
DISPLAYING YOUR PALM SUNDAY PALMS

Here are a few ideas to display your blessed palm: 1. Tuck it behind a cross or religious picture; 2. Place in a Bible; 3. Set in a narrow vase as a place of prayer; 4. Create a cross (see below) for display. Blessed palms should be treated with special reverence. Therefore, anything that has been blessed should be burned (and then the ashes buried) or simply buried. This type of disposal honors their sacred purpose and returns them to the earth in a dignified way.

Palm Leaf Cross Directions

Supplies: One palm leaf strip about 24-26" in length, 1/2" in width, tapering to the end.





THE HOLY POST

PALM SUNDAY of the PASSION of the LORD April 2, 2023

TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING - The Suffering Servant speaks to the weary.

(Isaiah 50:4-7)

PSALM - 'My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?"

(Psalm 22)

SECOND READING - Jesus emptied himself, and accepted death on a cross. (*Philippians 2:6-11*)

GOSPEL - They came to a place called Golgotha and crucified Jesus there. (Matthew 26:14 - 27:66 or 27: 11-54)

"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Jesus calls out near the point of death. Centuries earlier, the psalmist had cried out to God with similar words. One can imagine Isaiah saying the same thing as he was struck and beaten by his oppressors. Through all their suffering, none of them rebel or fight back. Though in tremendous pain hanging limply on the cross, Jesus remained obedient to the end. Let us listen to St. Matthew's Passion, realizing what our Lord endured to win our salvation.
