motherhood flows from Him.

Furthermore, this sacrament imprints an indelible mark on the soul, a permanent sign of belonging to Christ. This "character" of Baptism means that even in our moments of failure or doubt, we remain His. It is a foundation that can never be erased, providing us with a constant invitation to return to the Father's house. When we struggle with the "darkness" of the world, our Baptism serves as a beacon, reminding us that we have been claimed for the Light.



"It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me."

— Galatians 2:20

Christian Baptism also gives us a power we do not have on our own. It unites our souls with Christ's death and resurrection, filling us with divine life. This allows us to love not with our own selfish limitations, but with Christ's divine love. As St. Paul wrote, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me" (Gal 2:20). This grace acts as a spiritual engine, prompting us to act under the guidance of the Holy Spirit in our daily interactions, transforming ordinary moments into opportunities for holiness.

This Feast Day, let us "reawaken the memory" of our Baptism. We are called to live this grace every day, despite our weaknesses. If we manage to follow Jesus and remain in the Church, it is precisely because we have been clothed in Christ. And don't forget your homework:

Find out the date of your Baptism and celebrate it!

Ever Wonder About...

ORGAN DONATION

Question:

Are Catholics allowed to donate their organs?

Answer:

Yes, Catholics are allowed to donate their organs. In fact, the Catechism of the Catholic Church praises this practice when it notes that, "Organ donation after death is a noble and meritorious act and is to be encouraged as an expression of generous solidarity" (no. 2296).

The Church has a series of guidelines for health care providers called The Ethical and Religious Directives for Catholic Health Services. This document helps us see organ donation as an act of charity, but it also reminds us that we have to be sure that donations of organs by living donors do not "sacrifice or seriously impair any essential bodily function and the anticipated benefit to the recipient is proportionate to the harm to the donor" (no. 30); trained medical professionals can help to make this assessment. In the case of organ donation at the end of life, we must be sure of the intentions of the donor or of their proxy are always respected, and that the dignity of the human body is always respected.

In the end, we can look to Pope Saint John Paul II and his encyclical Evangelium Vitae, where he noted that organ donation is a beautiful act of expressing the culture of life, when "performed in an ethically acceptable manner, with a view to offering a chance of health or even of life itself to the sick who sometimes have no other hope" (no. 86).

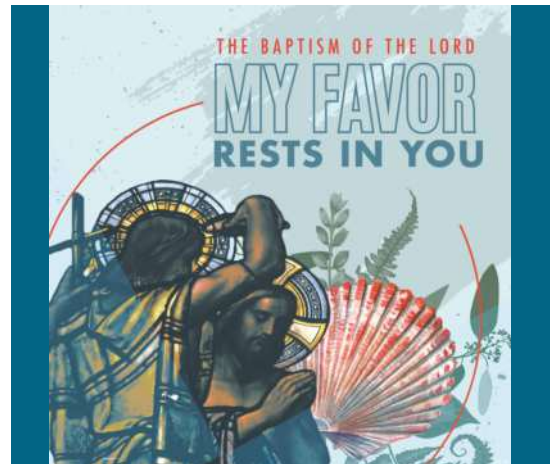

2026 HONDURAS MISSION TRIP

Join us for St. George's **first** international mission trip!

March 7-13, 2026 • Tegucigalpa, Honduras

It will be a meaningful, hands-on mission experience supporting the villages of Las Flores and Las Cienegas, just outside of the country's capital, Tegucigalpa. This 7-day trip is led by Rob and Stacy Dille and is open to 10-12 adult men and women (age 21+). It is organized by longtime mission partner Lucas Padilla, who grew up just minutes from these two villages. The trip includes both community projects and opportunities to build relationships with local families.



What the Trip Involves

We will spend five days assisting local residents with light-construction community projects. The work is very simple, non-strenuous and requires no prior experience or skill. The more demanding tasks are handled by the villagers, working alongside us. Examples of the projects we do are:

Concrete floors + Tin roofs (from the ground) + Latrines + Incinerators + Pilas (concrete wash basins)

Additional activities include visits to Casa Blanca (a home for abandoned elderly residents), Vacation Bible School (VBS) with local children, Field Day outdoor games, a village welcome, and a closing fiesta.

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL YEAR-END UPDATE

Thanks to the generosity of our St. George parishioners, the annual report for this past fiscal year indicates our parish was able to assist 841 individuals living within our parish boundaries. St. George provided \$4,980 in groceries from our parish food pantry, rental assistance of \$52,129, utility assistance and emergency expenses of \$45,713, along with donations of furniture, clothing, and household necessities.

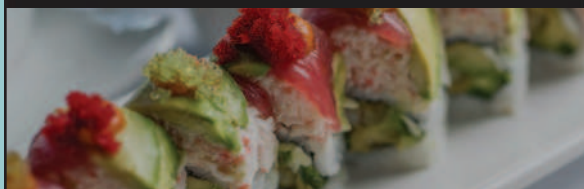
