Lenten Reflection
By Fr. Patrick Hough, SJ

ST. GEORGE CATHOLIC CHURCH FEB. 24 | 6 PM IN THE CHURCH

Lenten Reflection with Fr. Patrick Hough, S.J. (Feb. 24, 2026 | 6 PM | St. George)

St. George will welcome Fr. Patrick Hough, S.J., a Jesuit priest and retreat director serving in Grand Coteau, Louisiana. Fr. Hough is the Director of Grand Coteau Retreats: A Jesuit Mission Since 1837, the renewed, united retreat ministry serving the Church through the Ignatian tradition of prayer, silence, discernment, and the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius. In this role he has been tasked with helping shape and expand retreat opportunities on the Grand Coteau campuses for individuals and groups.



Originally from Lancashire, England, Fr. Hough attended Stonyhurst College, studied Geography at Leeds University, and pursued theological studies in Rome at the Pontifical Gregorian University and the Pontifical Angelicum University. He also made his Jesuit novitiate in Grand Coteau (2002–2004)—making this ministry something of a “homecoming.”

On February 24 at St. George, Fr. Hough will offer two Lenten reflections:

“Is my prayer working? I still have real struggles.”

An honest look at prayer when life doesn’t get easier—how to recognize God’s action, stay faithful in dryness, and bring real struggles into conversation with the Lord.

“Fasting from the future. Why it works.”

A practical Lenten invitation to step back from worry, urgency, and “what-if” thinking—learning how surrender and presence can make room for trust, clarity, and peace.

There is no cost to attend, and all are welcome. A free-will offering will be collected to help offset the expenses of hosting this event and to support our continued efforts to bring quality spiritual programming to the parish.

Meditation on the 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The liturgy for the 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time invites us to reflect on Psalm 119: “Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!” This week’s theme reminds us that God’s commandments are not burdens, but wise guidance leading us to a more joyful life.

In the Gospel, Jesus explains his mission: he didn’t come to get rid of the Law, but to bring it to completion. But it’s not the commandments or the Law themselves that give us life. The One who gives us life is Jesus Christ, who fulfills the Law on our behalf. As Jesus announces, “Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill.”

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that only Jesus, the divine legislator, could perfectly fulfill the Law. In him, the Law is no longer just rules written on stone, but is written on the heart—the heart of the Servant who brings justice and redemption. Through his fulfillment, Jesus saves us, taking upon himself the burden of the Law to redeem us. Because of this, he calls us to go deeper than just following rules—like not killing or stealing—and instead to live out real love. Rituals, like the offertory, don’t mean much if we aren’t at peace with those around us.

God doesn’t love us because we’ve earned it—He loves us deeply, giving everything on the Cross. We’re invited to move from seeing ourselves as servants of a strict master to children of a loving Father. As Sunday approaches, we can ask ourselves: Is our faith just for show, or is it a real relationship with God that inspires us to show mercy, just as He does?

Ever Wonder About...

STEM CELL RESEARCH

Question:

Why is the Church against stem cell research, especially if it offers the possibility of cures for diseases like Alzheimer's and Parkinson's?

Answer:

Like so many issues, the truth about stem cell research is more complicated than a few sound bites and vague promises of cures. For the Church, the problem is with embryonic stem cell research, not the research itself. The destruction of human life, even for a seemingly noble cause, is never acceptable. The ends cannot justify the means. Stem cells can be obtained in other ways, including from the placenta as well as from adults. So research is possible without the destruction of other life.

On the other hand, stem cell research shows much promise, but no concrete results. Some scientists also dispute what diseases might be cured by new discoveries. The research is still in its early stages. The question for our country is whether we should invest a lot of money in research now, looking for cures that will probably remain out of reach for most people, or should we invest that money in other programs with more immediate benefits, especially those that stress prevention and education. It is indeed a complex issue that requires close scrutiny and investigation before we jump to inaccurate conclusions or make decisions based on good, but misinformed, intentions.








1. Many Christian denominations celebrate Ash Wednesday. It is an ecumenical observance.






