

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

March 1, 2026

2ND SUNDAY IN LENT

Second Sunday of Lent: March 1, 2026

Part II: Navigating the Darkness (Rules 5–7)



In today's Gospel, we see Jesus transfigured in glory on Mount Tabor. Peter, filled with consolation, wants to build tents and stay there forever. But the "mountain-top" experience is meant to strengthen the disciples for the "valley" of the Cross. St. Ignatius teaches us that spiritual life has seasons; when the

light of Tabor fades and we enter the desert of desolation, we need "battle tactics" to stay the course.

Rule 5 – In desolation, never change your plan

"When you are in spiritual desolation, never change anything in your spiritual life."

In the darkness, the enemy suggests that our prayers are useless or that we should give up our Lenten resolutions. Ignatius insists: stand firm. Decisions made in the light should not be abandoned in the dark.

Self-Assessment: Am I tempted to quit prayer, Mass, confession, or a good resolution because I feel dry? What "non-negotiable" fidelity can I keep today?

Rule 6 – Four means: Prayer, Meditation, Examination, Penance

"In desolation use: prayer, meditation, examination, and suitable penance."

Don't be passive. Fight back by: (1) Asking God's help, (2) Remembering God's past fidelity in Scripture, (3) Asking "How did this start?", and (4) Standing your ground with a small act of self-denial rather than numbing out with distractions.

Self-Assessment: Which of the four means am I using today? What is one concrete act of "suitable penance" that helps me stand firm rather than numb out?

Rule 7 – God gives sufficient grace

"In desolation, think: God is giving me all the grace I need to get safely through this."

Desolation feels like abandonment, but it is a trial of our faith. God is actually closer than ever, providing the "hidden" grace necessary to resist the enemy.

Self-Assessment: Even without consoling feelings, do I trust God's grace is enough for the next faithful step? What is that step (10 minutes of prayer, one act of charity, one honest conversation)?



MISSIONARY COOPERATION APPEAL WEEKEND

This weekend, we will hold a Mission Appeal. Fr. Doug May, M.M. (Maryknoll) will be preaching at all Masses, except for the 6 PM on Sunday.

The Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers (Catholic Foreign Mission Society of America) are a Catholic society of priests and brothers dedicated to overseas missionary work, serving the poor and marginalized in Africa, Asia, and Latin America for over 100 years. Founded in 1911, they focus on direct evangelization, education, healthcare, and humanitarian relief.

- **Mission:** They are committed to serving in regions where the Church is not yet established or is in need of assistance, often working in areas of poverty and conflict.
- **Work & Services:** Their ministries include building schools, providing clean water, conducting agricultural projects, offering healthcare (including HIV/AIDS ministry), and promoting human rights.
- **Location:** While headquartered in Ossining, New York, they operate globally in over 20 countries.

Growing up in a small town near Buffalo, NY, Fr. Doug served as a missionary priest in Cairo, where he had been for more than two decades. He was the only United States-born, English-speaking priest in Egypt.

He provided pastoral care for several communities in the Cairo area. He also worked as the international coordinator for the Center for Intercultural Dialogue and Translation and the Center for Arab-West Understanding, a nongovernmental organization that fostered dialogue between Christians and Muslims and sociopolitical pluralism in Egypt and in the Middle East.

Ever Wonder About...

VIOLENT CONFLICTS

Question:

What is the Christian attitude towards violent conflicts?

Answer:

In the Beatitudes, Jesus teaches us “Blessed are the peacemakers” and to “love your enemies.” All human beings are made in God’s image and likeness. We are one human family — brothers and sisters despite what divides us. Christians have the obligation to prioritize peaceful means to resolve conflicts. War wreaks a toll on a nation. Civilians bear a disproportionate burden of this cost during the war itself and as the nation rebuilds. However, those in authority have the obligation to protect the innocent.

During the gradual fall of the Roman Empire, theologians began to theorize that war could be just if it was a defensive measure of last resort. The “Just War Theory” was later expanded by St. Thomas Aquinas, who also included moral obligations during the war itself, including the protection of civilians. Those in public authority have the obligation to carefully examine their motives, agendas, and rationale for violent force. Should a cause be just, those who fight and defend under such circumstances must be valued and honored. They deserve our support both during and after the war.

SELF CONTROL

Explained:

Love. Joy. Anger. Desire. Fear.

These are just a few of what are called the "passions" of humankind, and in order to understand self-control, we must first understand the passions. Our passions are neither good nor bad – it's all in how we interact with them.

Enter the virtue of self-control.

Self-control flows from the cardinal virtue of temperance, and it's really all about boundaries. Passions only become problematic when we allow them to control us. Through self-control, a gift of the Holy Spirit, we avoid surrendering too much of ourselves to our passions.

"When regulated by reason, and subjected to the control of the will, the passions may be considered good and used as means of acquiring and exercising virtue," we read in The Catholic Encyclopedia. "The sensitive is given to man by God, and therefore its acts have to be employed in His service."
