PASTOR'S MESSAGE

March 15, 2026

4TH SUNDAY IN LENT

Part IV: The Enemy's Tactics (Rules 12–14)

In the healing of the Man Born Blind, we see that sight is a gift, but it also brings a battle with those who prefer the darkness. St. Ignatius concludes his rules by exposing the "psychology" of the enemy. Like a bully or a false lover, the enemy relies on our fear and our secrets.

Rule 12—Resist at the beginning

"Resist temptations right at their very beginning; this is when it is easiest."

If we let a small spark of temptation sit, it becomes a forest fire. If we reject the first thought, the enemy loses his power.

Self-Assessment: What is the "first step" of my usual temptation (a thought, a click, a text, a memory)? What boundary stops it immediately?

Rule 13—Break secrecy: speak with a wise person

"When you find burdens, temptations, or discouragement, find a wise, competent spiritual person and talk about it."

The enemy is like a false friend who tells you, "Don't tell anyone about this." Once a temptation is spoken aloud to a priest or mentor, its power often vanishes instantly.

Self-Assessment: What am I carrying alone that should be brought to light? Who is my trusted guide, and when will I reach out?

Rule 14—Identify your vulnerable point and reinforce it

"Identify and reinforce the area where you are most vulnerable to the enemy's temptations."

A commander attacks a fortress at its weakest wall. We must know our "weakest wall"—whether it is pride, lust, or simple fatigue—and station extra guards there.

Self-Assessment: Where am I most vulnerable (fatigue, loneliness, resentment, pride, comparison)? What concrete reinforcement will I practice this week?

What a Blind Man Teaches Us About Lent

Lent is often described as a 40-day "spiritual check-up" for our souls. It is a journey that takes us out of the "darkness" of our mistakes and bad habits and leads us toward the "light" of Easter. One of the most famous stories used during this season is the Gospel of the Man Born Blind. In this story, Jesus heals a man who has been blind since birth by using a bit of mud and clay. While it is an amazing physical miracle, the Church uses it to teach us a much deeper lesson about how we "see" the world.

The story creates a big contrast between the blind man and the religious leaders of the time. Even though the man couldn't see with his eyes, his heart was open, and he eventually recognized Jesus as the Son of God. On the other hand, the religious leaders had perfect physical vision, but they were "spiritually blind" because their pride kept them from seeing the truth about Jesus. Lent is our time to ask ourselves: "What am I blind to?" We all have "blind spots"—sins like selfishness or judging others—that stop us from seeing God clearly.

Lent acts as a 40-day "treatment" to fix our spiritual vision. Through simple practices like prayer and fasting, we try to "remove the scales" of pride from our eyes. In the early Church, people preparing to be baptized at Easter called the process "Enlightenment" because they were finally stepping out of the dark. As we head toward the Resurrection, the story of the blind man reminds us that being a Christian means more than just knowing facts about God; it means letting Jesus open our eyes so we can live as "children of light" who see the world the way He does.

TAKING UP OUR CROSS

Question:

What does Jesus mean when he talks about taking up our cross?

Answer:

Our journey of faith begins in baptism. When we are faithful to it, we find God's plan for us, his way of allowing us to participate in his saving work, which in turn becomes for us our own salvation. Stated simply, we share in the mission of Jesus each day. We live our life with all of its ups, downs, joys, and sorrows in union with the mission of Jesus. Our work then is holy. It is joined to the cross, God's will for Jesus — the way in which he destroys sin and death and makes eternal life possible. His sacrifice accomplishes what we ourselves cannot do.

To take up the cross, then, means that we share in the mission of Jesus and so embrace the sufferings of the cross. It is our daily life made holy, given a redemptive mission. It is our purpose and goal to unite our life to that of Christ. St. Paul says it best, "If we have grown into union with him through a death like his, we shall also be united with him in the resurrection" (Rom 6:5).







Devotions, Explained!

TAIZÉ

Explained:

Taizé originated in France during World War II. It takes its name from the small town just southeast of Paris where Brother Roger Schutz, a Swiss Protestant, founded the community in the hopes of serving both Christian and Jewish refugees of the German-occupied country. In the years following World War II, Christian men from various traditions — Catholic and Protestant — came to live at Taizé and participate in Brother Roger's vision of ecumenism, social justice and peace, eventually forming a community of about 80 brothers from nearly 30 countries.

Today, Taizé continues to be a place of pilgrimage, particularly for young people, who visit the community in the tens of thousands each year.

Taizé has also become well-known for its style of music and prayer, which emphasizes silence, contemplation and stillness. Taizé devotees have carried its music and traditions to Catholic and Christian communities throughout the world.




