# PASTOR'S MESSAGE

February 8, 2026

## 5TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Imagine someone who has faced deep suffering—abuse, poverty, and abandonment—but instead of being overcome by darkness, somehow becomes a source of hope and light. Donna-Marie Cooper O'Boyle is such a person. Her story is not just inspiring; it invites us to wonder how anyone can find light in the midst of pain. Who is Donna-Marie, and how did she discover grace where most of us would see only hardship?

You'll have the chance to hear her in person and discover the answers for yourself. Donna-Marie will be joining our parish on **Tuesday, March 10, 2026, at 6:00 PM (Save the Date!)** to share her journey and the wisdom she's gained from saints and her own life.

Before we meet her, let's reflect on the message that runs through this Sunday's readings: how does God's light break into our world—and how might it shine through us, especially in our darkest moments? How does God's light find its way into our world, and how are we called to let that light shine through us? This Sunday's readings invite us to reflect on these questions as we seek to recognize God's presence in our daily lives.

Isaiah 58:7–10 reminds us that faith isn't just about words or rituals. True fasting, Isaiah tells us, shows itself in real acts of kindness—sharing food with the hungry, offering shelter to those in need, and providing clothing for those who have none. When we live this kind of love, God promises: "Then your light shall break forth like the dawn... your light shall rise in the darkness." Our light isn't something we create on our own; it's revealed when we put compassion into action.

Psalm 112 continues this message. The just person—gracious, merciful, and generous—"shines through the darkness like a light." Even in hard times, someone who trusts God becomes a source of

hope for others. Holiness, the psalm suggests, is often lived quietly and steadily, grounded in trust rather than attention.

In the Gospel (Matthew 5:13–16), Jesus first tells us who we are before asking anything of us: "You are the salt of the earth... You are the light of the world." Light isn't meant to be hidden away. When faith is kept private or unspoken, it loses its power to inspire and encourage. Jesus urges us to live so that others "see your good works and give glory to your heavenly Father."


- As we approach Lent, these readings challenge us to ask:
- Where have I hidden my light out of fear, shame, or weariness?

How might God be inviting me to let His grace shine through acts of mercy, forgiveness, or quiet faithfulness?

God doesn't ask us to create light on our own. He invites us to take away whatever hides it—to live out the Gospel in love—so that His light can shine for others and bring glory to Him.



## Ever Wonder About...

### MARDI GRAS

#### Question:

Carnivale and Mardi Gras celebrations are linked to Ash Wednesday, Lent, fast and abstinence. Can you tell us more about the connections between these events?

#### Answer:

Ash Wednesday is the beginning of the forty days known as Lent. Every year, Christians highlight this penitential season as a time of self-examination, reformation of one's life, and continued development of a deeper spiritual life. The recommended practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving become the focus of Lenten activity and ritual. Each of these spiritual practices is aimed at personal discipline as well as continued concern for the other, especially the poor or alienated.

Forty days is a symbolic biblical period of time, during which personal transformation occurs and out of which people surface as more spiritual, ready to carry out God's mission. Relying on God's providence and care, no matter how difficult life becomes, is crucial to Lenten spirituality. Fasting was initially stricter, permitting only one simple meal a day without meat, fish, or other delicacies. Such things were not even allowed in the house.

In order to prepare for this in an age of no refrigeration, people gathered to consume whatever was not allowed during Lent. This led to parties or celebrations originally referred to as Carnivale, literally meaning "goodbye to meat," or Mardi Gras, literally meaning "Fat Tuesday." The eating and celebrating ended on the Tuesday just before Ash Wednesday. Today we focus more on moderation in all things, as well as a strong concern for the poor. What are you doing for the poor this Lent?




