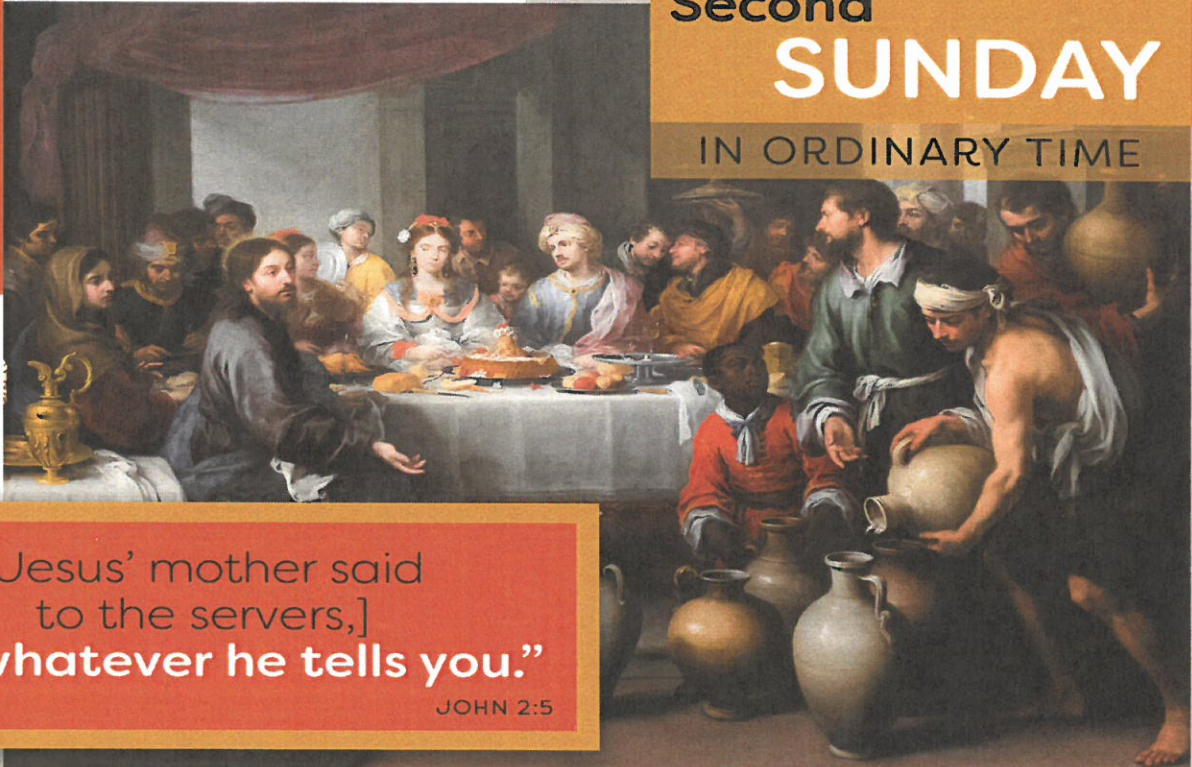

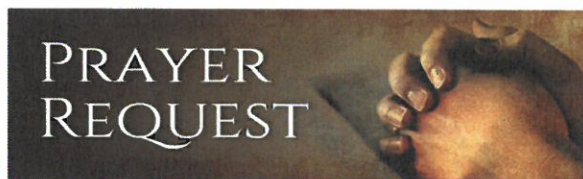

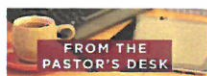

Dear Friends,

Since the onset of Covid-19 pandemic, there have been periods when weddings have been subject to restrictions, for example in the types of celebration allowed or the numbers permitted to attend. Yet for many people, their wedding is the most important and life-changing event they experience, so they go to huge effort and expense to make sure that the day is unforgettable. It has been calculated that the average wedding takes more than 250 hours to plan, and the average cost of a wedding has spiraled over the years.

The careful planning of a wedding is a way of making a statement about who we are and what we hope for the future of the couple. The circle of the gold wedding band symbolizes never-ending love; the confetti expresses a desire for fertility and an abundance of good fortune. Weddings speak of our hopes for the future, especially our desire for love, security, and a full and happy life, though we have to recognize that those hopes are not always fulfilled, or not fulfilled in a way we expect. And we should not be critical of people – or of ourselves – if those hopes are not fulfilled in the way we thought they would be.

