PASTOR'S MESSAGE

January 18, 2026

2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Called in Baptism to Serve and Make Room for Christ

This Sunday's liturgy invites us to remember who we are and why we are here: **God calls us in Baptism to be servants in the likeness of his Son, the Light of the World.** Baptism is not only a beginning; it is a lifelong mission. We are marked by Christ so that our lives may point to Him—through faith, humility, and love expressed in service.

John the Baptist: A Witness Who Steps Aside

In the Gospel (cf. Jn 1:29–34), John the Baptist testifies about Jesus after baptizing Him in the Jordan. His words are direct and clear: **Jesus is the One who comes first.** John identifies Him as “the Lamb of God.”

What stands out is not only what John says, but what John does. As Pope Francis reflects, John understands that his mission is to prepare the way—and once Jesus is revealed, John is able to **step back.** Humanly speaking, we might expect John to remain prominent, to receive recognition, or to hold on to the influence he has gained. Instead, he gives way to Jesus.

This is the freedom of a true servant. John does not bind people to himself. He does not build a following for his own sake. He points to Christ, helps others take the next step, and then accepts that his role is no longer center stage.

Pope Francis notes that this is difficult, because we can easily become attached to roles, responsibilities, and being noticed or appreciated. But Christian service is meant to be **gratuitous**—given freely—without using it to gain esteem or reward.

So this week we might ask ourselves:

- Do I make space for others—listening, encouraging, letting them grow?
- Do I need recognition to keep doing good?
- Do I lead people toward Jesus, or toward myself?

To step aside at the right time is not failure. It can be an act of humility and faith: Lord, this is Your work. Let Your light be seen.

The Lamb of God: Love That Saves

Calling Jesus the **Lamb of God** reveals the heart of what He came to do. Our redemption is entirely God's initiative—pure gift. As Scripture says:

“It is not that we have loved God, but that he has loved us and sent his Son as expiation for our sins” (1 Jn 4:10). And: **“God so loved the world that he gave his only Son...” (Jn 3:16).**

The title “Lamb of God” echoes the Exodus, when the blood of an unblemished lamb marked the doorposts and God protected His people (cf. Ex 12:1–14). That ancient sign points forward to Jesus, whose sacrifice brings salvation to the world. He is not only our teacher and example—He is our Savior.

Mother Teresa: “It’s Because You Don’t Know Him”

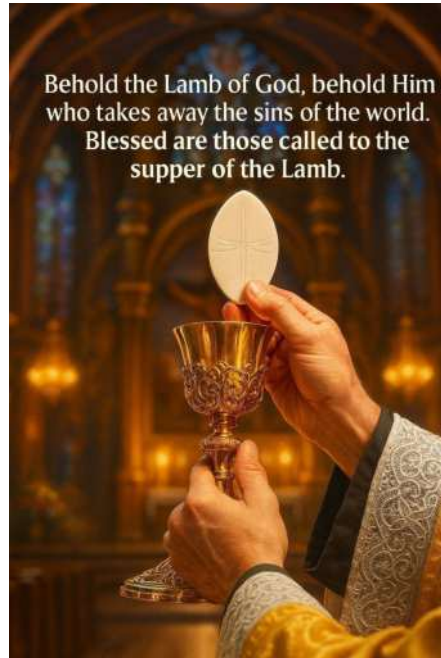
Mother Teresa once responded to the difficulty many have in accepting Christ's presence by saying: **“It’s because you don’t know Him.”** For her, Jesus was not distant. He was living and personal: her God, her Life, her Everything.

She drew inspiration from Jesus' hidden life—His humility, simplicity, and quiet obedience—and even more from His Passion, where love is shown without limit: **“Greater love has no man than this...” (Jn 15:13).** Her strength for serving the poorest came from the Eucharist and from adoration—time spent close to the Lord, letting His love form her into someone who could love others well.

Her witness echoes John the Baptist: when Jesus becomes the center, our service becomes freer, purer, and more joyful.

For the Week Ahead

May this Sunday help us renew our baptismal calling: **to bear witness to Christ with humility,** to serve without clinging to recognition, and to make room for others to follow God's call.

Ever Wonder About...

RECEIVING COMMUNION

Question:

How many times a day can a person receive communion?

Answer:

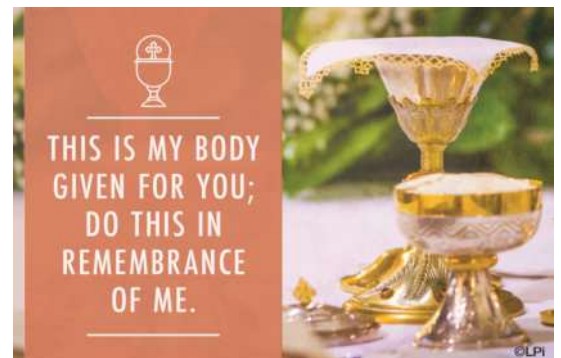
To find an answer to this question, we need to turn to the Church's Code of Canon Law. Here we read, "One who has received the blessed Eucharist may receive it again on the same day only within a Eucharistic celebration in which that person participates ..." (no. 917). This tells us that the standard answer would be that we can receive communion twice in a day.

Having said that, we also want to be sure that we pay attention to the entire instruction. The phrase "within a Eucharistic celebration in which that person participates" is important. It means a) that we always have to think of receiving communion as being within a celebration of the Mass and b) we have to be participants in that celebration – we can't simply show up "in time" for communion.

So, when would this rule apply? For example, if you attend Mass on a Saturday morning and then take part in the Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturday evening, you could licitly receive communion at both celebrations. Or, another example, if you receive communion at a wedding or funeral Mass, you could also receive communion at a daily Mass or Sunday Vigil celebrated on the same day. We always want to be sure that we observe the rules for fasting from food and drink before receiving the eucharist (see Code of Canon Law, no. 919).

We should also remember that the Code of Canon Law instructs that anyone who is in danger of death or seriously ill may also receive communion a second time (no. 91, §2).

2026 HONDURAS MISSION TRIP

Join us for St. George's **first** international mission trip!

March 7-13, 2026 • Tegucigalpa, Honduras

It will be a meaningful, hands-on mission experience supporting the villages of Las Flores and Las Cienegas, just outside of the country's capital, Tegucigalpa. This 7-day trip is led by Rob and Stacy Dille and is open to 10-12 adult men and women (age 21+). It is organized by longtime mission partner Lucas Padilla, who grew up just minutes from these two villages. The trip includes both community projects and opportunities to build relationships with local families.

What the Trip Involves

We will spend five days assisting local residents with light-construction community projects. The work is very simple, non-strenuous and requires no prior experience or skill. The more demanding tasks are handled by the villagers, working alongside us. Examples of the projects we do are:

Concrete floors + Tin roofs (from the ground) + Latrines + Incinerators + Pilas (concrete wash basins)

Additional activities include visits to Casa Blanca (a home for abandoned elderly residents), Vacation Bible School (VBS) with local children, Field Day outdoor games, a village welcome, and a closing fiesta.



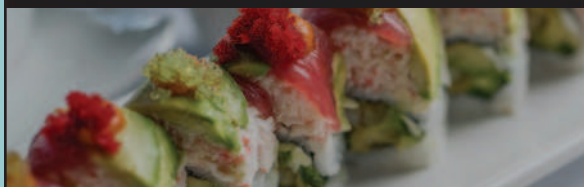
