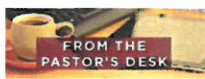

Dear Friends,

The United States has recently observed National Junk Food Day. Many people may have been delighted to celebrate it in style. But doctors and nutritionists would be among those who recognize that burgers, crisps and fizzy drinks lack much of the fiber, vitamins and minerals we need to stay healthy. A regular diet of pizza and coke can soon pile on the calories, clog the arteries and sap us of energy. Junk food may fill us up, but it leaves us nutritionally starved. All the same, junk food remains universally popular. All that tasty sugar, salt and fat can be very attractive to people. It can have an almost addictive effect, according to researchers. The pleasure centers of the brain become desensitized after a while, requiring us to eat more and more of it to achieve the same effect.

It would be wrong, however, to judge anyone for their eating habits. People often have to work long hours, and the time it takes for shopping and preparation can make healthy eating an unaffordable luxury for some. Advertisers know how to exploit people's tiredness, vulnerability and low self-esteem. Keeping to a healthy regime requires discipline, which is easier for anyone self-valuing enough to invest in their own future well-being – but for those who have little money to spare and apparently not much to look forward to in life, instant gratification may seem more appealing.

Many people were as vulnerable and hard up in Jesus' day. Springtime was a time of particular hardship. So when Jesus fed five thousand people with bread that seemed to appear from nowhere, word soon circulated around the lakeside villages of Galilee. Within hours crowds arrived from all directions, asking for more of this free food. You don't really want me, Jesus remarked sadly, you just want all the bread you can get.

Some people still complain of feeling empty inside. Often it is a sense of dissatisfaction. They might be deceived into thinking that the latest gadget will make them happy. Indeed, for some, life becomes a never-ending round of acquiring and disposing. Nothing, however, will ever fill that gnawing emptiness except the kind of nourishment which comes from God. When we gather in company with one another and with Jesus, we are being invited into relationship at its most intimate and lasting. We savor something of the divine life of heaven. Hearing the word of God, we are renewed; consuming the body and blood of Jesus, we are recreated. Changed to become like Jesus, we, too, can become bread for the world.

Many people still have to work very hard to provide for themselves and their families. Jesus urges us to work for our spiritual maintenance as well, for food that rejuvenates the inner self. Terrible though it is that people still go hungry in this day and age, hunger of a spiritual kind can be healthy if it makes us deeply desirous of Jesus. Today perhaps, we may recognize that hollow place within us all and come looking for the only one who can satisfy it. Come to me, Jesus is saying, you have no need ever to be hungry again.

Queridos Amigos,

Estados Unidos ha observado recientemente el Día Nacional de la Comida Chatarra. Es posible que muchas personas se hayan sentido encantadas de celebrarlo con estilo. Pero los médicos y nutricionistas estarían entre los que reconocen que las hamburguesas, las patatas fritas y las bebidas gaseosas carecen de gran parte de la fibra, las vitaminas y los minerales que necesitamos para mantenernos saludables. Una dieta regular de pizza y coca cola pronto puede acumular calorías, obstruir las arterias y agotarnos de energía. La comida chatarra puede llenarnos, pero nos deja con hambre nutricional. De todos modos, la comida chatarra sigue siendo universalmente popular. Todo ese sabroso azúcar, sal y grasa puede resultar muy atractivo para la gente. Puede tener un efecto casi adictivo, según los investigadores. Los centros de placer del cerebro se desensibilizan después de un tiempo, lo que nos obliga a comer más y más para lograr el mismo efecto.

Sin embargo, sería incorrecto juzgar a alguien por sus hábitos alimenticios. Las personas a menudo tienen que trabajar muchas horas, y el tiempo que se necesita para comprar y prepararse puede hacer que la alimentación saludable sea un lujo inasequible para algunos. Los anunciantes saben cómo explotar el cansancio, la vulnerabilidad y la baja autoestima de las personas. Mantener un régimen saludable requiere disciplina, que es más fácil para cualquiera que se valore lo suficiente como para invertir en su propio bienestar futuro, pero para aquellos que tienen poco dinero de sobra y aparentemente no mucho que esperar en la vida, la gratificación instantánea puede parecer más atractivo.

Muchas personas eran tan vulnerables y duras en los días de Jesús. La primavera fue una época de especial dificultad. Entonces, cuando Jesús alimentó a cinco mil personas con pan que parecía surgir de la nada, pronto se corrió la voz por las aldeas de Galilea junto al lago. En cuestión de horas llegaron multitudes de todas las direcciones, pidiendo más de esta comida gratis. Realmente no me quieres, dijo Jesús con tristeza, solo quieres todo el pan que puedas conseguir.

Algunas personas todavía se quejan de sentirse vacías por dentro. A menudo es una sensación de insatisfacción. Es posible que se engañen pensando que el último dispositivo los hará felices. De hecho, para algunos, la vida se convierte en una ronda interminable de adquirir y disponer. Sin embargo, nada jamás llenará ese vacío que roe, excepto el tipo de alimento que proviene de Dios. Cuando nos reunimos en compañía unos de otros y con Jesús, se nos invita a tener una relación más íntima y duradera. Saboreamos algo de la vida divina del cielo. Al escuchar la palabra de Dios, somos renovados; Al consumir el cuerpo y la sangre de Jesús, somos recreados. Transformados para ser como Jesús, nosotros también podemos convertirnos en pan para el mundo.

Muchas personas todavía tienen que trabajar muy duro para mantenerse a sí mismas y a sus familias. Jesús nos insta a trabajar también por nuestro mantenimiento espiritual, por alimentos que rejuvenezcan nuestro ser interior. Aunque es terrible que la gente todavía pase hambre en esta época, el hambre de tipo espiritual puede ser saludable si nos hace desear profundamente a Jesús. Quizás hoy reconozcamos ese lugar vacío dentro de todos nosotros y vengamos buscando al único que pueda satisfacerlo. Ven a mí, dice Jesús, no tienes por qué volver a tener hambre nunca más.
