PASTOR'S MESSAGE

5TH SUNDAY IN LENT

Fifth Sunday of Lent: March 22, 2026

The Journey of Desire: From the Shallow to the Deep

As we approach Holy Week, the raising of Lazarus reminds us that Jesus is the Lord of Life. He calls us out of the "tomb" of our self-centeredness and into the "deep" of His mercy. This final installment reflects on the heart of the spiritual journey.

The Copernican Revolution of the Soul

Most of us live as if we are the center of the universe. But a true "Copernican Revolution" happens when we realize we revolve around God, not vice versa. When we say, "I want to be a saint," we must be careful that the "I" isn't the focus. Holiness isn't an achievement; it is simply being in love with the One who loved us first.



The Trap of the "Peanuts"

In the Far East, monkeys are caught by putting nuts in a hollow tree. The monkey grabs the nuts, but his fist becomes too large to pull out. He is trapped because he refuses to let go. What are your "peanuts?" What are the attachments—success, comfort, or a specific reputation—that you cling to even when they keep you from freedom? St. Ignatius calls us to "holy indifference:" being so open to God's will that we desire only what pleases Him.

The Shallow and the Deep

We often prefer the "shallow" side of life because it feels safe. But Jesus calls us into the deep—the ocean of His mercy. We take showers for our bodies; why not for our souls? Regular confession is the "shower" that keeps our deep self clean and ready to receive the fervor of God.

Discipline and Silence

The leper said to Jesus, "If you will, you can make me clean." He was concerned with Jesus's heart. To stay connected to that Heart, we need spiritual discipline. Without discipline, there is no discipleship. This begins with silence. We do not seek silence for its own sake, but to facilitate the conversation with God. Without silence, we cannot hear the "Good Spirit" calling us home.

Final Lenten Reflection:

As we prepare for Palm Sunday, ask yourself: Am I ready to let go of my "peanuts" and step into the deep? Am I ready to let His Kingdom come, not just in the world, but in every corner of my heart?

Prayer for Preparing for the Holy Week

Lord Jesus Christ, as I approach the days of Your Passion, grant me the grace not merely to recall what You endured, but to enter the mystery with a watchful heart.

Quiet in me the noise of hurry and distraction. Teach me to follow You—from the hosannas of Palm Sunday into the humility of the Upper Room, into the silence of Gethsemane, and to remain near You at the Cross when love is proved and not explained.

Give me true repentance, not fear without trust, but sorrow that opens to Your mercy. Make me steadfast when my resolve is weak, and humble when I want to defend myself instead of surrendering to the Father.

Inflame in me a deep desire for You in the Most Blessed Sacrament. When I receive You sacramentally, let it change my life; and when I cannot, let my longing become a real act of communion— never permitting me to be separated from You.

Pour into my heart the mercy that flows from Your wounded side: the courage to forgive, the patience to serve, and the faith to hope when I cannot yet see Easter morning.

Holy Spirit, lead me through this Holy Week.

Father, receive my small offerings.

Jesus, unite them to Your perfect sacrifice, that I may die to sin and rise with You to new life.

Amen.

Ever Wonder About...

HOLY SEE

Question:

Why is the Vatican sometimes called the "Holy See?"

Answer:

A little background in ecclesiology will help explain why we call the Vatican the Holy See. The Church is very structured and organized in its hierarchy. A diocese is a geographic area governed by a bishop appointed by the Pope. Each diocese is further broken down into parishes, which have pastors who represent the bishop in his teaching authority.

The diocese of Rome has a particular role in the Church because of its importance and antiquity. The Pope is head of the Church because he is the Bishop of Rome. Every bishop has a seat or throne, which is the symbol of his teaching authority and is located in the cathedral of each diocese.

The Latin word for seat is "sedes." So each diocese can be referred to as a "see." Most people think that St. Peter's is the cathedral of Rome, but St. John Lateran Basilica is actually the cathedral of the Archdiocese of Rome. This is where the Pope's seat or throne as Bishop of Rome is found. So, the Holy See is a reference to the chair of Peter, the Pope's Chair.



Volunteers will talk about encountering Christ in the unexpected setting of a prison:



Bernie Corripio - 19 years in the ministry that has helped him understand more deeply what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. He leads the twice a month cell block ministry to Hunt Correctional.

Lynette Arlati - Already making a big difference, Lynette started in prison ministry two years ago. She is the volunteer Assistant Catholic Chaplain at LCIW and leads the Kolbe Prison Ministry program in the women's prison. "So that all may encounter the healing and redemptive love of God"

Bob Jelley - In 26 years in the ministry Bob has witnessed more miracles there than anywhere else. "How amazing that we receive more in return from those who have nothing to give back". He leads the St. George team going monthly to Angola.

Devotions, Explained!

ANIMA CHRISTI

Explained:

The Anima Christi prayer takes its name from its opening lines: Soul of Christ — "Anima Christi" in Latin. In this prayer, the faithful invoke the image of Christ crucified, calling upon the salvific elements of his wounds, his Body and his Blood to strengthen them, imploring him to save them from "the malicious enemy" and to bring them, in their final hour, to his presence.

The author of this prayer is unknown, but it originated in the 14th century and was referenced in St. Ignatius' Spiritual Exercises. It is traditionally said after or before receiving the Eucharist.
