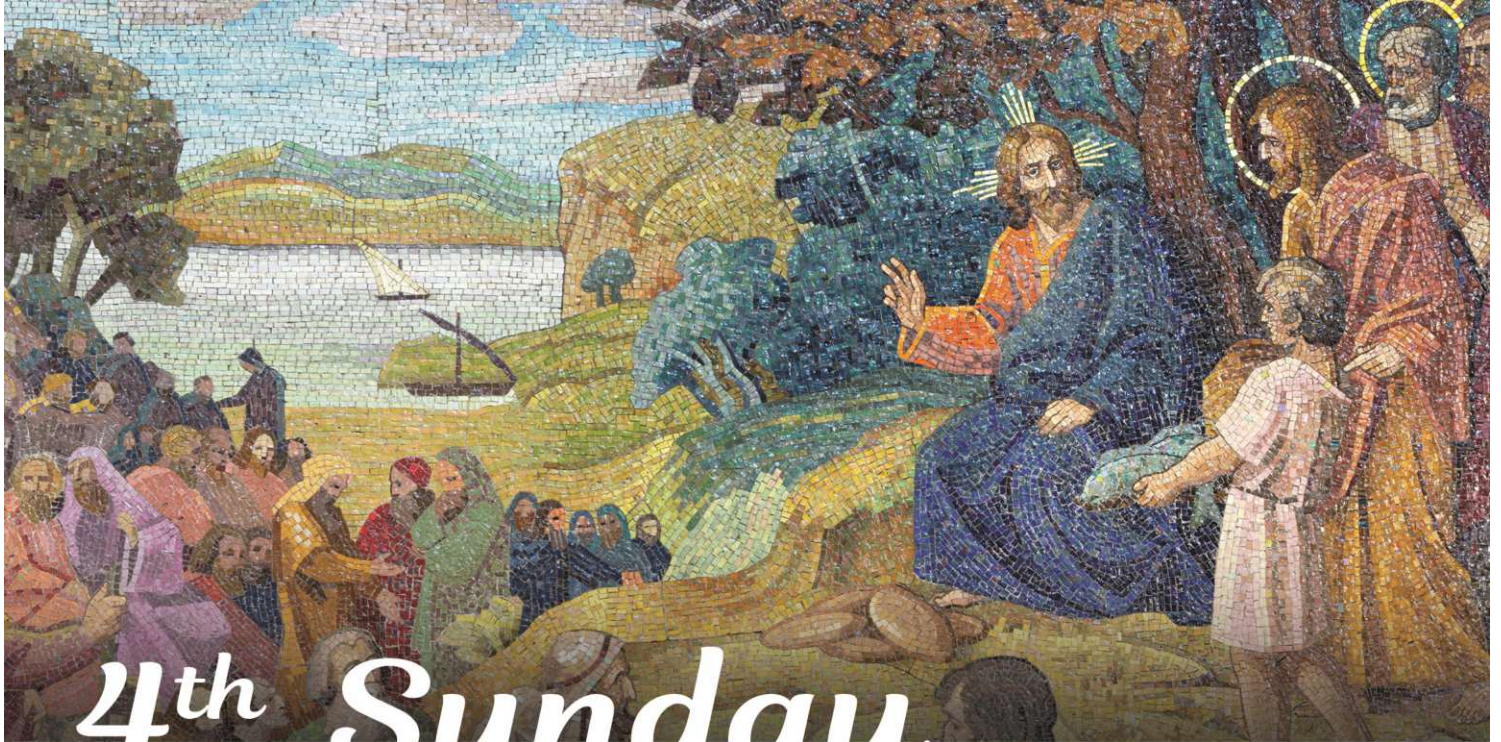

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

February 1, 2026

4TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi

Earlier this year, Pope Leo XIV named 2026 the **Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi**, an invitation for the entire Church to rediscover the simplicity, humility, and Gospel-centered way of life that defined the "little poor man" of Assisi. The Pope highlighted St. Francis as a living example for our times—a world weighed down by conflict, anxiety, and the temptation to look for power instead of holiness. By turning our attention to Francis, the Holy Father hopes we'll return to the core of Christian discipleship: placing our trust in God above all else.

This weekend's readings speak directly to the values embodied by St. Francis and why his example is so needed today.

St. Paul reminds the Corinthians:

"Not many of you were wise by human standards...But God chose the foolish of the world to shame the wise" (1 Corinthians 1:26-31).

Francis lived this message in a striking way. Though he was born into privilege, he chose poverty—making himself "small" so God could be great in him. His story echoes Paul's words: what matters most isn't our own achievements or status, but how God can turn our weakness into something holy.

In the Gospel, Jesus gives us the **Beatitudes** (Matthew 5:1-12)—a map to the Kingdom that Francis tried to follow with his whole heart.

