PASTOR'S MESSAGE

3RD SUNDAY IN LENT

Discernment of the Spirits with St. Ignatius of Loyola

Part III: Staying the Course & Preparing for Battle (Rules 8–11)

This weekend, we encounter the Samaritan Woman at the Well. She is thirsty for something the world cannot provide. Like her, we often toggle between the "living water" of consolation and the "dry well" of desolation. Ignatius teaches us how to maintain a "mature balance" so that we aren't tossed about by ever-changing emotions.

Rule 8 — Be patient; consolation will return

"In desolation, be patient, stay the course, and remember consolation will return much sooner than desolation is telling you."

Desolation lies to us, saying "it will always be like this." Patience is the antidote. The sun will rise again.

Self-Assessment: Am I making the desolation "permanent" in my mind? What evidence from my past shows that God brings light again?

Rule 9 — Why God allows desolation

"Desolation can help us see needed changes, strengthen resistance, and keep us from complacency."

God uses desolation as a "spiritual gym" to strengthen our soul's muscles. It reveals where we are attached to the feelings of God rather than the God of feelings.

Self-Assessment: What might God be inviting me to change (habits, boundaries, relationships, prayer)? How is this trial strengthening virtue in me?

Rule 10 — In consolation, prepare for desolation

"When you are in consolation, remember desolation will return and prepare for it."

When things are going well, we often become overconfident. Use the "sunny days" to build your spiritual pantry for the "rainy days" ahead.

Self-Assessment: What practices help me most when I'm low? What simple plan will I follow next time: (1) keep my schedule, (2) talk to someone wise, (3) reduce distractions, (4) return to Scripture?

Rule 11 — The mature balance

"Neither carelessly high in consolation nor despairingly low in desolation, but humble in consolation and trusting in desolation."

Self-Assessment: In consolation: do I remember it is gift, not achievement? In desolation: do I cling to God's faithfulness more than my feelings?



The Kiss of Jesus: Finding Comfort in Mother Teresa's Words

"For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God" (1 Cor 1:18).

In prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, Donna-Marie felt drawn deeply into Jesus' Passion and even asked to suffer for Him. Her spiritual director gently suggested asking the Lord to lessen her suffering, but she felt bound by her promise: she had told Jesus she would do whatever He asked.

The saints teach that suffering, though mysterious, is filled with grace when united to Christ. Thomas à Kempis wrote that adversity can be better for us than having everything our way, and that nothing suffered for God goes unrewarded. Mother Teresa, in the darkness of her own soul, still discovered that the deepest pain was not suffering itself, but longing for God. Saint Thérèse heard in her heart Jesus' cry from the Cross, "I thirst!"—a thirst for our love. Saint John Paul II taught that suffering holds a hidden power that draws us close to Christ.

Life brings many crosses: misunderstandings, family trials, and even false accusations, as when Donna-Marie's son was arrested for a crime he did not commit. Yet faith gave her the courage to "offer up" her anxious heart and to trust God in the dark. Archbishop Fulton Sheen wrote that Christ gives a peace that can coexist with tribulation, because true peace lives in the soul united to Him.

In this spirit, Donna-Marie often meditated on the Passion, both in church and amid ordinary duties "between the pots and the pans." She even wrote a Way of the Cross and sent it to Mother Teresa, who replied with a tender letter urging her to use her gifts for God's glory, to "make your life something beautiful for God," and to "keep the joy of loving Jesus ever burning in your heart and share this joy with others."

Other spiritual guides echoed the same mystery. Fr. John Hardon reminded Donna-Marie that Christ continues to suffer in His Mystical Body, the Church, especially where believers are persecuted or where the Church is opposed, even from within. Saint Faustina learned at the foot of the Cross the grace to forgive: each look at Jesus crucified became a fresh decision to forgive from the heart. Forgiveness does not excuse evil; it opens the soul to healing and mercy.

In a simple moment at home, Donna-Marie noticed a crucifix had fallen, stood it back up, and was moved to her knees in gratitude for Jesus' love and mercy for a sinner. She recalled Saint John Paul II's insight that without the agony of the Cross, we would not know with certainty that God is Love. Like Saint Paul, who accepted his own "thorn in the flesh," she discovered that God's grace is sufficient and that "when I am weak, then I am strong" (2 Cor 12:10).

Through wise confessors, the example of Mother Teresa, and the witness of the saints, Donna-Marie learned to see every cross—large or small—as a kiss from Jesus, an invitation to grow closer to Him, to forgive, to trust, and to become a light for others in their darkness. In all things, the counsel she received remains for us as well: stay close to Our Lord, and keep at peace.

Ever Wonder About...

CHURCH DIVISION

Question:

If we are all meant to be united in Christ, why is there so much division in the Church?

Answer:

Each Sunday, we profess that we believe in "one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church." The Church is indeed one because her source is the Trinity, and she is founded by Christ. The Church also exists in the fallen world and is made up of fallen people. Sometimes, there are tensions over what we believe as Catholics. Who is Jesus really? Are we affected by original sin? How do our traditional sexual ethics play out amidst medical and technological developments? Doctrinal disagreements are rarely just about ideas ... they occur within a context.

Tensions are influenced by various social and political factors of the time period. For example, Martin Luther's attempts at reform gained followers, in part, as a reaction against poor moral practices within the Catholic Church. When the schism between the Eastern Orthodox Church and the Catholic Church occurred in 1028, tensions between the two culturally different regions had been brewing for centuries.

Division still occurs within the bounds of the Church today. Oftentimes, this is about pastoral or practical matters. These Questions can vary. Should we incorporate Latin back into the liturgy? What is the best way to reach the youth in our parish? These may not be articles of faith, but people have strong opinions about what ought to be done. We can remember the prayer of Christ — "that all might be one" — and do what we can to grow in understanding and respectful dialogue.
