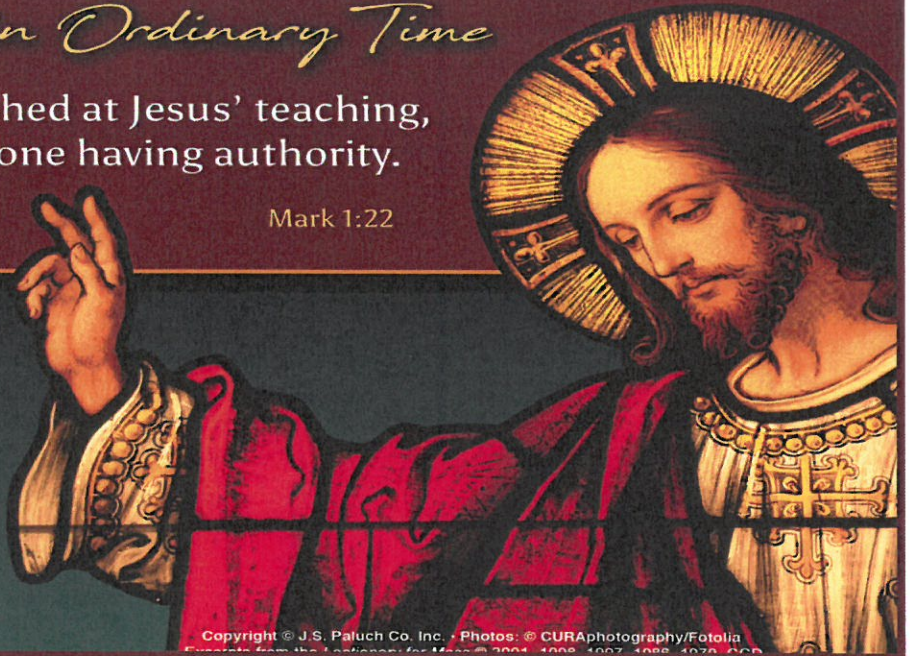

Dear Friends,

In 1991 the British boxer Michael Watson was left permanently paralyzed after a bout with Chris Eubank. The brain surgeon who conducted the initial operation on Michael thought he would die; later, the doctors said that he would never walk again. But twelve years later he managed to complete the London Marathon; he walked it at the rate of two hours each morning and two hours each afternoon, finally completing the whole course in six days. He was accompanied on the first leg of his marathon by the man who had brought disaster into his life; they'd become good friends. Indeed, Watson eventually wondered if it had been a disaster after all. "Getting angry", he said, "won't change the past. Before the accident I wasn't a Christian. Now Jesus is my inspiration. How can you fail to be moved by the words of Jesus on the cross: 'Father, forgive them'?"

The Jewish people revered Moses; they looked upon him as the greatest of their prophets. He promised to the Jews, "Your God will raise up for you a prophet like myself, from among yourselves." That was the promise; the Gospel in dramatic fashion shows its fulfillment. When Jesus preached in the synagogue people were impressed. They remarked that Jesus is a prophet like no other; his teaching was different; he taught them with authority. He displayed his authority not only in words but in actions too; he puts unclean spirits to flight.

So Mark's Gospel isn't only a drama: it's a challenge. What do I make of Jesus Christ? Who is he for me? What about evil spirits? Did Jesus come to conquer them? In our modern, scientific world, we perhaps smile a little at the very mention of such beings. But are there not evil forces in each of us, forces that threaten our well-being and that of others, dark forces like pride, selfishness, lust, envy and bitterness that can so easily come bubbling up to the surface? And might not these be described as evil spirits?

If today's Gospel highlights the authority of Christ's teaching, it is perhaps not surprising that the responsorial psalm should urge us to "listen to his voice! Harden not your hearts." And if we listen, what shall we hear? Many things, but it will all come down to this: your God loves you, you are God's child; God has prepared a place for you in God's kingdom. Do not be afraid, God can conquer every evil that threatens your happiness. Live for God and for your brothers and sisters. When we truly listen to him – not merely with our ears but our hearts – then his teaching is always new, always carrying an appeal and a freshness, as though we were hearing it for the first time. It is always Gospel, always good news.

Queridos Amigos,

En 1991, el boxeador británico Michael Watson quedó paralizado permanentemente después de una pelea con Chris Eubank. El neurocirujano que realizó la operación inicial de Michael pensó que iba a morir; más tarde, los médicos dijeron que nunca volvería a caminar. Pero doce años después logró completar la Maratón de Londres; lo caminó a razón de dos horas cada mañana y dos horas cada tarde, completando finalmente todo el curso en seis días. En la primera etapa de su maratón lo acompañó el hombre que había traído el desastre a su vida; se convertirían en buenos amigos. De hecho, Watson finalmente se preguntó si, después de todo, había sido un desastre. "Enfadarse", dijo, "no cambiará el pasado. Antes del accidente yo no era cristiano. Ahora Jesús es mi inspiración. ¿Cómo no ser conmovido por las palabras de Jesús en la cruz: 'Padre, perdónalos'? "

El pueblo judío veneraba a Moisés; lo consideraban el más grande de sus profetas. Prometió a los judíos: "Su Dios les levantará un profeta como yo, de entre ustedes". Esa fue la promesa; el Evangelio de manera dramática muestra su cumplimiento. Cuando Jesús predicó en la sinagoga, la gente quedó impresionada. Comentaron que Jesús es un profeta como ningún otro; su enseñanza fue diferente; les enseñó con autoridad. Mostró su autoridad no solo en palabras sino también en acciones; hace huir los espíritus inmundos.