The image of wedding is frequently used in the Old Testament to describe the relationship of God and God's people – the Lord is Israel's husband, as Isaiah tells us, though often Israel is an unfaithful bride who breaks her vows, worshipping false gods. Time and again God forgives her, turning her sadness into joy. In the time of Jesus, the people's longing for the coming of the Messiah was often expressed in terms of a wedding: the days of the Messiah would be a time of rejoicing, a wedding feast, with an abundance of wine and celebration. And so John tells us the story of the wedding at Cana at the beginning of his Gospel to indicate to us that God's blessings are being poured out on God's people, because the groom – Jesus has arrived to marry his bride, Israel.

Just as a wedding is a sign of who we are and what we hope for in life – love, security, abundance of good things – so Cana is a sign of what God offers us, God's people. Thru the death of Jesus, the Lord offers us more than we could ever dream of – not simply the gifts of the Spirit Paul mentions, but the fullness of life and love.

What is asked of us is that we believe, as the disciples did, in Jesus' power to change our lives and to lead us to God. It is thru faith in God that the water of our daily life can be transformed into something far superior. Our lives gain a new meaning, a new quality, if we enter into this covenant, this marriage with God, which Jesus makes possible. Mary shows us how to do this: by doing whatever he tells us. And in John's Gospel that simply means believing in Jesus and loving as he has loved us. Faith and love – all that is needed for a good marriage and all that God requires of us to have the fullness of life.

Queridos Amigos,

Desde el inicio de la pandemia de Covid-19, ha habido períodos en los que las bodas han estado sujetas a restricciones, por ejemplo, en los tipos de celebraciones permitidas o el número de personas a las que se permite asistir. Sin embargo, para muchas personas, su boda es el evento más importante y que cambia la vida que experimentan, por lo que hacen un gran esfuerzo y gasto para asegurarse de que el día sea inolvidable. Se ha calculado que la planificación de una boda promedio toma más de 250 horas, y el costo promedio de una boda se ha disparado a lo largo de los años.

La planificación cuidadosa de una boda es una forma de hacer una declaración sobre quiénes somos y qué esperamos para el futuro de la pareja. El círculo del anillo de bodas de oro simboliza el amor eterno; el confeti expresa un deseo de fertilidad y abundancia de buena fortuna. Las bodas hablan de nuestras esperanzas para el futuro, especialmente nuestro deseo de amor, seguridad y una vida plena y feliz, aunque tenemos que reconocer que esas esperanzas no siempre se cumplen, o no se cumplen de la manera que esperamos. Y no debemos ser críticos con las personas, ni con nosotros mismos, si esas esperanzas no se cumplen de la manera que pensamos que se harían.

La imagen de la boda se usa con frecuencia en el Antiguo Testamento para describir la relación de Dios y el pueblo de Dios: el Señor es el esposo de Israel, como nos dice Isaías, aunque a menudo Israel es una novia infiel que rompe sus votos y adora dioses falsos. Una y otra vez Dios la perdona, convirtiendo su tristeza en alegría. En tiempos de Jesús, el anhelo del pueblo por la venida del Mesías se expresaba a menudo en términos de boda: los días del Mesías serían un tiempo de regocijo, fiesta de bodas, con abundancia de vino y fiesta. Y entonces Juan nos cuenta la historia de la boda de Caná al comienzo de su Evangelio para indicarnos que las bendiciones de Dios se están derramando sobre el pueblo de Dios, porque el novio, Jesús, ha llegado para casarse con su novia, Israel.

Así como una boda es un signo de lo que somos y de lo que esperamos de la vida: amor, seguridad, abundancia de cosas buenas, así Caná es un signo de lo que Dios nos ofrece a nosotros, el pueblo de Dios. A través de la muerte de Jesús, el Señor nos ofrece más de lo que podríamos soñar, no simplemente los dones del Espíritu que menciona Pablo, sino la plenitud de la vida y el amor.

Lo que se nos pide es que creamos, como los discípulos, en el poder de Jesús para cambiar nuestra vida y llevarnos a Dios. Es a través de la fe en Dios que el agua de nuestra vida diaria puede transformarse en algo muy superior. Nuestras vidas adquieren un nuevo sentido, una nueva cualidad, si entramos en esta alianza, este matrimonio con Dios, que Jesús hace posible. María nos muestra cómo hacer esto: haciendo lo que él nos dice. Y en el Evangelio de Juan eso simplemente significa creer en Jesús y amar como él nos ha amado. Fe y amor: todo lo que se necesita para un buen matrimonio y todo lo que Dios requiere de nosotros para tener la plenitud de la vida.