- He was poor in spirit, finding freedom in simplicity.
- He mourned with a deep compassion for the suffering.
- He lived gently, seeking peace and reconciliation.
- He hungered for holiness, embracing the Gospel "without gloss."
- He endured misunderstanding and ridicule for the sake of Christ.

Pope Leo XIV also reminds us that this Jubilee is a real call to "rebuild the Church," just like the words Francis once heard before the San Damiano Cross. Today, when so many feel distanced from faith or overwhelmed by the pace of life, the Pope points to the way Francis welcomed everyone—and how he could see Christ's face in the poor and the outcast. The Jubilee Year isn't just about remembering history; it's a chance to practice "fraternity without borders," healing what is broken in our communities through the same spirit of peace that



Francis brought to everyone he met, from sultans to everyday people.

This Jubilee Year also invites us to a "conversion of the heart" in how we relate to all of creation. By bringing the message of *Laudato Si'* into the celebration, the Holy Father shows us that Francis's love for "Brother Sun" and "Sister Moon" was a real recognition that everything is connected. As we listen to the Beatitudes this Sunday, we're invited to be peacemakers not just with each other, but toward the earth as well. The Jubilee challenges us to live in a way that's "holy enough"—finding fulfillment not in more stuff, but in the richness of God's grace and in serving others with joy.

In this Jubilee Year, Pope Leo XIV invites us not merely to admire St. Francis but to imitate his Gospel joy, his reverence for all creation, and his unwavering faith in God's providence. The Beatitudes, lived fully by Francis, become our guide as well—showing that sanctity is possible in every age, including our own.

As we celebrate this Sunday, may these readings inspire us to embrace the humble, Christ-centered path of St. Francis and allow God's grace to reshape our hearts. Through this Jubilee Year, may we rediscover the beauty of living simply, loving generously, and walking joyfully with the Lord.

Ever Wonder About...

PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

Question:

Luke's Gospel is the only one to mention the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. What is Luke trying to communicate here and what connection does it have with Mary?

Answer:

February 2 is exactly forty days after December 25, the nativity of Jesus. Jewish law (Ex 13:2, 12) dictated that Jesus, as the firstborn, be consecrated to God. This was done by the parents as they presented their Son in the Temple.

Jewish law further specified (Lv 12:2-8) that a mother was ritually impure after giving birth, and that she had to wait a set period of time (forty days for a boy) before she was to offer a sacrifice to the Lord for purification.

The convergence of these two Jewish regulations occasions Luke's account of both the Presentation of the Lord and the Purification of Mary. These days the liturgical emphasis is more on the Presentation of Jesus. Luke highlights the role of Simeon and Anna, two righteous Jews who recognized Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah and praised God for being able to see and experience such a marvel in their lifetimes.

Simeon's prayer concerning the special role of Jesus states that Jesus is "a light for revelation to the Gentiles." This phrase eventually originated the custom of blessing candles on this day which were to be used in the ceremonies, rituals, and processions throughout the church year. Thus February 2 is also known as Candlemas Day. This day is indeed a rich feast to be savored.

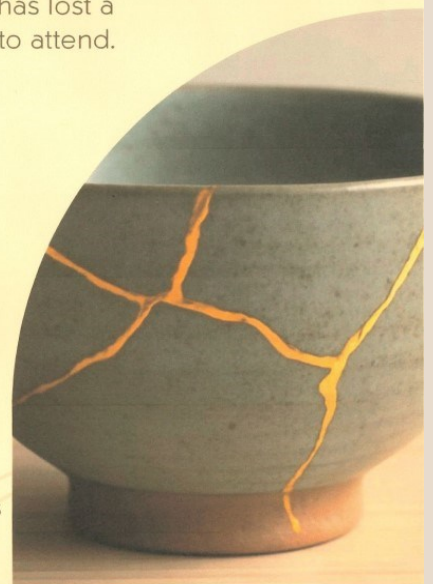

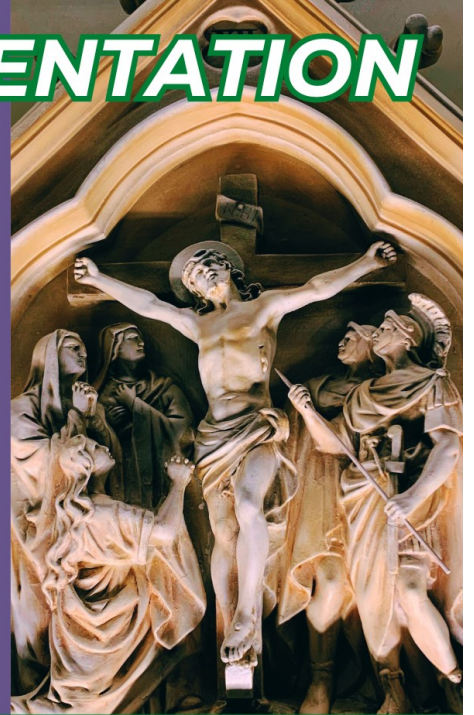