Entonces, el Evangelio de Marcos no es solo un drama: es un desafío. ¿Qué hago con Jesucristo? Quien es para mí ¿Qué pasa con los espíritus malignos? ¿Vino Jesús a conquistarlos? En nuestro mundo científico moderno, quizás sonreímos un poco ante la sola mención de tales seres. Pero, ¿no hay fuerzas malignas en cada uno de nosotros, fuerzas que amenazan nuestro bienestar y el de los demás, fuerzas oscuras como el orgullo, el egoísmo, la lujuria, la envidia y la amargura que tan fácilmente pueden salir burbujeando a la superficie? ¿Y no podrían describirse estos como espíritus malignos?

Si el evangelio de hoy destaca la autoridad de la enseñanza de Cristo, quizás no sea sorprendente que el salmo responsorial nos instara a "¡escuchar su voz! No endurezcáis vuestro corazón ". Y si escuchamos, ¿qué oiremos? Muchas cosas, pero todo se reducirá a esto: tu Dios te ama, eres hijo de Dios; Dios ha preparado un lugar para ti en el reino de Dios. No temas, Dios puede vencer todos los males que amenazan tu felicidad. Viva para Dios y para sus hermanos y hermanas. Cuando realmente lo escuchamos, no solo con nuestros oídos sino con nuestro corazón, entonces su enseñanza es siempre nueva, siempre lleva un atractivo y una frescura, como si la escucháramos por primera vez. Siempre es Evangelio, siempre buenas noticias.

Retreat Coordinator Job Description

Office of Family Life for the St. Philip Institute

The Retreat Coordinator organizes the various elements of the Three to Get Married marriage formation retreats in the Diocese of Tyler. These retreats provide formation for engaged couples as outlined in Bishop Joseph Strickland's Constitution on Teaching for the Diocese of Tyler. The Office of Family Life provides 8-10 retreat weekends per year. This is a position that could be filled by a couple or an individual.

Responsibilities include:

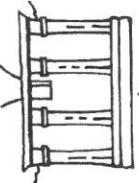
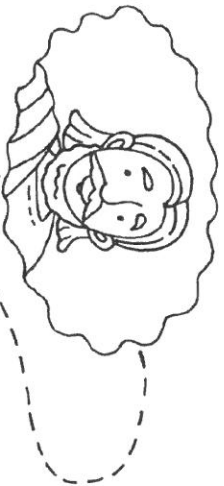
- **Retreat scheduling:** Meet with the Director of Family Life and schedule retreats in the diocese online and in person.
- **Retreat coordination:** Plan and execute 8-10 retreat weekends a year. These weekends are scheduled between January-early November. Each weekend runs from Friday night-Saturday evening or all-day Saturday-Sunday afternoon. Coordination of each weekend includes:
 - Recruit and form the retreat team. The team consists of presenting couples and retreat chaplain.
 - Prepare the retreat materials for the weekend.
 - Communicate with registered couples before the weekend.
 - Collaborate with the Events Manager to ensure details for the weekend are covered, such as meals, retreat environment, decorations, and set up.
- **Retreat development:** Evaluate the needs of the retreat ministry and make adjustments to content, team, schedule, etc. as needed.
- **Team formation:** Work with the chaplain to provide ongoing spiritual support for team members, provide training on the retreat materials and presentations, and assess the team needs for the retreat weekend.

The ideal candidate for this position would be a person or couple who is familiar with our marriage formation materials, has a background in theology and/or experience in marriage ministry, has experience coordinating teams/volunteers, has strong writing and organizational skills, and has experience with public speaking. Bilingual is a plus.

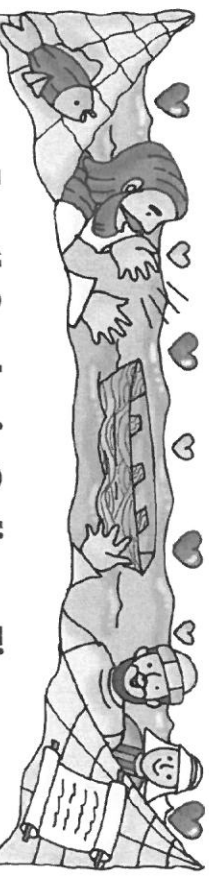
This is a contractual position with the St. Philip Institute. Commitment will require 10-20 hours per week on weeks when retreats are scheduled.

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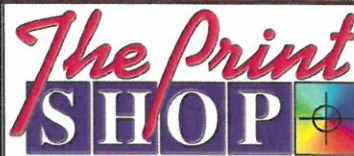
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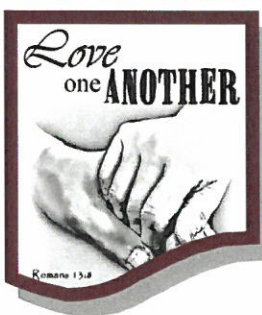
