PASTOR'S MESSAGE

January 25, 2026

3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Theme for the Week: Jesus, the Light of the World, has come to shine with his radiance and scatter all darkness, to save us from sin. Let us deepen our relationship with him so that we may not only walk in the light of his love but also shine his light on others.

To Live Life, We Must Accept the Challenge of Leaving

In today's Gospel (Matthew 4:12-23), we witness the decisive moment when the first disciples leave everything to follow Jesus. This encounter is not a coincidence; Jesus goes to where they live and work, drawing near to them in the midst of their daily routines. Pope Francis reminds us that this is how the Lord always operates—He looks for us, enters our reality, and extends a direct call: "Follow me!"

To follow Jesus, however, requires the courage to leave. This is a decisive moment for every Christian because the meaning of our entire existence is at stake. If we do not find the courage to set out on the journey, we risk remaining mere spectators of our own lives, living a "halfway" faith. We are called to leave behind our vices and sins—those anchors that hold us back from setting sail—but also our fears, selfish calculations, and the false security of just "getting by." Whether it is a young family embracing the unpredictable adventure of parenthood or a professional giving up free time to serve the sick, living fully requires us to accept the challenge of leaving comfort for the sake of a greater joy.



Going Deeper: Peter's Encounter

This "leaving" is vividly captured in an Ignatian contemplation of Peter's call. Imagine Peter at the shore, exhausted after a night of fruitless fishing, cleaning his nets. Jesus steps into his boat—not a cathedral or a palace, but a workspace. When Jesus finishes teaching the crowd, He gives Peter a startling command: "Let's row out there, where it's deeper."

There is a profound spiritual weight to that word: deeper. Peter, the experienced fisherman, initially objects based on logic and fatigue. Yet, something in Jesus' gaze gives him strength. When he finally trusts and lowers the nets, the catch is so overwhelming that the boats begin to sink. In the face of such power, Peter is struck by his own sinfulness, crying out, "Depart from me, Lord!" But Jesus responds not with judgment, but with a promise: "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men."

Our Call Today

The "Light of the World" has come to scatter our darkness, but we must be willing to step into that light. Like Peter, we might feel unworthy or tired of "fishing" with no



results. Jesus is stepping into your boat today, asking you to row into the deep waters of prayer, service, and trust.

What are the "nets" you need to leave behind this week? Perhaps it is the time wasted on useless things, or the fear that prevents you from being a witness to others. When we leave behind our comforts to follow Him, we find that the sacrifice is small compared to the joy of the catch. Let us deepen our relationship with Him so that we may not only walk in His light but become a beacon of that same light for everyone we meet.

Ever Wonder About...

ANointing of the Sick

Question:

Can anyone offer the Anointing of the Sick to a sick or dying person, or is that only something a priest can do?

Answer:

The Letter of James speaks to us of the ancient tradition of a special anointing and blessing of those who are sick: "Is there anyone sick among you? Let him send for the presbyters of the Church and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord ... If he has committed any sins, they will be forgiven him" (5:14, 15b).

This passage forms the foundation for the theology of the sacrament that we call "Anointing of the Sick." In keeping with what we read in the Letter of James and the ancient tradition of the Church, the anointing of a person who is sick or dying may only be performed by a priest or bishop.

Although deacons and other members of the Church are not able to celebrate the sacrament with a person who is sick, we can read Sacred Scripture and pray with and for those who are ill. Resources like the Book of Blessings also contain special blessings that can be celebrated by deacons or lay ministers.

In the end, we want to be sure that we show a special care and concern for the sick, helping them to always experience God's loving comfort through made tangible through our acts of charity and service.



Explained:


Though it is often used as a synonym for happiness, joy has far more to do with the choices we make than the emotions we feel.

Joy is the experience of achieving what we most desire — and what we most desire is love. God made us in love and for love, and so, in the same way that a flower seeks the sunlight, our souls seek the warmth of true, selfless love. The virtue of joy, therefore, is a fruit of the virtue of love, or charity (CCC 1829).

"We are meant to have our human joys: the joy of living, the joy of love and friendship, the joy of work well done," said Saint Pope John Paul II. "We who are Christians have a further cause for joy: like Jesus, we know that we are loved by God our Father. This love transforms our lives and fills us with joy."






